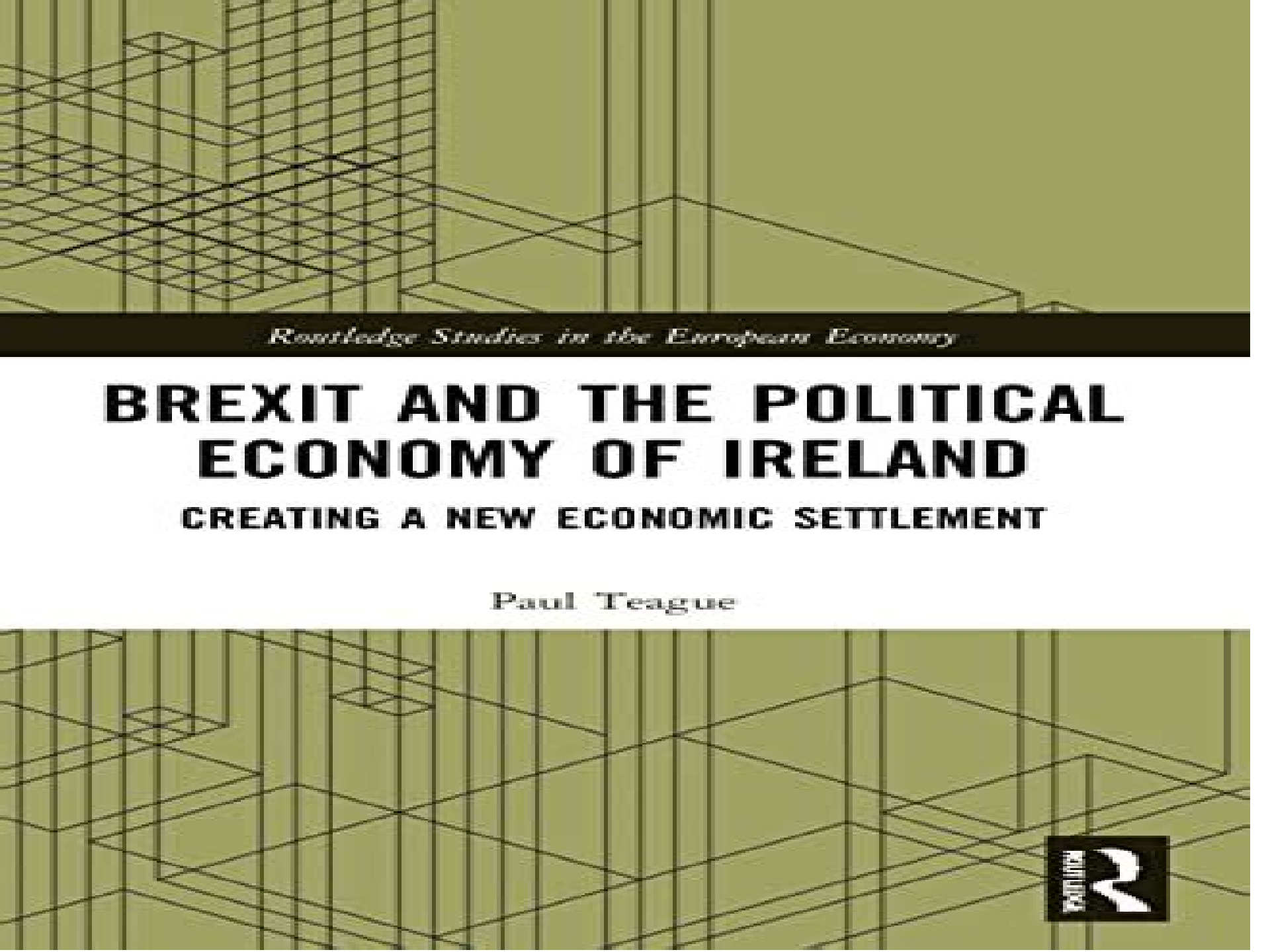

Joyce and the Two Irelands Willard Potts, 2010-01-01 Uniting Catholic Ireland and Protestant Ireland was a central idea of the Irish Revival a literary and cultural manifestation of Irish nationalism that began in the 1890s and continued into the early twentieth century Yet many of the Revival's Protestant leaders including W B Yeats Lady Gregory and John Synge failed to address the profound cultural differences that made uniting the two Irelands so problematic while Catholic leaders of the Revival particularly the journalist D P Moran turned the movement into a struggle for greater Catholic power This book fully explores James Joyce's complex response to the Irish Revival and his extensive treatment of the relationship between the two Irelands in his letters essays book reviews and fiction up to Finnegans Wake Willard Potts skillfully demonstrates that despite his pretense of being an aloof onlooker Joyce was very much a part of the Revival He shows how deeply Joyce was steeped in his whole Catholic culture and how regardless of the harsh way he treats the Catholic characters in his works he almost always portrays them as superior to any Protestants with whom they appear This research recovers the historical and cultural roots of a writer who is too often studied in isolation from the Irish world that formed him

Making Ireland Modern Enda Delaney, 2025-10-02 A provocative and original reinterpretation of modern Irish history There is a widespread misconception that Ireland became modern much later than its neighbours in the 1960s and 1970s This is grounded in several enduring stereotypes and caricatures of Ireland as a timeless and unchanging land of saints and scholars of its society and culture in the long nineteenth century as puritanical regressive or archaic of Gaelic language and culture as backward or inward looking in contrast to a modern English counterpart and of the island as natural and rural in the face of the urban and technological progress of modernity Drawing on an extensive range of sources from poetry and novels to contemporary historical documents acclaimed historian Enda Delaney here offers a reinterpretation of Ireland s encounter with modernity that corrects these stereotypes By situating the island s history between 1780 and 1916 within its broader European global and colonial contexts he demonstrates that Ireland s pathway to modernity was not inevitable belated or uni directional over a complex and centuries long process it was made modern and in its own distinctive way This was related to but distinct from Ireland s complicated colonial relationship with Britain and played out in the broader contexts of globalisation and the rise of capitalism And at the heart of this history are the Irish people themselves both those who lived on the island and the millions of those who left during this period and made their lives in Britain America Australia and beyond who made sense of modernity in a variety of conflicting ways and in so doing sought to shape their own destinies and adapt the old ways of doing things in the face of relentless waves of progress Changes in values consciousness and beliefs interacted with broader social political and cultural revolutions to create a distinctive experience of becoming modern The result is a bold and wide ranging new history of modern Ireland that restores agency to those who lived and made its history raising important and timely questions about modernity globalisation modern history and post colonialism

Reimagining the Nation-State Jim Mac Laughlin, 2001-02-20 This book assesses competing modes of nation building and nationalism through a critical reappraisal of the works of key theorists such as Benedict Anderson and Eric Hobsbawm Exploring the processes of nation building from a variety of ethnic and social class contexts it focuses on the contested terrain within which nationalist ideologies are often rooted Mac Laughlin offers a theoretical and empirical analysis of nation building taking as a case study the historical connections between Ireland and Great Britain in the clash between big nation historic British nationalism on the one hand and minority Irish nationalism on the other Locating the origins of the historic nation in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries Mac Laughlin emphasises the difficulties and specificity of minority nationalism in the nineteenth century In so doing he calls for a place centred approach which recognises the symbolic and socio economic significance of territory to the different scales of nation building Exploring the evolution of Irish Nationalism
