1. What is personality? What do traits tell us?

Personality is a more or less stable psychophysical system of thoughts, emotions, and behavior. Each person has their own patterns in their personality.

Personality is the ABC's- Affect Behavior and Cognition

Traits are characteristic adaptations that include motives, goals, plans, strategies, values, selfimage, and developmental tasks.

Traits are relatively broad terms to describe one another.

A trait is a stable dimension across time and situations of personality that can be used to characterize people. We can use traits to describe ourselves and others.

Know the longitudinal study of TV violence and aggression by Leonard Eron. What hypotheses was he able to investigate? What do the correlations mean?

He studied 500 children in 3rd grade (boys) in Chicago for Tv violence and aggression. Examined 10 years later, 8 years old and 10 years old.

Hypothesis... Situation and

A correlation of .21 is not a strong correlation. Situational hypothesis: .31; Selective hypothesis: .01; Personality hypothesis: .38

Given a study description, be able to identify the type of study (correlational, experimental), the variables (what is the IV?), and strengths and weaknesses of the design?

Experiments are to find causality. The experiment method has the ability to ascertain what causes what. In an experiment, you manipulate a variable. Opposed to measuring the variable like in the correlational. Correlational is how strong or weak two variables are. The stronger the r-value the stronger correlation. IV is the independent variable, which can be measured or manipulated. The dependent variable is measured with a correlation value.

4. Be familiar with examples of S, I, B, and L data.

The S data is Self-reports

The I data is informant data. The types of observers. Naturalistic vs. artificial observations.

The B data is Behavior data. These are behavior (social interactions), performance (IQ, memory, reaction time), physiology (skin conductance, eyeblink startle reflex, brain imaging), projective tests (TAT, Roschach inkblots), and MMPI.

The L data is life-outcome: health, education, work, marriage, and parenthood. The examples are interviews with mothers of 8-10-year-old children. Rated severity and frequency of temper tantrums. Men who had exhibited temper tantrums. Women who had exhibited temper tantrums.

- 5. With respect to assessment, be familiar with reliability, validity, and generalizability.
 - Reliability: is something consistent?
 - O Test-retest reliability: do you get the same results each time.
 - O Internal consistency: do the items relate/are consistent with each other
 - O Inter-rater reliability: do two people see the same thing.
 - Validity: does it actually measure what is supposed to?
 - Face validity: does it look like it is measuring what it is supposed to.
 - O Predictive/criterion validity: can you use the measure to predict various outcomes.
