sheds new light not only on the figure of the radical but also on the moderate Muslim represented by a community forever changed by the men's departure. *Homegrown Radicals* offers a case study of the complex entanglements of the radical and moderate Muslim in post 9/11 North America. Youcef Soufi brings these figures together in uneasy tension providing insight into how state violence has inextricably tied them together. The book examines how and why this theory resonated as well as its consequences for the men's families, friends, and Muslim community. *Homegrown Radicals* highlights how post 9/11 Islamophobia has operated through the conceptual blurring of the line between moderate and radical Muslims and asks what alternative forms of solidarity may transcend the violent boundaries of the nation state.
