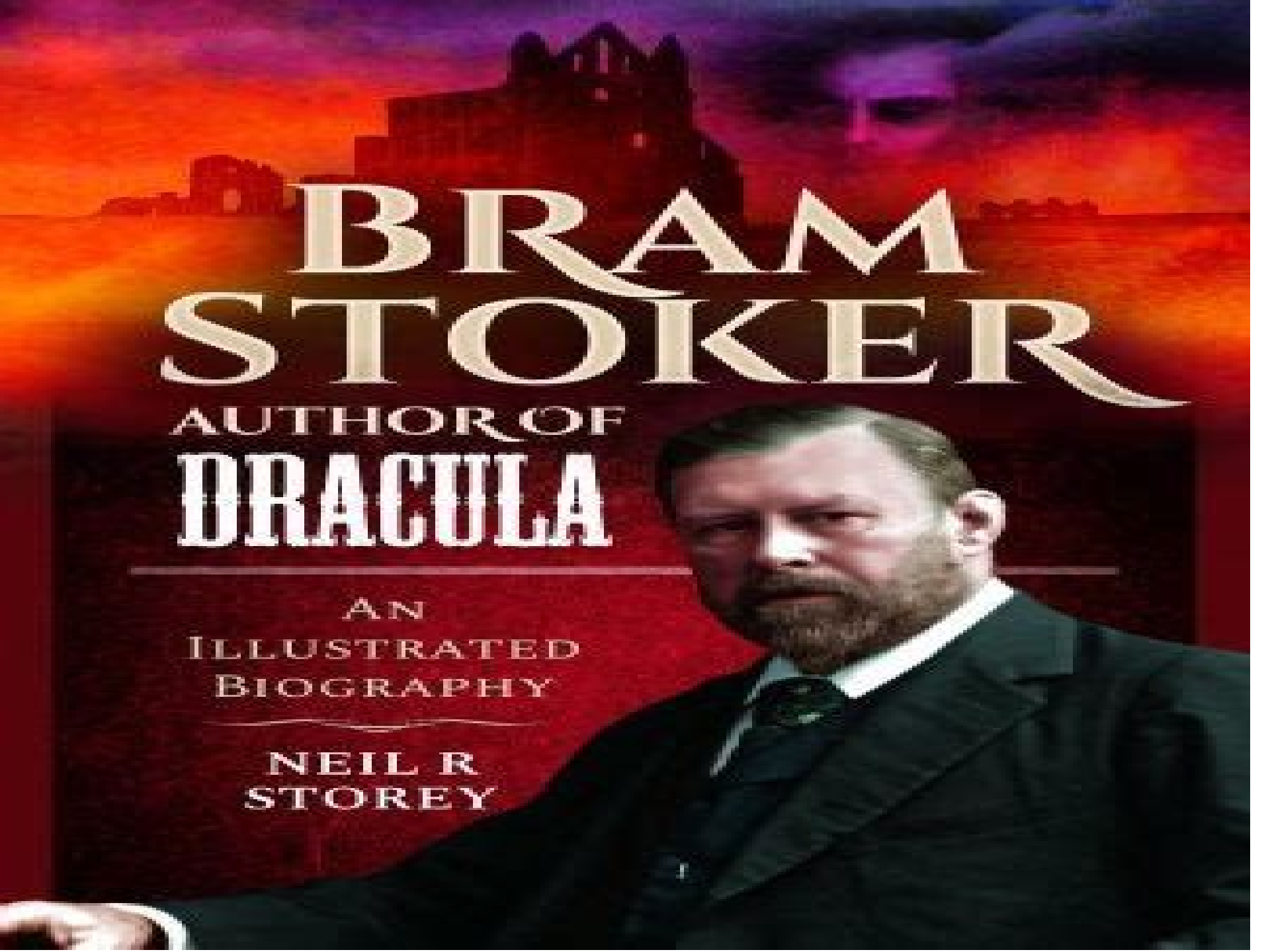

Storey,2023-10-12 Previously unpublished research sheds new light on how Bram Stoker researched and wrote Dracula and the people who inspired his characters Bram Stoker Author of Dracula is an affectionate and revealing biography of the man who created the vampire novel that would define the genre and lead to a new age in Gothic horror literature Based on decades of painstaking research in libraries museums and university archives and privileged access to private collections on both sides of the Atlantic the private letters of Bram and the reminiscences of those who knew him not only shed new light on Stoker's ancestry his life loves and friendships they also reveal more about the places and people who inspired him and how he researched and wrote his books Bram wrote numerous articles short stories and poetry for newspapers and magazines he had a total of eleven novels and two collections of short stories published in his lifetime but he would only become known for one of them Dracula Tragically he did not live long enough to see it as a huge success In his heyday as Acting Manager for Sir Henry Irving at the Lyceum Theatre in the West End of London Bram was a well known figure in a golden age of British theater He was a big framed ebullient genial gentleman with red hair and beard who never lost his soft Irish brogue was blessed with wit and a host of entertaining stories fit for every occasion Described as having the paw of Hercules and the smile of Machiavelli above all he knew what it meant to be a loyal friend

From the Shadow of Dracula Paul Murray,2004 It is one of the great ironies of literary history that the author of arguably the world's bestselling work of fiction remains little known This book seeks to redress the balance and to articulate a new vision of Bram Stoker relating the creator to his most famous creation Paul Murray has examined important primary sources such as Stoker's working notes for DRACULA and his extensive correspondence which shed an entirely new light on Stoker's life He places Stoker in the context of Victorian Ireland and the literary and theatrical circles in which he moved Bram Stoker was immersed in the Dublin literary scene and was involved with the great theatrical literary and artistic figures of the day such as Sarah Bernhardt Ellen Terry Oscar Wilde Mark Twain Tennyson and Whistler His most important relationship however was with Henry Irving with whom he ran the Lyceum Theatre in London And as his greatest achievement DRACULA Stoker's enduring work of horror is placed at the core of this book This remarkable new biography places Bram Stoker centre stage in a tradition of Irish horror writing which

