Bligh's Other Mutiny Arthur Hawkey, 1975 Captain Bligh of the Bounty has come down through the years as the archetypal naval tyrant all that was brutal among Britain's eighteenth century sea commanders This popular conception of his is not new it was first fostered by an influential relative of one of the mutineers who was saved from the hangman's rope In modern times the image has been reinforced by imaginative film versions of the Bounty uprising This book shows that the real Bligh although a man of explosive temperament was by the standards of his time a reasonably considerate officer who did not make excessive use of the lash a common punishment at the time in the royal Navy But he expected from others total obedience to his authority as he in his turn gave complete obedience to the authority of his superior officers Disobedience and indiscipline he could not and would not tolerate either in himself or in his men It was this inflexible streak that again cast William Bligh as the victim of a more serious but comparatively little known army rebellion when he became Governor of New South Wales in 1805 and the author unfolds these stirring events that reached their climax in London when Lieutenant Colonel George Johnston was court martialled for mutiny Bligh's whole career was revealed under the Colonel's searching cross examination that Bligh's record withstood this intense court room onslaught is vindication in itself of a much maligned man The author draws on contemporary accounts and diaries to build up a fascinating picture of a difficult but essentially just man and at the same time reflects the wider struggles of a small colony in its efforts to achieve statehood **Captain**

Bligh's Other Mutiny, 2004 **Captain Bligh's Other Mutiny** Stephen Dando-Collins, 2007 The rollicking story of two powerful and colourful men and the only military coup in Australian history William Bligh is famous as captain of the Bounty the ship he lost to mutineers led by Fletcher Christian But few people know that Bligh was the centre of a later much larger mutiny when he lost not just a ship but the entire continent of Australia On January 26 1808 the British army corps stationed in Australia rose up and deposed the British governor Locking him up a cabal of military officers and colonists ran Australia as their private kingdom for the next two years The deposed imprisoned governor was none other than William Bligh by this time famous for the Bounty affair and for fighting heroically under Admiral Nelson The British Government had thought Bligh's reputation as a tough no nonsense man and war hero equipped him for the job in Australia But it was Bligh's reputation as the Bounty Bastard that preceded him to the colony John Macarthur and his friends among the officers of the New South Wales Corps joked about it and prepared to send yet another inept governor number 4 home in disgrace Captain Bligh's Other Mutiny shares the story of two powerful and colourful men Captain Bligh and John Macarthur bent on mutual destruction a goal both achieved Stephen Dando Collins shares the story of Bligh's house arrest for a year on the site that is now the Museum of Sydney his blockade on a ship off the coast of Tasmania for another twelve months his rescue by Colonel Macquarie and Bligh's pursuit of justice through the London courts **Mr Bligh's Bad Language** Greg Denning, 1994-03-25 Captain Bligh and the mutiny on the Bounty have become proverbial in their capacity to evoke the extravagant and violent

abuse of power But William Bligh was one of the least violent disciplinarians in the British navy It is this paradox which inspired Greg Denning to ask why the mutiny took place His book explores the theatrical nature of what was enacted in the power play on deck on the beaches at Tahiti and in the murderous settlement at Pitcairn on the altar stones and temples of sacrifice and on the catheads from which men were hanged Part of the key lies in the curious puzzle of Mr Bligh's bad language
