Bread, Peace and Liberty J. Kreitman, 1981 *Love and Terror* William Herrick, 1982-02 Now available as a New Directions paperback *Love and Terror* William Herrick's second novel with ND both reflects and anticipates today's headlines Terrorist kidnappings hijackings and dramatic rescues all form a part of the plot but Herrick's interest lies less in tension filled heroics than in the human cost of flawed idealism Through the notebook of the principal terrorist Viktor X the complex characters of Viktor and Gabriele for whom love and terrorism are intertwined and inseparable are revealed And in a series of interviews with a nameless reporter the lives of three disillusioned revolutionaries the old ones now hostages to a new brand of revolution gradually and movingly unfold In his earlier *Shadows and Wolves* New Directions 1980 Herrick showed us the possibility of human solutions that transcend politics In *Love and Terror* he shows us why any ideology inflexibly adhered to makes such solutions necessary Republican Identities in War and Peace Antoine Prost, 2014-03-04 Antoine Prost's contributions to French history have enabled us to understand the failure of fascism in France and why the Republic survived the humiliation of occupation and collaboration in the Second World War He is the pre eminent historian of civil society in France For the first time his seminal articles have been translated into English and collected in this single volume Beginning with his classic account of war memorials through his pioneering study of the people of a popular quarter of Paris in 1936 and of the troubled history of commemorating the Algerian war this book expertly takes us through republican representations of war and peace urban spaces and social identity and discourse and social conflict in republican France Amongst this range of topics Prost considers the notion of social class and deference the multiple uses of myth the secularization of religious imagery the centrality of primary schools in French political culture and insults as staples of French political rhetoric Included here are his famous essays Verdun and War Memorials of the Great War which have been hailed as indispensable additions to the study of European cultural history Also notable is his fascinating investigation of rites de passage in Orlans which artfully reveals how complex and semiologically rich rites de passage can be This book is essential reading for anyone wishing to gain a firm understanding of the history of nineteenth and twentieth century France and of the work of one of the most influential cultural historians of our day Léon Blum Joel Colton, 1987 John Colton is a meticulous researcher and a fine craftsman In his political biography of Leon Blum these two qualities are beautifully blended none of the available evidence appears to have been over looked and the enormous mass of variegated material has been transmuted in a polished richly tapestried and absorbing narrative Bread, Peace and Liberty J. Since its publication in Italy, Claudio Pavone's masterwork has become indispensable to anyone seeking to understand this period and its continuing importance for the nation's identity. Pavone casts a sober eye on his protagonists' ethical and ideological motivations. He uncovers a multilayered conflict in which class antagonisms, patriotism and political ideals all played a part. A clear understanding of this complexity allows him to explain many details of the post-war transition as well as the legacy of the Resistance for modern Italy. In addition to being a monumental work of scholarship, A Civil War is a folk history capturing events, personalities and attitudes that were on the verge of slipping entirely out of recollection to the detriment of Italy's understanding of itself and its past.

The Popular Front in France Julian Jackson, 1990-05-25 This is the first full-length study in English of the Popular Front, the left-wing coalition which emerged in France during the 1930s in response to the threat of fascism and which went on to win the elections of 1936, giving France her first socialist premier, Léon Blum. After a brief narrative history of the Popular Front, the book is organised thematically around the main historiographical debates to which the Popular Front has given rise. Among the issues considered are the origins of the strikes of 1936, the reasons for the failure of the Popular Front economic policy, the relationship between culture and politics in France in the 1930s and the causes of France's policy of non-intervention in the Spanish Civil War. The book views the Popular Front at three levels: as a mass movement, political coalition and government, and argues that it must not be seen just as a narrowly political phenomenon but as a political, social and cultural explosion which attempted to break down the barriers between all areas of human activity in the highly compartmentalised society of France in the 1930s. Even if the Popular Front ultimately failed in this aim, it has acquired legendary status in France, and the epilogue to the book briefly examines the myth of the Popular Front from 1936 to the present day.
