The authors primary aim in writing this book was based on the confidence that a relevant reference between the encyclopedic nature of some and the specific subject matter of others could be used to provide fundamental information for management of public as well as private gardens The boundary between botanical and zoological gardens and parks is no longer as distinct as it once was In part it is because a garden is not a garden without plants and in part it has become apparent that for all practical intents and purposes all animals need plants for their survival Visitors of zoological gardens expect to see more than just animals zoos are landscaped grounds Moreover most communities find it financially difficult to simultaneously operate a botanical garden or an arboretum as well as a zoological garden and city parks A number of public gardens are currently referred to as
