Decolonizing the Sodomite Michael J. Horswell, 2005 This is a study of alternative gender and sexuality in the colonial Andean world which uses the concept of the third gender to reconsider some key aspects of Andean culture and provides an alternative history and interpretation of the much maligned aboriginal subjects the Spanish referred to as sodomites

Decolonizing the Sodomite Michael J. Horswell, 2005 Early Andean historiography reveals a subaltern history of indigenous gender and sexuality that saw masculinity and femininity not as essential absolutes Third gender ritualists Ipas mediated between the masculine and feminine spheres of culture in important ceremonies and were recorded in fragments of myths and transcribed oral accounts Ritual performance by cross dressed men symbolically created a third space of mediation that invoked the mythic androgyne of the pre Hispanic Andes The missionaries and civil authorities colonizing the Andes deemed these performances transgressive and sodomitical In this book Michael J Horswell examines alternative gender and sexuality in the colonial Andean world and uses the concept of the third gender to reconsider some fundamental paradigms of Andean culture By deconstructing what literary tropes of sexuality reveal about Andean pre Hispanic and colonial indigenous culture he provides an alternative history and interpretation of the much maligned aboriginal subjects the Spanish often referred to as sodomites Horswell traces the origin of the dominant tropes of masculinist sexuality from canonical medieval texts to early modern Spanish secular and moralist literature produced in the context of material persecution of effeminates and sodomites in Spain These values traveled to the Andes and were used as powerful rhetorical weapons in the struggle to justify the conquest of the Incas

Masculinity and Queer Desire in Spanish Enlightenment Literature Mehl Allan Penrose, 2016-05-06 In *Masculinity and Queer Desire in Spanish Enlightenment Literature* Mehl Allan Penrose examines three distinct male figures each of which was represented as the Other in eighteenth and early nineteenth century Spanish literature The most common configuration of non normative men was the petimetre an effeminate Francophile male who figured a failed masculinity a dubious sexuality and an invasive French cultural presence Also inscribed within cultural discourse were the bujarr n or sodomite who participates in sexual relations with men and the Arcadian shepherd who expresses his desire for other males and who takes on agency as the voice of homoerotica Analyzing journalistic essays poetry and drama Penrose shows that Spanish authors employed queer images of men to engage debates about how males should appear speak and behave and whom they should love in order to be considered real Spaniards Penrose interrogates works by a wide range of writers including Luis Ca uelo Ram n de la Cruz and F lix Mar a de Samaniego arguing that the tropes created by these authors solidified the gender and sexual binary and defined and described what a queer man was in the Spanish collective imaginary *Masculinity and Queer Desire* engages with current cultural historical and theoretical scholarship to propose the notion that the idea of queerness in gender and sexuality based on identifiable criteria started in Spain long before the medical concept of the homosexual was created around 1870 , The Oxford Handbook

The Coloniality of Humanitarian Intervention Patrick J. Vernon, 2024-05-07 This book scrutinises the practice of humanitarian intervention to explore the extent to which racism and heteronormativity rooted in colonial understandings of time and space are enacted through the UK's responses failed responses and non responses to atrocity crimes Taking humanitarian intervention as its central focus the book uses queer international relations scholarship to draw the ongoing coloniality of the Western state into stark relief By studying House of Commons debates on the UK's response to mass atrocities in Libya Syria Iraq and Myanmar between 2011 and 2018 it highlights the ways in which dominant logics in these debates invoke subject positions of extreme selfhood or otherness These are identified as The Brutal Dictator The ISIL

Terrorist and The British Self framed as existing at various steps on The Universal Path to Democracy In studying these extreme cultural figures of selfhood and otherness the book examines the ways in which racism and heteronormativity work together to dehumanise certain populations under coloniality and the ways in which this can be resisted By studying these debates it uncovers the extent to which UK foreign policy continues to operate through a colonial script The book notably studies failed interventions Syria and non interventions Myanmar as significant objects of study which alongside the comments of UK legislators opposing the case for violence help to expose the ongoing impact of colonial identities in the formulation of government policy As well as looking at the British case the book reflects upon changing norms of humanitarian intervention from the 1990s to the present day including what might be understood as the rise and fall of R2P The book also makes a distinct contribution to queer international relations scholarship broadening what Vernon calls the homonormative turn with a renewed focus on heteronormativity as a racist and globally dominant episteme Offering both a theoretically informed analysis of humanitarian intervention and a practical guide for possible strategies to resist future iterations of liberal violence this book will appeal to scholars students policy makers and NGOs interested in R2P humanitarian intervention queer decolonial feminist international relations and British politics
