The Air War in Ukraine Dag Henriksen, Justin Bronk, 2024-08-01 This book provides a comprehensive account of the use of airpower in the first year of the Ukraine conflict Airpower has been central to political military and public debates from the outset of the Russo Ukrainian war After having started with whether the US and NATO should attempt to establish a No Fly Zone over Ukraine to protect the civilian population the international discussion soon focused on the underperformance of Russian airpower The fact that the initial contest for air superiority over Ukraine ended in an uneasy state of mutual denial came as a surprise to Western analysts who suspected Kyiv would fall within a relatively short period of time The surprise and relief that it did not only fueled urgent and ongoing discussions on how NATO nations could support the Ukrainian war effort Regardless of nationality age level of education or ethnicity the near daily footage of Russian missiles bombs and drones hitting residential areas and bombarding infrastructure to deprive an entire population of electricity and water has been emotionally imprinted on generations who have only known peace Why the Russians have used airpower with such brutality and how Ukraine and its allies have defended against this threat is an important topic to understand even outside a specialist military audience The aim of this book therefore is to provide an analysis on why the air war over Ukraine unfolded as it did during the first year of the war This book will be of much interest to students of air power military and strategic studies Russian and eastern European politics and International Relations **War in Ukraine** Tom Cooper, Adrien Fontanellaz, Milos Sipos, 2024-12-31 On 24 February 2022 the Russian Federation launched an all out invasion of Ukraine

The Ardennes, 1944-1945 Christer Bergström, 2014-12-19 A comprehensive photo filled account of the six week long Battle of the Bulge when panzers slipped through the forest and took the Allies by surprise In December 1944 just as World War II appeared to be winding down Hitler shocked the world with a powerful German counteroffensive that cracked the center of the American front The attack came through the Ardennes the hilly and forested area in eastern Belgium and Luxembourg that the Allies had considered a quiet sector Instead for the second time in the war the Germans used it as a stealthy avenue of approach for their panzers Much of US First Army was overrun and thousands of prisoners were taken as the Germans forged a fifty mile bulge into the Allied front But in one small town Bastogne American paratroopers together with remnants of tank units offered dogged resistance Meanwhile the rest of Eisenhower's broad front strategy came to a halt as Patton from the south and Hodges from the north converged on the enemy incursion Yet it would take an epic six week long winter battle the bloodiest in the history of the US Army before the Germans were finally pushed back Christer Bergström has interviewed veterans gone through huge amounts of archive material and performed on the spot research in the area The result is a large amount of previously unpublished material and new findings including reevaluations of tank and personnel casualties and the most accurate picture yet of what really transpired from the perspectives of both sides With nearly four hundred photos numerous maps and thirty two superb color profiles of combat vehicles and aircraft it provides perhaps the most comprehensive look at the battle yet published

The First Day on the Eastern Front Craig W.H. Luther, 2018-11-01 Sunday June 22 1941 three million German soldiers invaded the Soviet Union as part of Hitler's long planned Operation Barbarossa which aimed to destroy the Soviet Union secure its land as lebensraum for the Third Reich and enslave its Slavic population From launching points in newly acquired Poland in three prongs North Central South German forces stormed western Russia virtually from the Baltic to the Black Sea By late fall the invasion had foundered against Russian weather terrain and resistance and by December it had failed at the gates of Moscow but early on as the Germans sliced through Russian territory and soldiers with impunity capturing hundreds of thousands it seemed as though Russia would fall In the spirit of Martin Middlebrook's classic First Day on the Somme Craig Luther narrates the events of June 22 1941 a day when German military might was at its peak and seemed as though it would easily conquer the Soviet Union a day the common soldiers would remember for its tension and the frogs bellowing in the Polish marshlands It was a day when the German blitzkrieg decimated Soviet command and control within hours and seemed like nothing would stop it from taking Moscow Luther narrates June 22 one of the pivotal days of World War II from high command down to the tanks and soldiers at the sharp end covering strategy as well as tactics and the vivid personal stories of the men who crossed the border into the Soviet Union that fateful day which is the Eastern Front in microcosm representing the years of industrial scale warfare that followed and the unremitting hostility of Germans and Soviets

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