extends back to authors such as Charles Maturin and Sheridan Le Fanu and which also looks forward to writers such as Neil Jordan and Anne Rice

The first full scale biography of the complex man known today as the author of *Dracula* but who was famous in his own time as the innovative manager of London's Lyceum Theatre home of the greatest English actors of the day Henry Irving and Ellen Terry Barbara Belford tells the story of Stoker the hidden man On the surface the very model of Victorian modesty reserve and duty the devoted husband and father In actuality a man whose emotional and working energies were in large part expended on the care and cultivation of the flamboyant mesmerizing genius of the stage Henry Irving We see Stoker the writer of novels and stories that were imbued with sexuality violence and the celebration of death works at opposite poles from the decorum he presented in society And Barbara Belford shows us in *Dracula* a mirror of the undercurrents of Stoker's own life as well as a masked exploration of subjects utterly forbidden in his time seduction rape necrophilia incest voyeurism universal taboos dramatized with such a myth making edge that the novel remains resonant and unsettling almost one hundred years later We follow Stoker from his sickly childhood entertained by his mother's twice told tales of Irish hobgoblins and banshees to his years as a Dublin undergraduate and newspaperman when he first wrote to his idol Walt Whitman spilling out his innermost thoughts and beginning a lifelong correspondence that culminated in their meeting when Stoker traveled to America on tour with Irving and Ellen Terry We see Stoker's childhood friendship with Oscar Wilde and watch as the two young men compete for the hand of the beautiful Florence Balcombe who became Stoker's wife And we see Stoker in the literary and theatrical circles of Victorian London among such figures as Mark Twain Arthur Conan Doyle James Whistler Lord Tennyson and George Bernard Shaw Belford gives us a vivid picture of the man his time his London the domestic and theatrical worlds he lived in and the dark imaginary realms that were the wellspring of all his writings especially of his enduring and enduringly fascinating *Dracula*
