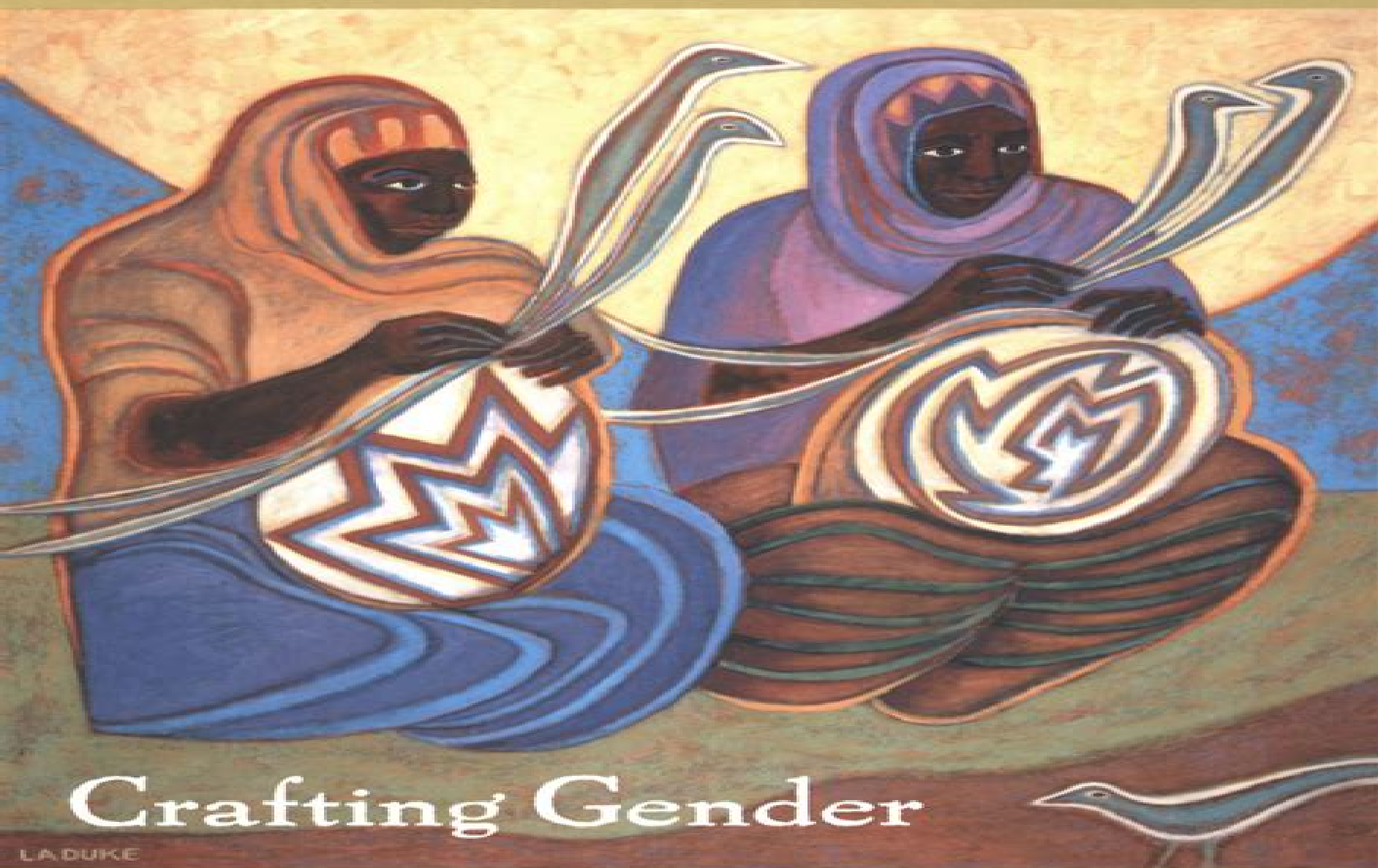

Weaving the Past offers a comprehensive and interdisciplinary history of Latin America s indigenous women While the book concentrates on native women in Mesoamerica and the Andes it covers indigenous people in other parts of South and Central America including lowland peoples in and beyond Brazil and Afro indigenous peoples such as the Garifuna of Central America Drawing on primary and secondary sources it argues that change not continuity has been the norm for indigenous peoples whose resilience in the face of complex and long term patterns of cultural change is due in no small part to the roles actions and agency of women The book provides broad coverage of gender roles in native Latin America over many centuries drawing upon a range of evidence from archaeology anthropology religion and politics Primary and secondary sources include chronicles codices newspaper articles and monographic work on specific regions Arguing that Latin America s indigenous women were the critical force behind the more important events and processes of Latin America s history Kellogg interweaves the region s history of family sexual and labor history with the origins of women s power in prehispanic colonial and modern South and Central America Shying away from interpretations that treat women as house bound and passive the book instead emphasizes women s long history of performing labor being politically active and contributing to even supporting family and community well being Fair Trade and Social Justice Mark Moberg, Sarah Lyon, 2010-06-01 By 2008 total Fair Trade purchases in the developed world reached nearly 3 billion a five fold increase in four years Consumers pay a fair price for Fair Trade items which are meant to generate greater earnings for family farmers cover the costs of production and support socially just and environmentally sound practices Yet constrained by existing markets and the entities that dominate them Fair Trade often delivers material improvements for producers that are much more modest than the profound social transformations the movement claims to support There has been scant real world assessment of Fair Trade s effectiveness Drawing upon fine grained anthropological studies of a variety of regions and commodity systems including Darjeeling tea coffee crafts and cut flowers the chapters in Fair Trade and Social Justice represent the first works to use

Szkol, 2012 Popular art is a masculine and working class genre associated with Panama's black population Its practitioners are self taught commercial painters whose high toned designs vibrant portraits and landscapes appear in cantinas barbershops and restaurants The red devil buses are popular art's most visible manifestation The old school buses are

