After Appomattox Gregory P. Downs, 2019-08-13 Original and revelatory David Blight author of *Frederick Douglass* Avery O Craven Award Finalist A Civil War Memory Civil War Monitor Best Book of the Year In April 1865 Robert E Lee wrote to Ulysses S Grant asking for peace Peace was beyond his authority to negotiate Grant replied but surrender terms he would discuss The distinction proved prophetic After Appomattox reveals that the Civil War did not end with Confederate capitulation in 1865 Instead a second phase of the war began which lasted until 1871 not the project euphemistically called Reconstruction but a state of genuine belligerence whose mission was to shape the peace Using its war powers the U S Army oversaw an ambitious occupation stationing tens of thousands of troops in outposts across the defeated South This groundbreaking history shows that the purpose of the occupation was to crush slavery in the face of fierce and violent resistance but there were limits to its effectiveness the occupying army never really managed to remake the South The United States Army has been far too neglected as a player a force in the history of Reconstruction Downs wants his work to speak to the present and indeed it should David W Blight *The Atlantic* Striking Downs chronicles a military occupation that was indispensable to the uprooting of slavery Boston Globe Downs makes the case that the final end to slavery and the establishment of basic civil and voting rights for all Americans was born in the face of bayonets A remarkable necessary book Slate

Terror in the Heart of Freedom Hannah Rosen, 2009-06-01 The meaning of race in the antebellum southern United States was anchored in the racial exclusivity of slavery coded as black and full citizenship coded as white as well as male These traditional definitions of race were radically disrupted after emancipation when citizenship was granted to all persons born in the United States and suffrage was extended to all men Hannah Rosen persuasively argues that in this critical moment of Reconstruction contests over the future meaning of race were often fought on the terrain of gender Sexual violence specifically white on black rape emerged as a critical arena in postemancipation struggles over African American citizenship Analyzing the testimony of rape survivors Rosen finds that white men often staged elaborate attacks meant to enact prior racial hierarchy Through their testimony black women defiantly rejected such hierarchy and claimed their new and equal rights Rosen explains how heated debates over interracial marriage were also attempts by whites to undermine African American men s demands for suffrage and a voice in public affairs By connecting histories of rape and discourses of social equality with struggles over citizenship Rosen shows how gendered violence and gendered rhetorics of race together produced a climate of terror for black men and women seeking to exercise their new rights as citizens Linking political events at the city state and regional levels Rosen places gender and sexual violence at the heart of understanding the reconsolidation of race and racism in the postemancipation United States Washington during Civil War and Reconstruction Robert Harrison, 2011-08-15 In this provocative study Robert Harrison provides new insight into grassroots reconstruction after the Civil War and into the lives of those most deeply affected the newly emancipated African Americans Harrison argues that the District of Columbia far from being marginal to the Reconstruction story was central to Republican efforts to reshape civil and political relations with the capital a testing ground for Congressional policy makers The study describes the ways in which federal agencies such as the Army and the Freedmen s Bureau attempted to assist Washington s freed population and shows how officials struggled to address the social problems resulting from large scale African American migration It also sheds new light on the political processes that led to the abandonment of

Dowling, 2007 Author translator social critic and Harvard professor of art Charles Eliot Norton was widely regarded in his own day as the most cultivated man in America In modern times by contrast he has been condemned as the supercilious representative of an embattled patrician caste This revisionary study argues that Norton's genuine significance for American culture and politics today can only be grasped by recovering the vanished contexts in which his life and work took shape In a wide ranging analysis Linda Dowling demonstrates the effects upon Norton's thought of the great transatlantic humanitarian reform movement of the 1840s the Pre Raphaelite and Ruskinian revolution in art and architecture of the 1850s and the surging liberal optimism that emerged from the Civil War Drawing on numerous deleted passages from Norton's manuscript journals Dowling probes beneath the imperturbable mask of the public Norton bringing to light the elusive private man Returning from Europe in 1873 bereft of his wife and stripped of his religious belief Norton was compelled to confront the painful contradictions within his own liberal political faith In a land given to celebrating freedom of speech Norton would become a speaker subjected to physical threats for opposing the Spanish American War Among a people given to glorying in its superiority to other civilizations he would become a social critic reviled for arguing that the nation was failing to live up to its own most cherished ideals It would be Norton's misfortune shared with others of his generation to watch the golden promise of a victorious war for the Union fade into the unrepentant cynicism of the Gilded Age Yet Norton's militant idealism and heroic citizenship Dowling argues survive now as a vital parable for American civic liberalism in the present day

When the War Was Over Dan T. Carter, 1985-04-01 In the months after Appomattox the South was plunged into a chaos that surpassed even the disorder of the last hard months of the war itself Peace brought if anything an increased level of violence to the region as local authorities of the former Confederacy were stripped of their power and the returning foot soldiers of the defeated army hungry and without hope raided the already impoverished countryside for food and clothing In the wake of the devastation that followed surrender even some of the most virulent Yankee haters found themselves relieved as the Union army began to bring a small level of order to the lawless southern terrain Dan T Carter's *When the War Was Over* is a social and political history of the two years following the surrender of the Confederacy the so called period of Presidential Reconstruction when the South under the watchful gaze of Congress and the Union army attempted to rebuild its shattered society and economic structure Working primarily from rich manuscript sources Carter draws a vivid portrait of the political leaders who emerged after the war a diverse group of men former loyalists as well as a few mildly repentant fire eaters who in some cases genuinely sought to find a place in southern society for the newly emancipated slaves but who in many other cases merely sought to redesign the boundaries of black servitude Carter finds that as a group the politicians who emerged in the postwar South failed critically in the test of their leadership Not only were they unable to construct a

realistic program for the region's recovery a failure rooted in their stubborn refusal to accept the full consequences of emancipation but their actions also served to exacerbate rather than allay the fears and apprehensions of the victorious North Even so Carter reveals these leaders were not the monsters that many scholars have suggested they were and it is misleading to dismiss them as racists and political incompetents In important ways they represented the most constructive creative and imaginative response that the white South overwhelmed with defeat and social chaos had to offer in 1865 and 1866 Out of their efforts would come the New South movement and with it the final downfall of the plantation system and the beginnings of social justice for the freed slaves

