opened a vital second aerial front against the Third Reich bombing critical oil and transportation targets with great effectiveness The first full examination of the Mediterranean theater in these critical roles as a strategic and tactical testing ground for the Allies and as a vital theater of operations in its own right The Mediterranean Air War fills in a long missing but vital dimension of the history of World War II

Hitler's Air War in Spain Norman Ridley, 2022-06-07 Almost since the advent of warfare civilians have suffered collateral damage but the concept of Total War a war without limits only surfaced in the early part of the twentieth century The idea of huge numbers of aircraft raining death upon defenceless cities was seen by many as not only barbaric but in practical terms quite unrealistic given the logistical challenges that would have to be overcome in order to put them into practice Any complacency over the threat however was rudely shattered on 26 February 1935 when Adolf Hitler officially signed a decree authorizing the formation of the Luftwaffe The third branch of Germany's armed forces erupted on to the European military landscape Its blustering claims of irrepressible air power sent waves of panic rippling through ministries of war throughout the world Framing a realistic response to Hitler's propaganda offensive proved to be problematic given the lack of detailed knowledge of not only the numbers but also the true performance capabilities of his new generation of aircraft and the ways in which they had expanded the boundaries of war It was therefore of huge interest to all modern military establishments when these machines were deployed during the Spanish Civil War which broke out in July 1936 Notwithstanding the limited scope of this conflict it offered for the participating nations a testing ground for new machines and for the interested observers a window into the future of aerial warfare When the Spanish Civil War was less than a year old it had already seen air power employed in most of the ways that it would be used in the Second World War This not only included airlifting troops reconnaissance interdiction close support and strategic bombing but also the deliberate targeting of civilians as a means of achieving military objectives This book looks at all the significant aerial engagements of the war and examines them against the background of the wider global context In this way the Spanish Civil War's part in the evolution of air power is confirmed as is the way in which its lessons were learned or ignored in the context of the much greater conflagration that was to come

A History of the Mediterranean Air War, 1940-1945 Christopher Shores, Russell Guest, 2025-09-30 In 1943 Allied bombers from Italy launched strategic attacks on Axis oil fields factories and Danube supply routes Following the inter Allied Casablanca Conference in January 1943 the outline for the Combined Bomber Offensive was agreed and resulted in early February with the Casablanca Directive This required the progressive destruction and dislocation of the German military industrial and economic systems and the undermining of the morale of the German people to a point where their capacity for armed resistance is fatally weakened This directive was clarified in June when the Combined Chiefs of Staff issued the Pointblank Directive that stated that the highest priority targets were the fighter aircraft factories to ensure that in the coming invasion of France the enemy would not have air superiority When these directives were issued it was envisaged that as well as attacks by RAF Bomber Command

and the US 8th Air Force based in England the strategic bomber forces in Italy would begin operations once suitable bases were available After the Allied landings in Italy and resulting collapse of the Italian fascist regime a network of bomber bases was hastily developed Thus on 1 November 1943 the US 15th Air Force was formed to conduct the daylight bombing offensive against strategic targets in southern Germany and across southeastern Europe Key among these were the Rumanian oilfields and traffic along the River Danube This new formation was joined by the smaller but highly effective 205 Group RAF that was trained and equipped for night bombing so mirroring their equivalent British based formations The damaging attacks on the Reich's oil supplies and the highly effective Danube mining campaign conducted at night by 205 Group delivered huge strategic effect The latter reduced vital oil and goods traffic into the Reich to a trickle but also dislocated the supply and logistics train into the southern part of the Eastern Front so giving manifest support to the Soviets In this volume the early months of this hugely significant air campaign are described in minute and original detail and are accompanied by hundreds of hitherto unpublished photographs In combating these attacks Germany's Axis allies such as Hungary Rumania Bulgaria and Slovakia were encountered for the first time by the Western Allies Airwar Phillip S. Meilinger, 2003 These essays cover a wide range of subjects and tell the story of air power's evolution over the past century
