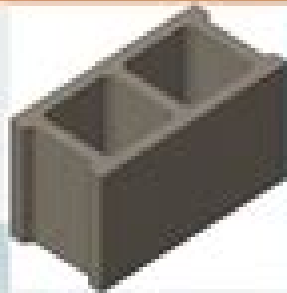


COMMON STRUCTURAL DEFECTS IN BUILDINGS

MOLD



Often caused by moisture intrusion

INSULATION



Results in increased heating/cooling costs

CRACKS TO WALLS



Vary in severity some may signal significant problems

TREES ROOFS STRUCTURE DEFECTS



Risk of fallen branches causing structural damage

STUMP DEFECTS



Decaying stumps near buildings weaken foundations

FLOOR DEFECTS



Signify underlying structural problems or poor construction

DRAINAGE



Poor drainage leads to water accumulation around foundations
