



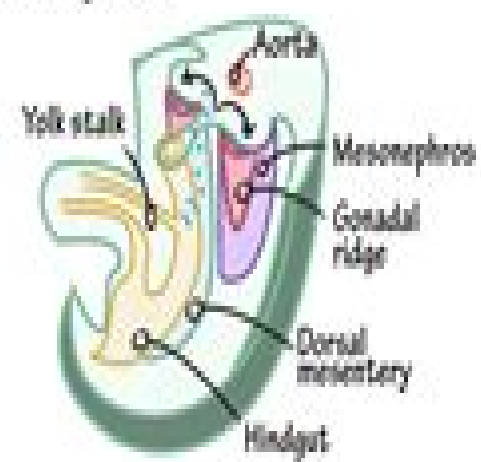

Undifferentiated Stage

- ✓ Primordial germ cells migrate to posterior body wall.
- ✓ Gonadal ridges form.



Embryological Origins

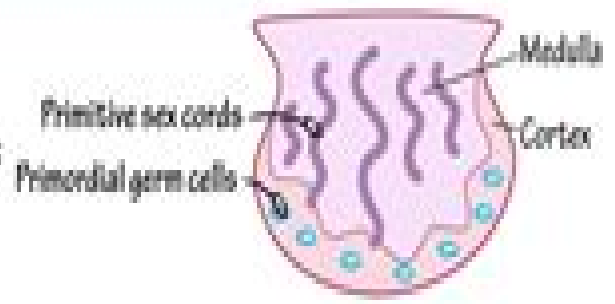
Primordial germ cells	Oogonia

Week 8+ — Ovary Differentiation

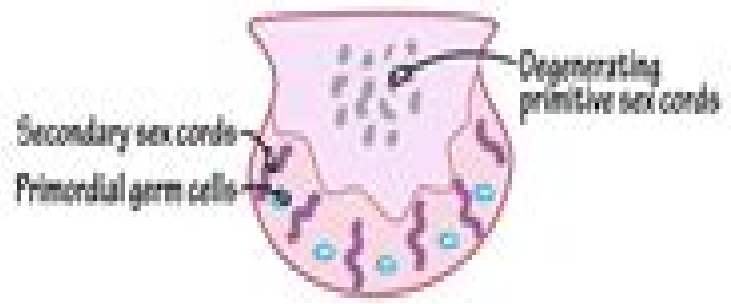
1. Primitive Sex Cords

- Arrival of primordial germ cells induces formation of primitive sex cords;
- Gonadal ridge forms with medullary and cortical regions.



2. Secondary Sex Cords

- Primitive sex cords degenerate.



3. Cell Nests

- Primordial germ cells -> oogonia
- Oogonia -> oocytes
- Secondary sex cords dissociate & form follicular cells.



4. Ovarian Follicles

- Cell nests break apart
- Follicular cells surround individual oocytes
