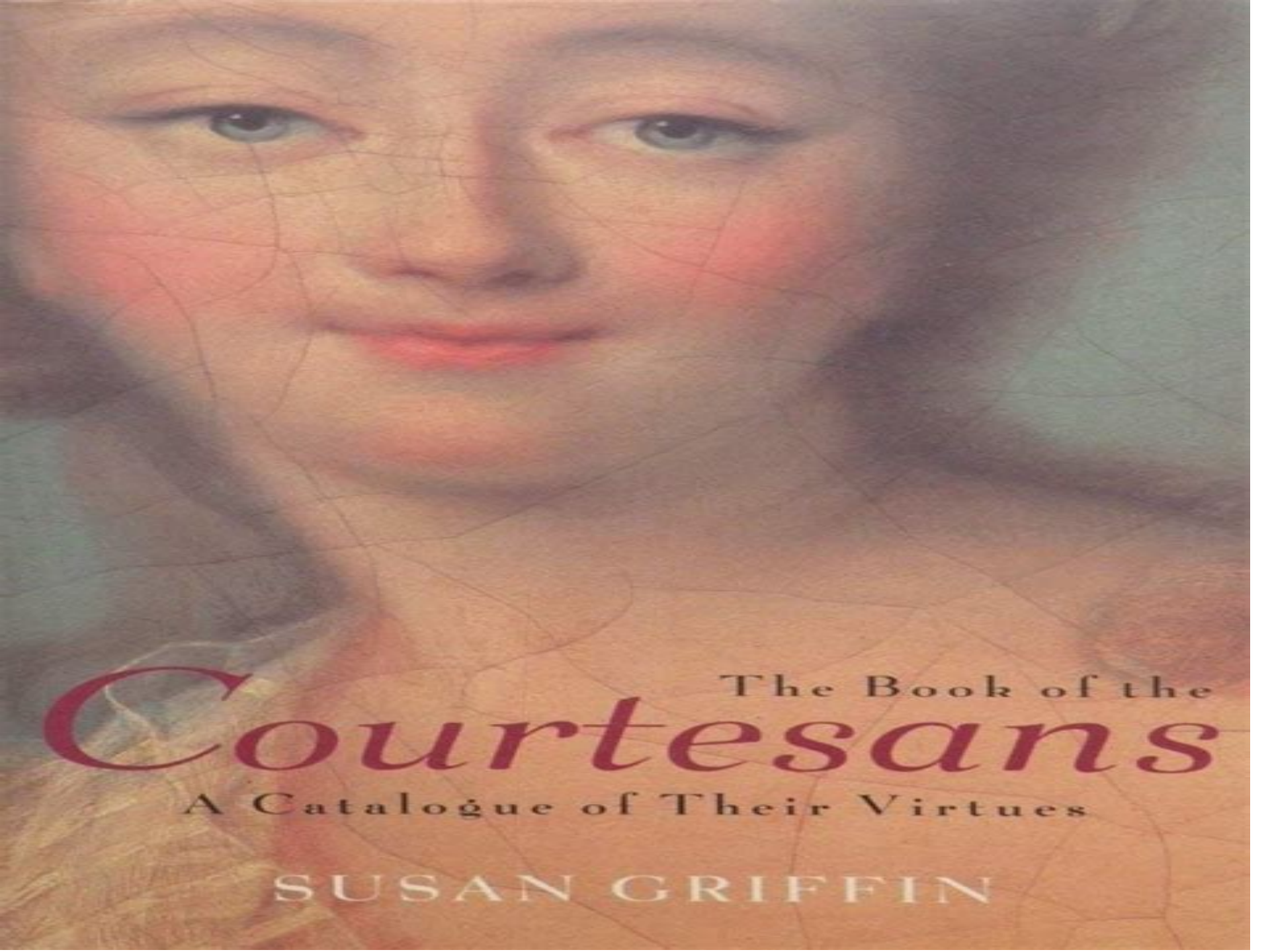

The Book of the Courtesans Susan Griffin, 2001 From Pulitzer Prize nominated author Susan Griffin comes an unprecedented provocative look at the dazzling world of the West's first independent women whose lively liaisons brought them unspoken influence wealth and freedom While they charmed some of Europe's most illustrious men honing their social skills as well as their sexual ones the great courtesans gained riches power education and sexual freedom in a time when other women were denied all of these From Imperia of sixteenth century Rome who personified the Renaissance ideal of beauty Mme de Pompadour the arbiter of all things fashionable in eighteenth century Paris and Versailles Liane de Pougy known in France during the Belle Epoque as Our National Courtesan to Sarah Bernhardt who following in her mother's footsteps supported herself in her early career with a second profession The Book of the Courtesans tells the life stories and intricacies of the lavish lifestyles of these women Unlike their geisha counterparts courtesans neither lived in brothels nor bent their wills to suit their suitors They were strong willed autonomous and plucky An open secret their presence can be felt throughout our culture The muses who enflamed the hearts and imaginations of our most celebrated artists they were also artists in their own right They wrote poetry and novels invented the cancan at the Moulin Rouge and presented celebrated acts at the Folies Bergeres They helped to influence and shape the sensibility of modern literature painting and fashion When Greek sculptor Praxiteles wanted to depict Venus he used a famous courtesan as a model as in later centuries Titian Veronese Raphael Giorgione and Boucher did when they painted goddesses When Marcel Proust was a young man it was the courtesan Laure Hayman who took him under her wing introducing him to the right people and providing inspiration for one of literature's greatest masterpieces And they often had considerable political influence too When King Louis XV needed advice on foreign affairs or appointments of state he turned to Jeanne du Barry as well as Pompadour In her witty and insightful prose as Griffin celebrates these alluring and fascinating women she restores a lost legacy of women's history She gives us the stories of these amazing women who starting from impoverished or unimpressive beginnings garnered chateaux fine coaches fabulous collections of jewelry and even aristocratic titles along the way And through a brilliant exploration of their extraordinary abilities skills and talents which Griffin playfully categorizes as their virtues Timing Beauty Cheek Brilliance Gaiety Grace and Charm her book explains how while helping themselves through their often outrageous always entertaining examples the great courtesans not only enriched our cultural heritage but helped to liberate women from the social sexual and economic strictures that confined them Intensively researched and beautifully crafted The Book of the Courtesans delves into scintillating but often hidden worlds telling stories gleaned from many sources including courtesans memoirs presented along with stunning rare photographs to create memorable portraits of some of the most pivotal figures in women's history

