The Business Strategy of Booker T. Washington Michael B. Boston, 2010-08-29 Michael Boston offers a radical departure from other interpretations of Booker T. Washington by focusing on the latter's business ideas and practices. More specifically, Boston examines Washington as an entrepreneur, spelling out his business philosophy at great length and discussing the influence it had on black America. He analyzes the national and regional economies in which Washington worked and focuses on his advocacy of black business development as the key to economic uplift for African Americans. The result is a revisionist book that responds to the skewed literature on Washington even as it offers a new framework for understanding him. Based upon a deep reading of the Tuskegee archives, it acknowledges Washington not only as a champion of black business development but one who conceived and implemented successful strategies to promote it as well. The Business Strategy of Booker T. Washington makes abundantly clear that Washington was not an accommodationist; it will be required reading for any future discussion of this titan of history.

History of the Mosaic Templars of America Aldridge Edward Bush, P. L. Dorman, 2008-01-01 This is a reprint of classic history of an important African American organization. Originally published in 1924 and long out of print, this book tells the story of the Mosaic Templars of America (MTA), a famous black fraternal organization that was founded by two former slaves in Little Rock, Arkansas, in the late nineteenth century. The organization originally provided illness, death, and burial insurance during an era of segregation when few basic services were available to black people. By 1900, Mosaic Templars' industries grew to include an insurance company, a building and loan association, a publishing company, a business college, a nursing school, and a hospital. By 1905, it had a number of lodges across the state with thousands of members. Its headquarters were housed in a handsome new building that opened in 1913. Booker T. Washington delivered the dedication speech. In the 1920s, they claimed chapters in twenty-six states and six foreign countries, making it one of the largest black organizations in the world. However, in the 1930s, the MTA began to feel the effects of the Great Depression and eventually ceased operations. However, a single chapter remains in Barbados. The headquarters building burned down in 2005, and this book is being published to coincide with the grand opening of a completely rebuilt structure that will house the new Mosaic Templars Cultural Center.

From Slavery to Uncertain Freedom Randy Finley, 1996 As African Americans in Arkansas emerged from slavery in the aftermath of the Civil War and the Emancipation Proclamation, it was the job of the Federal Freedmen's Bureau to help them build bridges to freedom. The bureau supported former slaves as they assumed new names, searched for lost family members, moved to new homes, worked to provide for their families, learned to read and write, formed and attended their own churches, created their own histories and myths, and struggled to obtain land. Crockett,2021-10-08 From Appomattox to World War I blacks continued their quest for a secure position in the American system The problem was how to be both black and American how to find acceptance or even toleration in a society in which the boundaries of normative behavior the values and the very definition of what it meant to be an American were determined and enforced by whites A few black leaders proposed self segregation inside the United States within the protective confines of an all black community as one possible solution The Black town idea reached its peak in the fifty years after the civil War at least sixty Black communities were settled between 1865 and 1915 Norman L Crockett has focused on the formation growth and failure of five such communities The towns and the date of their settlement are Nicodemus Kansas 1879 established at the time of the Black exodus from the South Mound Bayou Mississippi 1897 perhaps the most prominent black town because of its close ties to Booker T Washington and Tuskegee Institute Langston Oklahoma 1891 visualized by one of its promoters as the nucleus for the creation of an all Black state in the West and Clearview 1903 and Boley 1904 in Oklahoma twin communities in the Creek Nation which offer the opportunity observe certain aspects of Indian Black relations in this area The role of Black people in town promotion and settlement has long been a neglected area in western and urban history Crockett looks at patterns of settlement and leadership government politics economics and the problems of isolation versus interaction with the white communities He also describes family life social life and class structure within the Black towns Crockett looks closely at the rhetoric and behavior of Black people inside the limits of their own community isolated from the domination of whites and freed from the daily reinforcement of their subordinate rank in the larger society He finds that long before Black is beautiful entered the American vernacular Black town residents exhibited a strong sense of

race price The reader observes in microcosm Black attitudes about many aspects of American life as Crockett ties the Black town experience to the larger question of race relations at the turn of the century This volume also explains the failure of the Black town dream Crockett cites discrimination lack of capital and the many forces at work in the local regional and national economies He shows how the racial and town building experiment met its demise as the residents of all Black communities became both economically and psychologically trapped This study adds valuable new material to the literature on Black history and makes a significant contribution to American social and urban history community studies and the regional history of Kansas Oklahoma and Mississippi
