History would not be what it is today were it not for the role of infectious disease epidemics. Had not the Black Plague decimated Europe's cloistered intelligentsia in the 1600s, this and anything worth writing and reading would be in Latin. Hospitals as institutions to isolate the sick from the well descended from the leper houses of the Middle Ages. If it weren't for smallpox, the Mayan civilization would be still here today. Then again, Old World explorers during Columbus' time were given something to take home from their adventures -- syphilis.

Although public health has done much to eradicate infectious diseases, the task is never done. Tuberculosis remains a perennial symptom of urban blight, and newly discovered viruses, such as Ebola, remind us that there are still some diseases for which there are no cures. Another is the Acquired Immunodeficiency Disease Syndrome, or AIDS -- the almost certain outcome of infection with the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV). A. Nikoforuk notes, "Dying from AIDS is like reliving every past epidemic all at once."

Unlike infectious diseases of the past, AIDS will probably be the most researched malady in our lifetime. More generously supported than research for other chronic diseases, AIDS researchers have been able to conduct the kind of basic research needed to understand the biology of the virus and, thus, develop ways to combat HIV's tenacious will to live. Its ability to mutate almost at will makes it a formidable foe, especially for those championing vaccine development.

Now 15 years into the AIDS pandemic, the major challenge for health professionals working with those afflicted is trying to keep up with the research so its findings can be used to assess the value of available therapies as well as to provide support and comfort to those who are terminally ill. Dr. G.J. Stine's AIDS Update 1996: An Annual Overview of Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome does an admirable job in keeping the reader interested and informed.

AIDS Update 1996 is the fifth in a series of textbooks the author has written in recent years for college-level courses on HIV/AIDS. The textbook is also meant to serve as a supplemental resource on the subject for medical, nursing, and allied health science students, as well as those involved with any of the counseling and training activities associated with AIDS services.

This 13-chapter text is the alternate and more current version of his 1996 textbook, Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome: Biological, Medical, Social and Legal Issues, 2nd Edition, which includes three additional chapters not
