Rubio, 2010-05-15 This book brings to life the important but neglected story of African American postal workers and the critical role they played in the U S labor and black freedom movements Historian Philip Rubio a former postal worker integrates civil rights labor and left movement histories that too often are written as if they happened separately Centered on New York City and Washington D C the book chronicles a struggle of national significance through its examination of the post office a workplace with facilities and unions serving every city and town in the United States Black postal workers often college educated military veterans fought their way into postal positions and unions and became a critical force for social change They combined black labor protest and civic traditions to construct a civil rights unionism at the post office They were a major factor in the 1970 nationwide postal wildcat strike which resulted in full collective bargaining rights for the major postal unions under the newly established U S Postal Service in 1971 In making the fight for equality primary African American postal workers were influential in shaping today s post office and postal unions

**Women Who Invented the Sixties** Steve Golin, 2022-09-20 While there were many protests in the 1950s against racial segregation economic inequality urban renewal McCarthyism and the nuclear buildup the movements that took off in the early 1960s were qualitatively different They were sustained not momentary they were national not just local they changed public opinion rather than being ignored Women Who Invented the Sixties tells the story of how four women helped define the 1960s and made a lasting impression for decades to follow In 1960 Ella Baker played the key role in the founding of the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee which became an essential organization for students during the civil rights movement and the model for the antiwar and women s movements In 1961 Jane Jacobs published *The Death and Life of Great American Cities* changing the shape of urban planning irrevocably In 1962 Rachel Carson published *Silent Spring* creating the modern environmental movement And in 1963 Betty Friedan wrote *The Feminine Mystique* which sparked second wave feminism and created lasting changes for women Their four

Ballantyne,2024-05-01 *Radical Volunteers* tells the largely unknown story of southern student activism in Tennessee between the Brown decision in 1954 and the national backlash against the Kent State University shootings in May 1970 As one of the first statewide studies of student activism and one of the few examinations of southern student activism it broadens scholarly understanding of New Left and Black student radicalism from its traditionally defined hotbeds in the Northeast and on the West Coast By incorporating accounts of students from both historically Black and predominantly white colleges and universities across Tennessee *Radical Volunteers* places events that might otherwise appear random and intermittent into conversation with one another This methodological approach reveals that students joined organizations and became activists in an effort to assert their autonomy and as a result student power became a rallying cry across the state Katherine J Ballantyne illuminates a broad movement comprised of many different sorts of students white and Black private and public western middle and east Tennesseans Importantly Ballantyne does not confine her analysis to just campuses Indeed *Radical Volunteers* also situates campus activism within their broader communities Tennessee student activists built upon relationships with Old Left activists and organizations thereby fostering their otherwise fledgling enterprises and creating the possibility for radical change in the politically conservative region But framing student activism over a long period of time across Tennessee as a whole reveals disjuncture as much as coherence in the movement Though all case studies contain particular and representative features Tennessee s diversity lends itself well to a study of regional variations While outnumbered Tennessee student activists secured significant campus reforms pursued ambitious community initiatives and articulated a powerful countervision for the South and the United States [Teaching U.S. History Beyond the Textbook](#)

Board of Education* Wanda Little Fenimore, 2023-04-21 As early as 1947 Black parents in rural South Carolina began seeking equal educational opportunities for their children After two unsuccessful lawsuits these families directly challenged legally mandated segregation in public schools with a third lawsuit in 1950 which was eventually decided in *Brown v Board of Education* Amidst the Black parents resistance Elizabeth Avery Waring a twice divorced northern socialite and her third husband federal judge J Waties Waring launched a rhetorical campaign condemning white supremacy and segregation In a series of speeches the Warings exposed the incongruity between American democratic ideals and the reality for Black Americans in the Jim Crow South They urged audiences to pressure elected representatives to force southern states to end legal segregation Wanda Little Fenimore employs innovative research methods to recover the Warings speeches that said the unsayable about white supremacy When the couple poked at the contradiction between segregation and all men are created equal white supremacists pushed back As a result the couple received both damning and congratulatory letters that reveal the terms upon which segregation was defended and the reasons those who opposed white supremacy remained silent Using rich archival materials Fenimore crafts an engaging narrative that illustrates the rhetorical context from which *Brown v Board of Education* arose and dispels the notion that the decision was inevitable The first full length account of the Warings rhetoric this multilayered story of social progress traces the symbolic battle that provided a locus for change in the landmark Supreme Court decision

Harwell, 2014-08-05 As tensions mounted before Freedom Summer one organization tackled the divide by opening lines of communication at the request of local women Wednesdays in Mississippi WIMS Employing an unusual and deliberately feminine approach WIMS brought interracial interfaith teams of northern middle aged middle and upper class women to Mississippi to meet with their southern counterparts Sponsored by the National Council of Negro Women NCNW WIMS operated on the belief that the northern participants gender age and class would serve as an entrance to southerners who had dismissed other civil rights activists as radicals The WIMS teams respectable appearance and quiet approach enabled them to build understanding across race region and religion where other overtures had failed The only civil rights program created for women by women as part of a national organization WIMS offers a new paradigm through which to study civil rights activism challenging the stereotype of Freedom Summer activists as young student radicals and demonstrating the effectiveness of the subtle approach taken by proper ladies The book delves into the motivations for women's civil rights activism and the role religion played in influencing supporters and opponents of the civil rights movement Lastly it confirms that the NCNW actively worked for integration and black voting rights while also addressing education poverty hunger housing and employment as civil rights issues After successful efforts in 1964 and 1965 WIMS became Workshops in Mississippi which strived to alleviate the specific needs of poor women Projects that grew from these efforts still operate today

broad popular front type agendas Progressive women brought to their later work an understanding of how race class and gender intersect in women s organizing These women s stories demonstrate that the ultimate result of Cold War era McCarthyism was not the defeat of women s activism but rather its reconfiguration
