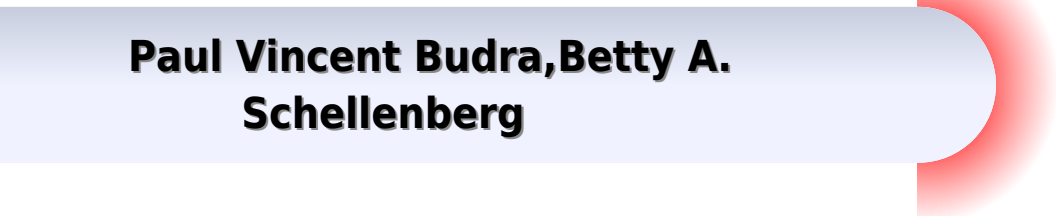

Bliss Carman Quest Revolt:

Bliss Carman Gerald Lynch,1990 The tarnished reputation of this turn of the century poet is persuasively burnished anew by fifteen scholars editors and poets Published in English *The Picturesque and the Sublime* Susan Glickman,2000 Winner of the Gabrielle Roy Prize in English and the Raymond Klibansky Prize *The Picturesque and the Sublime* is a cultural history of two hundred years of nature writing in Canada from eighteenth century prospect poems to contemporary encounters with landscape Arguing against the received wisdom made popular by Northrop Frye and Margaret Atwood that Canadian writers view nature as hostile Susan Glickman places Canadian literature in the English and European traditions of the sublime and the picturesque Glickman argues that early immigrants to Canada brought with them the expectation that nature would be grand mysterious awesome even terrifying and welcomed scenes that conformed to these notions of sublimity She contends that to interpret their descriptions of nature as negative as so many critics have done is a significant misunderstanding Glickman provides close readings of several important works including Susanna Moodie's *Enthusiasm* Charles G D Roberts's *Ave* and Paulette Jiles's *Song to the Rising Sun* and explores the poems in the context of theories of nature and art Instead of projecting backward from a modernist perspective Glickman reads forward from the discovery of landscape as a legitimate artistic subject in seventeenth century England and argues that picturesque modes of description and a sublime aesthetic have governed much of the representation of nature in this country Susan Glickman is a poet living in Toronto She is the author of *Complicity The Power to Move* Henry Moore's *Sheep* and *Other Poems* and *Hide and Seek*

When Canadian Literature Moved to New York Nicholas James Mount,Nick Mount,2005-01-01 Canadian literature was born in New York City It began not in the backwoods of Ontario or the salt flats of New Brunswick but in the cafés publishing offices and boarding houses of late nineteenth century New York where writing developed as a profession and where the groundwork for the Canadian canon was laid So argues Nick Mount in *When Canadian Literature Moved to New York* The last decades of the nineteenth century saw an extraordinary exodus from English Canada draining the country of half its writers and all but a few of its contemporary and future literary celebrities Motivated by powerful obstacles to a domestic literature most of these migrants landed in New York by the 1890s the centre of the continental literary market and found for the first time a large receptive literary market and recognition from non Canadian publishers and reviewers While the expatriates of the 1880s and 1890s including Bliss Carman Ernest Thompson Seton and Palmer Cox were recognized for their achievements in Canada the domestic literature they themselves spurred into existence rekindled a nationalist imperative to distinguish Canadian writing from other literatures especially American and this slowly eliminated most of their work from the emerging English Canadian canon *When Canadian Literature Moved to New York* is the story of these expatriate writers who they were why they left what they achieved and how they changed Canadian literary history "I wish to keep a record" Gail G. Bentley, 2013-12-11 As one of the formative periods in Canadian history the late nineteenth century witnessed the birth of a nation a people and a literature In this study of Canada's first school of poets D M R Bentley combines archival work including extensive research in periodicals and newspapers with close readings of the work of Charles G D Roberts Archibald Lampman Bliss Carman William Wilfred Campbell Duncan Campbell Scott and Frederick George Scott Bentley chronicles the formation reception national and international successes and eventual disintegration after the 1895 War Among the Poets of the Confederation Group whose poetry forever changed the perception and direction of Canadian literature With the aid of biographical political and sociological analyses Bentley's literary history delineates the group's political aesthetic and thematic dispositions and characteristics and contextualizes them not only within Canadian history and politics but also within contemporary intellectual and literary currents including Romantic nationalism Canadianism and poetic formalism Bentley casts new light on the poets commonalities such as their debt to Young Ireland their commitment to careful workmanship and their participation in the American mind cure movement as well as on their most accomplished and anthologized poems from 1880 to 1897 In the process he presents a compelling case for the literary and historical importance of these six men and their poems in light of Canada's cultural and political past and defends their right to be known as Canada's first poetic fraternity at a time when Canada was striving to achieve literary and national distinction *The Confederation Group of Canadian Poets 1880 1897* is an erudite and innovative work of literary history and critical interpretation that belongs on the bookshelf of every serious scholar of literary studies

New Brunswick at the Crossroads Tony Tremblay, 2017-10-25 What is the relationship between literature and the society in which it incubates Are there common political social and economic factors that predominate during periods of heightened literary activity *New Brunswick at the Crossroads Literary Ferment and Social Change in the East* considers these questions and explores the relationships between periods of creative ferment in New Brunswick and the socio cultural conditions of

those times The province's literature is ideally suited to such a study because of its bicultural character in both English and French periods of intense literary creativity occurred at different times and for different reasons What emerges is a cultural geography in New Brunswick that has existed not in isolation from the rest of Canada but often at the creative forefront of imagined alternatives in identity and citizenship At a time when cultural industries are threatened by forces that seek to negate difference and impose uniformity New Brunswick at the Crossroads provides an understanding of the intersection of cultures and social economies contributing to critical discussions about what constitutes the creative in Canadian society especially in rural non central spaces like New Brunswick

Parkin William Christian, 2008-09-09 George Parkin was born the thirteenth child of an immigrant New Brunswick farmer and died a knight of the realm and perhaps the most famous Canadian in the world Charismatic charming eloquent and dedicated Parkin devoted his immense energy to two causes As an orator and journalist he worked to strengthen the bonds between the English speaking peoples as Principal of Upper Canada College and Founding Secretary of the Rhodes Scholarships he promoted a vision of education primarily as the formation of character not the training of the intellect This beautifully written and witty biography is a story of ideas lived through Parkin and those in his wide circle of influence with leaders of many countries He was one of the first Canadians to see the development of globalization and produced that famous map to demonstrate his vision the British Empire all in red Canada huge and dominating in the centre His passionate opposition to free trade and eventual annexation by the United States mark him as an eloquent and prophetic visionary of Canada s fate under NAFTA Author William Christian s own life in Parkin s footsteps and rich sensitivity to Parkin s story is on full display in this masterful biography Political science professor at University of Guelph well known journalist and
