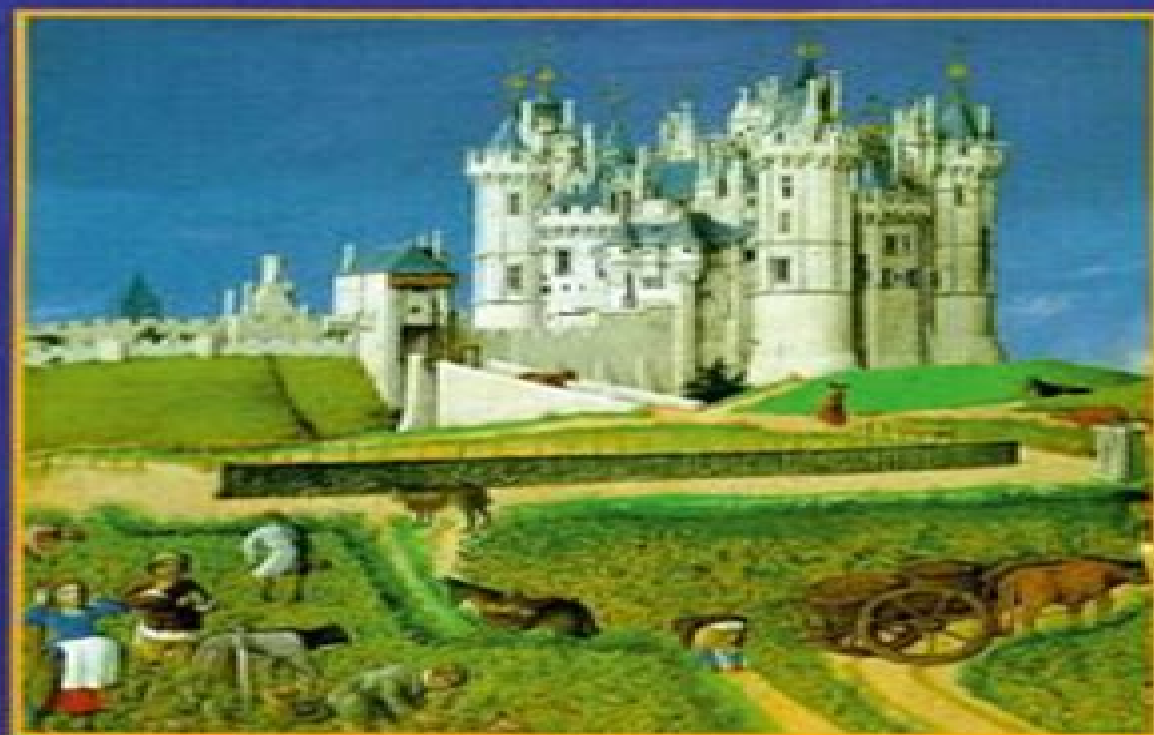

Time in the Medieval World Colum Hourihane, 2007 This volume is a rich resource for the study of time as represented by the signs of the zodiac and occupations of the months documented in the comprehensive files of the Index of Christian Art at Princeton University The measurement and documentation of time has been a universal issue since the dawn of civilization and no more so than in the medieval period when images representing the signs of the zodiac and occupations of the months were commonly used Nature and the occupations or labors that each month brought were reflected in earthly calendars while the movements of the heavens and their impact on mankind were recorded in the signs of the zodiac The changing compositions that were used to represent these twin calendars in several hundred works of art are documented in this volume which provides an unrivaled visual record for the student and scholar

Imaginings of Time in Lydgate and Hoccleve's Verse Karen Elaine Smyth, 2016-05-13 Using empirical research to explore medieval writers imaginings of time this study presents a new morphology by which to study narratives of time in fifteenth century literary culture focusing on poems of John Lydgate and Thomas Hoccleve Karen Smyth begins with an overview of medieval time keeping devices and considers collective and individual attitudes and perceptions of time She then examines a range of Middle English authors appropriations and innovations in relation to such perceptions identifying competitions of tradition and innovation allowing for an interrogation of commonly accepted medieval theories of time An empirically based morphology emerges and is used to examine narratives of time in Lydgate and Hoccleve's work Through a series of close readings of selected short poems and Lydgate's Troy Book Fall of Princes and Siege of Thebes and of Hoccleve's Regiments of Princes and Series Karen Smyth looks at expressions of time and examples of the authors negotiation of time consciousness illustrating how both poets manipulate a range of cultural narratives of time in order to create multiple and sometimes competing temporalities within a single poem Smyth simultaneously draws attention to Lydgate's and Hoccleve's underestimated artistic skills and lays out a means to re evaluate medieval cultural attitudes towards time

Woodcuts as Reading Guides Andrea Leerdam, 2025-10-01 In the first half of the sixteenth century the Low Countries saw the rise of a lively market for practical and instructive books that targeted non specialist readers This study shows how woodcuts in vernacular books on medicine and astrology fulfilled important rhetorical functions in knowledge communication These images guided readers perceptions of the organisation visualisation and reliability of knowledge Andrea van Leerdam uncovers the assumptions and intentions of book producers to which

images testify and shows how actual readers engaged with these illustrated books Drawing on insights from the field of information design studies she scrutinises the books material characteristics including their lay outs and traces of use to shed light on the habits and interests of early modern readers She situates these works in a culture where medicine and astrology were closely interwoven in daily life and where both book producers and readers were exploring the potential of images

Farmers, Monks and Aristocrats K. M. Dobney, D. Jaques, James Barrett, Cluny Johnstone, 2007-12-12 The environmental archaeological evidence from the site of Flixborough in particular the animal bone assemblage provides a series of unique insights into Anglo Saxon life in England during the 8th to 10th centuries The research reveals detailed evidence for the local and regional environment many aspects of the local and regional agricultural economy changing resource exploitation strategies and the extent of possible trade and exchange networks Perhaps the most important conclusions have been gleaned from the synthesis of these various lines of evidence viewed in a broader archaeological context Thus bioarchaeological data from Flixborough have documented for the first time in a detailed and systematic way the significant shift in social and economic aspects of wider Anglo Saxon life during the 9th century AD and comment on the possible role of external factors such as the arrival of Scandinavians in the life and development of the settlement The bioarchaeological evidence from Flixborough is also used to explore the tentative evidence revealed by more traditional archaeological materials for the presence during the 9th century of elements of monastic life The vast majority of bioarchaeological evidence from Flixborough provides both direct and indirect evidence of the wealth and social standing of some of the inhabitants as well as a plethora of unique information about agricultural and provisioning practices associated with a major Anglo Saxon estate centre The environmental archaeological record from Flixborough is without doubt one of the most important datasets of the early medieval period and one which will provide a key benchmark for future research into many aspects of early medieval archaeology

Zodiac Calendars in the Dead Sea Scrolls and Their Reception Helen R. Jacobus, 2014-10-30 The ancient mathematical basis of the Aramaic calendars in the Dead Sea Scrolls is analysed in this investigation Helen R Jacobus re examines an Aramaic zodiac calendar with a thunder divination text 4Q318 and the calendar from the Aramaic Astronomical Book 4Q208 4Q209 all from Qumran Jacobus demonstrates that 4Q318 is an ancestor of the Jewish calendar today and that it helps us to understand 4Q208 4Q209 She argues that these calendars were taught in antiquity as angelic knowledge described in 1 Enoch and the Book of Jubilees The study also encompasses Babylonian Hellenistic Byzantine astronomy and astrology and classical and Jewish writings Finally a medieval Hebrew zodiac calendar related to 4Q318 with an astrological text is published here for the first time