Another Kind of War John A. In the Shadow of the Great Rebellion Gary L. Donhardt, 2007 With the death of Abraham Lincoln on April 15 1865 Andrew Johnson was plunged into a national political morass Johnson a Southern Democrat and advocate of states rights had been chosen as Lincoln's second term running mate Now as Lincoln's successor he faced a most difficult trial a divisiveness that threatened to undo the fabric of a nation desperately trying to mend itself after a great civil strife For this self educated tailor from the hills of Tennessee it would prove to be a formidable task Albeit no stranger to national politics Johnson was ill prepared for this sudden change of fortune Absent from Washington since

1862 he had limited political allies and little ability to foster new ones Adding to his difficulties he was a Democrat serving in a Republican administration and a Southerner in the midst of a victorious North It would have been a daunting task for the ablest of politicians nearly impossible for one lacking political acumen Taking the helm as the 17th President of the United States Johnson continued Lincoln's effort to reconstruct the Union following the Civil War While Congress was in recess he began his restoration process by pardoning many ex Confederates who were willing to take the oath of allegiance and by allowing the Southern states to re-establish their governments But there were radical elements in Congress who bitterly opposed Johnson's approach to Reconstruction They objected to his rapidity in bringing the former Confederate states back into the Union and his reluctance to support suffrage for the freed slaves Likely even Lincoln would have butted up against the same obstacles but Johnson lacked his predecessor's finesse and soon found himself on a collision course with Congress Andrew Johnson learned his craft as a politician as he rose from alderman in an Eastern Tennessee village to president of the United States The Constitution was his fundamental authority and ultimate resource on all questions of state He was an ardent stump speaker and was quite adept at power politics in the halls of Congress Yet as the Chief Executive he showed such little political skill in assessing opposition and conquering obstacles during Reconstruction that the party that put him in the White House ultimately turned from him and he was forced to defend his actions before the bar of the Senate in the country's first presidential impeachment trial Throughout the journey the Tennessee Tailor born in abject poverty fashioned himself as a man of the people He always held a strong empathy for the common man and equally strong antipathy for members of the aristocracy Having come from the lower class mudsill as he referred to himself he carried a deep compassion for the labourer in the workshop as well as the farmer the field This book presents the story of this president The Papers of Andrew Johnson Andrew Johnson, 1967 The Papers of Andrew Johnson Project began in the mid 1950s as part of a larger trend toward projects for the collection and publication of presidential papers The project was headed by University of Tennessee historians LeRoy Graf and Ralph Haskins and led to its conclusion by Paul Bergeron The project became part of the Tennessee Presidents Center in 1987 joining the papers projects of the two other Tennessee presidents Andrew Jackson and James K Polk The first volume of The Papers of Andrew Johnson was published in 1967 and the project was completed on July 31 2000 with the publication of the sixteenth and final volume The entire project covers Johnson's correspondence from 1858 to 1875 **The Politics of Presidential Impeachment** Daniel P. Taratoot, 2020-08-01 The Politics of Presidential Impeachment takes a distinctive and fresh look at the impeachment provision of the US Constitution Instead of studying it from a legal constitutional perspective the authors use a social science approach incorporating extensive case studies and quantitative analysis Focusing on four presidents who faced impeachment processes Andrew Johnson Richard Nixon Ronald Reagan and Bill Clinton they examine the conditions under which presidential impeachment is likely to occur and argue that partisanship and the evolving relationship between Congress and

the president determine its effectiveness as an institutional constraint They find that in our contemporary political context the propensity of Congress to utilize the impeachment tool is more likely but given the state of heightened partisanship impeachment is less likely to result in removal of a president The authors conclude that impeachment is no longer a credible threat and thus no longer an effective tool in the arsenal of checks and balances The book also offers a postscript that discusses the impeachment of President Donald J Trump

The Scalawags James Alex Baggett, 2004-09-01 In The Scalawags James Alex Baggett ambitiously uncovers the genesis of scalawag leaders throughout the former Confederacy Using a collective biography approach Baggett profiles 742 white southerners who supported Congressional Reconstruction and the Republican Party He then compares and contrasts the scalawags with 666 redeemer Democrats who opposed and eventually replaced them Significantly he analyzes this rich data by region the Upper South the Southeast and the Southwest as well as for the South as a whole Baggett follows the life of each scalawag before during and after the war revealing real personalities and not mere statistics Examining such features as birthplace vocation estate slaveholding status education political antecedents and experience stand on secession war record and postwar political activities he finds striking uniformity among scalawags This is the first Southwide study of the scalawags its scope and astounding wealth in quantity and quality of sources make it the definitive work on the subject
