2. The changing lives of Black Americans 1877-1900

Black Americans continued to live in poverty after the end of Reconstruction

- America's economic development between 1877 and 1900 created opportunities for some Black Americans but the majority continued to live in poverty and faced discrimination.
- The freedoms of the Reconstruction Era were being eroded.
- In the 1890s, civil rights campaigners such as **Frederick Douglass** and **Ida B. Wells** campaigned for the rights of Black people.

Ida B. Wells

- Ida was born as an enslaved person in 1862 and got an education thanks to the Freedmen's Bureau.
- She became a teacher and moved to Tennessee.
- She sued a train company in 1884 when the train crew ordered her to move to a carriage for Black Americans – her case was overturned by the highest court in Tennessee.
- As a journalist she travelled across the US and raised awareness about poor treatment of Black Americans including quality of education and lynchings.
- Ida B. Wells became a founding member of the NAACP in 1909.

experience at all and that many of these outside groups embodied values that were in fact quintessentially American

Lacey, 2007 This examination of illustrations in early American books pamphlets magazines almanacs and broadsides provides a new perspective on the social cultural and political environment of the late colonial period and the early republic American printers and engravers drew upon a rich tradition of Christian visual imagery Used first to inculcate Protestant doctrines regional symbolism later served to promote reverence for the new republic The chapters are devoted to momento mori imagery children s readers visionary literature and illustrated Bibles One chapter shows the demonization of the Indians even as the Indian was being adopted as a symbol of America Other chapters deal with propaganda for the American Revolution canonization of leaders secularized roles for women and socialization of sites in the new nation Throughout analysis of image and text shows how the religious and the secular contrasted coexisted and intermingled in eighteenth century American illustrated imprints Barbara E Lacey is a Professor of history at St Joseph College It includes more than 110 illustrations

The Early Modern Production of Missionary Books on Indigenous Languages in New Spain and Peru Zanna Loon, 2025-10-01 How do the social material and spatial processes underlying the making of early modern missionary grammars vocabularies and devotional translations deepen our understanding of their contents The handwritten and printed missionary books produced in the Spanish viceroyalties of New Spain and Peru were key instruments designed to help study Indigenous languages in order to efficiently teach religious doctrine to local communities unfamiliar with European culture and religion This volume considers these missionary books as physical and social objects and illuminates how a variety of factors determines their physical appearance structure and form which in turn shape and guide the interpretation of their contents people involved in its making geographical and social circumstances and conditions of production technologies materials and tools genre and function s of the books and intended readership modes of distribution and readerly responses

To Make this Land Our Own Arlin C. Migliazzo, 2007 A case study in the social history of frontier town building set in the swamps of South Carolina On the banks of the lower Savannah River the military objectives of South Carolina officials the ambitions of Swiss entrepreneur Jean Pierre Purry and the dreams of Protestants from Switzerland France Germany Italy and England converged in a planned settlement named Purrysburg This examination of the first South Carolina township in Governor Robert Johnson s strategic plan to populate and defend the colonial backcountry offers the clearest picture to date of the settlement of the colony s Southern frontier by ethnically diverse and contractually obligated immigrants Arlin C Migliazzo contends that the story of Purrysburg Township founded in 1732 and set in the forbidding environment bounded by the Savannah River and the Coosawhatchie swamps challenges the notion that white colonists shed their ethnic distinctions to become a monolithic culture He views Purrysburg as a laboratory in which to observe ethnic phenomena in the colonial and antebellum South Separated by linguistic religious and cultural barriers the migr s adapted familiar social processes from their homelands to create a workable sense of community and identity His

work is one of only a handful of examples of what has been deemed the new social history methodology as applied to a South Carolina subject Initially devastated by privation and a high mortality rate Purrysburg residents also suffered the vicissitudes of an indifferent provincial elite the encroachment of lowcountry rice planters Prevost's invasion in 1779 and ultimate destruction of the settlement by Sherman's army Migliazzo details the community's changing military and economic fortunes the gradual displacement of its residents to neighboring communities the role of African Americans in the region the complex religious life of township settlers and the quirky contributions of Purry's climatological speculations to the fateful siting of this first township

Making Americans Desmond S. King, 2002-06-15 In the nineteenth century virtually anyone could get into the United States But by the 1920s U S immigration policy had become a finely filtered regime of selection Desmond King looks at this dramatic shift and the debates behind it for what they reveal about the construction of an American identity Specifically the debates in the three decades leading up to 1929 were conceived in terms of desirable versus undesirable immigrants This not only cemented judgments about specific European groups but reinforced prevailing biases against groups already present in the United States particularly African Americans whose inferior status and second class citizenship enshrined in Jim Crow laws and embedded in pseudo scientific arguments about racial classifications appear to have been consolidated in these decades Although the values of different groups have always been recognized in the United States King gives the most thorough account yet of how eugenic arguments were used to establish barriers and to favor an Anglo Saxon conception of American identity rejecting claims of other traditions Thus the immigration controversy emerges here as a significant precursor to recent multicultural debates Making Americans shows how the choices made about immigration policy in the 1920s played a fundamental role in shaping democracy and ideas about group rights in America
