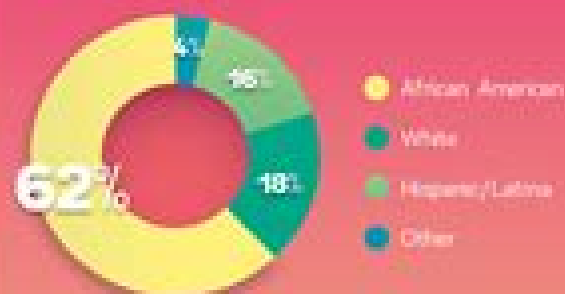


In the U.S., nearly
