supposed period of four hundred years of prophetic silence is not supported by the biblical or historical evidence Finally an epilogue sketches the historical and theological situation prevailing at the death of Herod in 4 BC providing important context for the New Testament writings In this way the book bridges the Old and New Testaments by providing a historical and theological understanding of the five centuries leading up to the birth of Jesus tracking a biblical theology through them and abolishing the notion of a four century prophetic silence

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
