closely associated sport with US nationalism The cultural identity of these runners Sakiestewa Gilbert contends challenged white American perceptions of modernity and did so in a way that had national and international dimensions This broad perspective linked Hopi runners to athletes from around the world including runners from Japan Ireland and Mexico and thus Hopi Runners suggests caused non Natives to reevaluate their understandings of sport nationhood and the cultures of American Indian people