imported from the United States and provide public transportation in Col n and Panama City Their owners hire the artists to attract customers with eye catching depictions of singers and actors brassy phrases and vivid representations of both local and exotic panoramas The red devils boast powerful stereo systems and dominate the urban environment with their blasting reggae screeching brakes horns sirens whistles and roaring mufflers Wolf Tracks analyzes the origins of these practices tying them to rebellious Afro American festival traditions and to the rumba craze of the mid twentieth century During World War II thousands of U S soldiers were stationed in Panama and elaborately decorated cabarets opened to cater to their presence These venues often featured touring Afro Cuban musicians Painters such as Luis The Wolf Evans exploited such moments of modernization to challenge the elite and its older conception of Panama as a country with little connection to Africa While the intellectual class fled from modernization and asserted a romantic and mestizo European indigenous vision of the republic popular artists enthusiastically embraced the new influences to project a powerful sense of blackness Wolf Tracks includes biographies of dozens of painters as well as detailed discussions of mestizo nationalism soccer reggae and other markers of Afro Panamanian identity

Insurgent Beauty Peter Szok, 2025-10-02 *Insurgent Beauty* Indigenous Art in Urban Panama examines artistic and political developments from 1968 to the present exploring how Native American artists leveraged Panama's populist military reforms from 1968 to 1989 and the subsequent neoliberal transition to assert their presence in society Breaking new ground the book situates Indigenous art in previously overlooked contexts Historically scholars of Latin American Indigenous artistic expression have focused on elements regarded as rural based crafts such as weavings ceramics oral literature and carvings Drawing inspiration from scholars Philip Deloria and Gerald Vizenor this study turns to urban art forms including jazz modern dance hip hop drama studio art photography and film Author Peter Szok concentrates on the Guna formerly Kuna people who were the earliest Indigenous migrants to Panama City and who are famous across the Americas for their geometrically patterned mola fabrics Szok argues that the molas are just one aspect of Guna artistic culture and that the rise of more urban manifestations is part of a process of ethnic resurgence

Millennial Ecuador Norman E Whitten, 2003-12 In the past decade Ecuador has seen five indigenous uprisings the emergence of the powerful Pachakutik political movement and the strengthening of the Confederation of Indigenous Nationalities of Ecuador and the Association of Black Ecuadorians all of which have contributed substantially to a new constitution proclaiming the country to be multiethnic and multicultural Furthermore January 2003 saw the inauguration of a new populist president who immediately appointed two indigenous persons to his cabinet In this volume eleven critical essays plus a lengthy introduction and a timely epilogue explore the multicultural forces that have allowed Ecuador's indigenous peoples to have such dramatic effects on the nation's political structure