Mossman, 2009-01-01 Writing with a Vengeance examines the life and works of a nineteenth century French courtesan C leste V nard later the Countess de Chabrillan A notorious Paris courtesan Chabrillan married into the nobility taught herself to write penning two series of memoirs and upon being widowed wrote novels to support herself ten between 1857 and 1885 These novels and memoirs constitute exceptional literary and historical documents particularly as very few sex workers before the twentieth century have left written records of their lives Writing with a Vengeance intertwines the courtesan's autobiographical account of the horrors of her life on the streets with that era's political medical and cultural discourses surrounding prostitution Though French society both silenced and refused to pardon the prostitute Carol Mossman's literary analysis of Chabrillan's novels contends that it is through the process of writing itself that she arrived at self forgiveness and ultimately refashioned for her damaged self a new identity and narrative

Mummies, Cannibals and Vampires Richard Sugg, 2015-11-06 Mummies Cannibals and Vampires charts in vivid detail the largely forgotten history of European corpse medicine which saw kings ladies gentlemen priests and scientists prescribe swallow or wear human blood flesh bone fat brains and skin in an attempt to heal themselves of epilepsy bruising wounds sores plague cancer gout and depression In this comprehensive and accessible text Richard Sugg shows that far from being a medieval therapy corpse medicine was at its height during the social and scientific revolutions of early modern Britain surviving well into the eighteenth century and amongst the poor lingering stubbornly on into the time of Queen Victoria Ranging from the execution scaffolds of Germany and Scandinavia through the courts and laboratories of Italy France and Britain to the battlefields of Holland and Ireland and on to the tribal man eating of the Americas Mummies Cannibals and Vampires argues that the real cannibals were in fact the Europeans Picking our way through the bloodstained shadows of this remarkable secret history we encounter medicine cut from bodies living and dead sacks of human fat harvested after a gun battle gloves made of human skin and the first mummy to appear on the London stage Lit by the uncanny glow of a lamp filled with human blood this second edition includes new material on exo cannibalism skull medicine the blood drinking of Scandinavian executions Victorian corpse stroking and the magical powers of candles made from human fat In our quest to understand the strange paradox of routine Christian cannibalism we move from the Catholic vampirism of the Eucharist through the routine filth and discomfort of early modern bodies and in to the potent numinous source of corpse medicine's ultimate power the

human soul itself Now accompanied by a companion website with supplementary articles interviews with the author related images summaries of key topics and a glossary the second edition of *Mummies Cannibals and Vampires* is an essential read for anyone interested in the history of medicine early modern history and the darker hidden past of European Christendom

The Anthology in Portugal Patricia Anne Odber de Baubeta, 2007 This book breaks new ground in considering the nature and function of anthologies of poetry and short stories in twentieth century Portugal It tackles the main theoretical issues identifies a significant body of critical writing on the relationship between anthologies literary history and the canon and proposes an approach that might be designated Descriptive Anthology Studies The author aims to achieve a full understanding of the role of anthologies in the literary polysystem Moreover this study considers anthologies published in Portugal in the early years of the twentieth century the influential figures who made them the works they selected and who read them It also focuses on the principal publishing houses of the 1940s and 50s and how their literary directors shaped public taste and promoted intercultural transfer The author reveals tensions between conservative nostalgic anthologies that promote an idyllic vision of rural Portugal and collections of poems that question and challenge the status quo whether in respect of the colonial wars or repressed female sexuality The last part of the book explores anthology production in the period following the Revolution of 1974 observing the co existence of traditional anthologising activity with new trends and innovations and noting the role of women both as anthologists and anthology items

Sexting Judith Davidson, 2015-01-20 *Sexting Gender and Teens* provides a close up look into the intimate and gendered world of teens and those who live with and work with them The author draws upon interviews with teens parents and caregivers and many others who work with teens from teachers and youth workers to principals and police we learn how the new digital world is still permeated by beliefs and patterns of earlier patriarchal structures This three state study reveals there are significant gendered differences among teens in their perspectives on sexting and these differences have implications for how to respond to the issue of teen sexting Adults too demonstrate gendered differences in their views on teen sexting and these differences have an important impact on the shaping of youth views about gender and sexuality As one mother said Girls set the pace and boys notch the bedpost Some key findings include The human curriculum of sexuality is both conserving and adapting and these two impulses are always interacting We are in the midst of social and technological changes that have vast implications for all of our cultural notions including sexuality Regarding sexting Adults are pointing fingers in many directions and leaving adolescents to fend for themselves This compelling account presented through the words of participants provides a vivid introduction to hands on social research that will be of interest to those in gender and women s studies as well as the broader disciplines that touch upon these concerns such as sociology education psychology media studies criminal justice and other fields Sure to spark strong opinions and discussion the book offers opportunities for sustained engagement with topics of critical interest to today s digital world Judith Davidson Ph D is an associate professor in the Graduate School of Education at
