Angus McLaren, 2022-08-19 The decline of the British birth rate was arguably the most important social change to occur in the last decades of the nineteenth century but historians have shown remarkably little interest in the phenomenon Most of the work done on the question has been by sociologists and reflects their assumption that the progressive adoption of birth control was largely a matter of the lower classes aping the behaviour of their betters Originally published in 1978 this book argues against this interpretation It contends that the great interest of the nineteenth century birth control debate is that it reveals that there was not a growing consensus of opinion on the question of family planning but rather two cultural confrontations the struggle of the middle class propagandists of both left and right to manipulate for political purposes working class attitudes towards procreation and on a deeper level the clash of the differing attitudes of men and women towards the possibility of fertility control The purpose of this study is to place the idea and practice of birth control in their social and political context and four major factors are focused upon to this end the first is that the birth control issue played a key role in the confrontation between Malthusians socialists eugenisists and feminists Secondly the whole question of contraception led to a conflict between doctors quacks midwives and ordinary men and women seeking to control their own fertility Thirdly men and women belong to different sexual cultures and necessarily respond in different ways to the possibility of family regulation and finally despite the claims of some that birth control was an innovation it was the pre industrial forms of fertility control including abortion which brought the birth rate down

Contraception, Colonialism and Commerce

Sarah Hodges, 2017-03-02 Birth control holds an unusual place in the history of medicine Largely devoid of doctors or hospitals only relatively recently have birth control histories included tales of laboratory based therapeutic innovation Instead these histories elucidate the peculiar slippages between individual bodies and a body politic occasioned by the promotion of techniques to manipulate human reproduction The history of birth control in India brings these as well as

additional complications to the field Contrary to popular belief India has one of the most long lasting institutionalized far reaching state sponsored family planning programs in the world During the inter war period the country witnessed the formation of groups dedicated to promoting the cause of birth control This book outlines the early history of birth control in India particularly the Tamil south In so doing it illuminates India s role in a global network of birth control advocacy The book also argues how Indians contraceptive advocacy and associationalism became an increasingly significant realm of action in which they staked claims not just about the utility of contraception but simultaneously over their ability and right to self rule

Mishra,2025 AN EXTREMELY TOPICAL BOOK AND THE FIRST OF ITS KIND ON DELIMITATION WHICH IS TO BE CARRIED OUT AFTER THE 2026 CENSUS The popular narrative around delimitation is that south India controlled its population growth through effective family planning while the north did not Therefore the argument goes delimitation expected to take place after the Census is conducted in 2026 would penalise the south for performing well In this compelling and data driven analysis Ravi K Mishra a scholar of modern Indian history and Joint Director of the Prime Ministers Museum and Library questions this belief Drawing on 150 years of comprehensive data from decennial censuses district gazetteers boundary commission reports and state reorganisation legislations Mishra reveals that all regions of India have experienced phases of peak population growth though at different times He argues that there is little causal connection between family planning and population control in India when family planning assumed importance in the 1960s under the flawed Western notion of population explosion most southern states had already grown rapidly for ninety years and almost completed their demographic transition leading to a gradual decline in growth thereafter Meanwhile trailing the south by decades the north had only then entered the peak growth phase and the north and west are currently underrepresented disrupting the one person one vote one value principle Tackling myths about demography and delimitation head on **Demography Representation Delimitation** is an essential read on a complex and widely misunderstood subject
