Building Dutch Air Power in World War II Nicholas

Michael Sambaluk, 2025-01-17 During World War II the United States earned the nickname the arsenal of democracy due to its sheer productive output which included over 3 000 000 trucks and jeeps 86 000 tanks 6 750 naval platforms 300 000 aircraft of all types It was also the arsenal of democracy in a second sense as a large portion of that hardware was supplied to countries fighting fascism When Franklin D Roosevelt introduced the Lend Lease Act Allied countries of the antifascist coalition were supplied with aid hardware and food Beyond material aid the United States also hosted and trained over 20 000 foreign pilots and aircrew between 1941 and 1945 This book presents the history of one such training program where 532 Dutch pilots crew and other personnel were trained on United States soil over 21 months With the Japanese army intent

on invading the Netherlands East Indies it was critical that the Dutch army strengthen their air power. When resistance fell on the NEI island of Java and Australia became the new front line, Dutch authorities were forced to relocate their training program to Jackson, Mississippi, where they christened the Royal Netherlands Military Flying School. From there they trained on bases in over a dozen states representing a high point for the Dutch air force during a grueling time. After their training, the RNMFS participated in the liberation of NEI from Japanese occupation. This history presents in full context the training of Dutch air personnel on U.S. soil under the Lend Lease Act, their easy rapport with their American hosts, and their efforts to establish the Netherlands as an integral part of the Allied cause.

Catalina over Arctic

Oceans John French, 2013-02-05. John French first took up flying in 1937 with the University of London Air Squadron and in 1938 joined the Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve. His early war years were spent instructing newly recruited RAF pilots on Airspeed Oxfords and Avro Ansons. When the end of this posting came through, he was designated to 210 Squadron at Sullom Voe in the Shetlands to fly the Catalina flying boat. In November 1942, the squadron was ordered south to join 202 Squadron at Gibraltar. Here they flew sorties in support of the North African landings, Operation Torch. These were lengthy flights out into the Atlantic, approaches to Gibraltar or eastwards into the Mediterranean. He flew fifteen sorties in this short period before returning to Pembroke Dock. He was then instructed to report to Felixstowe to collect Catalina IB FP 222 and to ferry it up to his new base Sullom Voe. From this northern base, the flying boats flew thirty-hour patrols out into the Northern Atlantic, searching for enemy ships and U-boats. On 8 September, he was ordered to execute an extended search of the Norwegian coast where it was thought that the Tirpitz and Scharnhorst were seeking shelter. Having unsuccessfully searched the entire coastline at low level, they finally touched down on the Kola Inlet after a flight of over twenty-two hours. As February 1944 came towards its end, he was detailed to cover a Russian convoy, JW57, far up to the north of the Arctic Circle. Shortly before his ETA with the convoy, they got a radar return. They dropped down below the cloud to find a rough, angry sea and spotted the wake of a ship. However, this was not a ship but a surfaced U-boat. As they flew into attack, they met a hail of 37mm and machine gun fire. John dropped to attack level and came in from the stern, dropping two depth charges. Thus came the demise of U-601. On 18 July 1944, a Liberator of 86 Squadron was set on fire during an attack on a U-boat and was forced to ditch some 100 miles west of the Lofoten Islands. Eight members of the crew took to their dinghies. A Catalina was despatched on a search and rescue mission the following day but failed to find the victims. However, on 20 July they were resighted. A volunteer crew was hastily formed and took off at 0130 on the 21st. Some excellent navigation brought the survivors into view at ETA. John decided to attempt a sea landing to effect the rescue. He came in low into the wind and across the swell at 65 knots. His crew soon had the stranded airman aboard, somewhat bedraggled after their sixty-two-hour ordeal. They landed back at Sullom

at 1410 After the war John stayed in the RAF and spent much of his time behind the Iron Curtain

Operation KE Dennis R Letourneau, J. A. R Letourneau, 2012-11-15 Operation KE explores the air combat that attended the Japanese evacuation of Guadalcanal in early 1943 a topic which has hitherto received very little attention Operation KE was successful largely because Japanese strategic planning and tactical execution was basically sound The traditional view holds that the Japanese got away with the initiative largely because the Americans let them the US Pacific high command felt it was not worth the effort to try and stop them Letourneau contends that this was not entirely the case He argues that the Cactus Air Force and Guadalcanal based naval units did their best to disrupt the evacuation still believing

that the Tokyo Express was bringing reinforcements and supplies to the 17th Army Other US forces in the South Pacific did make a half hearted and questionably executed attempt to stop the Japanese but were bluffed into adopting a wait and see posture Operation KE focuses on the air war fought between the Cactus and US 13th Air Forces on the one hand and the Japanese Navy and Army Air Forces on the other from mid December 1942 to mid February 1943 The book scrutinizes the US air strikes against the six KE related Tokyo Express destroyer runs plus related air strikes against the Japanese merchant marine as well as air and naval base suppression missions undertaken by both sides to determine what actually happened in order to analyze why the Japanese evacuation succeeded and why Cactus failed to stop it Background chapters attempt to assess the respective states of readiness of the Japanese and US air arms in the South Pacific to support on the one hand and counter on the other the execution of Operation KE The central portion of the book narrates in some detail what actually occurred in the air and at sea including air strikes fighter sweeps base suppression missions and naval sorties during the crucial prelude to and the actual playing out of the interrelated events that comprised the evacuation operation Concluding chapters analyze on both strategic and tactical levels the Japanese planning and execution of Operation KE and Cactus initiatives to interdict KE s successful prosecution The authors conclude that both the Japanese and the American states of readiness on the eve of Operation KE suffered in such matters as optimizing both resources and operating procedures and combating a hostile environment Consequently both combatants were somewhat handicapped in their abilities respectively to carry out and contest Operation KE The author contends that the Japanese developed a reasonably sound strategy that exploited those methods and tools of war then in use in the South Pacific to achieve success they maximized their own strengths while taking advantage of their adversary s limitations Contrary to the traditional view the authors are of the opinion that Japanese utilization of their newly built airstrip at Munda in the Central Solomons played an important role in the success of Operation KE which was in keeping with the long range intention of developing Munda and Vila airstrips as major forward airbases to defend against any Allied push toward Rabaul through the Solomons The U S on the other hand by consistently misreading Japanese intent regarding Operation KE and pursuing a cautious offensive strategy blunted the tactical impact of their initiatives to counter the evacuation Several imprudent tactical decisions and a misallocation of resources further diluted the strength of US efforts *Australia Air Force Handbook - Strategic Information and Weapon Systems* IBP USA,2013 *Australia Air Force Handbook* **The Polo Encyclopedia, 2d ed.** Horace A.
