after death Using excavated materials Lillian Tseng shows how Han artisans transformed various notions of Heaven as the mandate the fantasy and the sky into pictorial entities The Han Heaven was not indicated by what the artisans looked at but rather was suggested by what they looked into Artisans attained the visibility of Heaven by appropriating and modifying related knowledge of cosmology mythology astronomy Thus the depiction of Heaven in Han China reflected an interface of image and knowledge By examining Heaven as depicted in ritual buildings on household utensils and in the embellishments of funerary settings Tseng maintains that visibility can hold up a mirror to visibility Heaven was culturally constructed and should be culturally reconstructed
