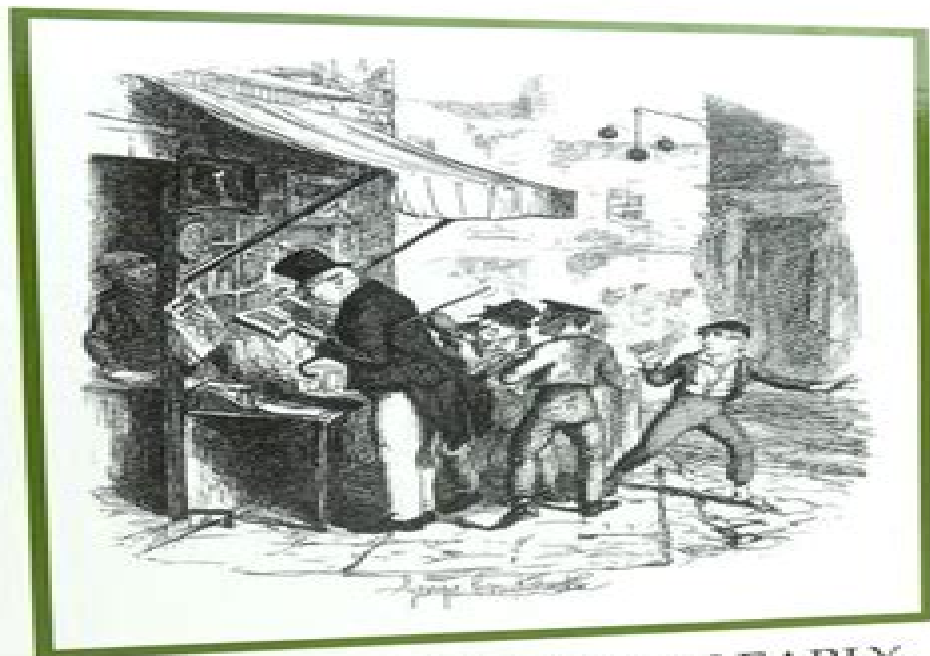

Conceptualizing Cruelty to Children in Nineteenth-Century England Monica Flegel, 2016-05-23 Moving nimbly between literary and historical texts Monica Flegel provides a much needed interpretive

framework for understanding the specific formulation of child cruelty popularized by the National Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children NSPCC in the late nineteenth century Flegel considers a wide range of well known and more obscure texts from the mid eighteenth century to the early twentieth including philosophical writings by Locke and Rousseau poetry by Coleridge Blake and Caroline Norton works by journalists and reformers like Henry Mayhew and Mary Carpenter and novels by Frances Trollope Charles Dickens Wilkie Collins and Arthur Morrison Taking up crucial topics such as the linking of children with animals the figure of the child performer the relationship between commerce and child endangerment and the problem of juvenile delinquency Flegel examines the emergence of child abuse as a subject of legal and social concern in England and its connection to earlier primarily literary representations of endangered children With the emergence of the NSPCC and the new crime of cruelty to children new professions and genres such as child protection and social casework supplanted literary works as the authoritative voices in the definition of social ills and their cure Flegel argues that this development had material effects on the lives of children as well as profound implications for the role of class in representations of suffering and abused children Combining nuanced close readings of individual texts with persuasive interpretations of their influences and limitations Flegel's book makes a significant contribution to the history of childhood social welfare the family and Victorian philanthropy

Young Criminal Lives Barry S. Godfrey, Pamela Cox, Heather Shore, 2017 Young Criminal Lives is the first cradle to grave study of the experiences of some of the thousands of delinquent difficult and destitute children passing through the early English juvenile reformatory system The book breaks new ground in crime research speaking to pressing present day concerns around child poverty and youth justice and resonating with a powerful public fascination for family history Using innovative digital methods to unlock the Victorian life course the authors have reconstructed the lives families and neighbourhoods of 500 children living within or at the margins of the early English juvenile reformatory system Four hundred of them were sent to reformatory and industrial schools in the north west of England from courts around the UK over a fifty year period from the 1860s onwards

Young Criminal Lives is based on one of the most comprehensive sets of official and personal data ever assembled for a historical study of this kind. For the first time these children can be followed on their journey in and out of reform and then through their adulthood and old age. The book centres on institutions celebrated in this period for their pioneering new approaches to child welfare and others that were investigated for cruelty and scandal. Both were typical of the new kind of state certified provision offered from the 1850s on to children who had committed criminal acts or who were considered vulnerable to predation, poverty and the inheritance of criminal dispositions. The notion that interventions can and must be evaluated in order to determine what works now dominates public policy. But how did Victorian and Edwardian policy makers and practitioners deal with this question? By what criteria and on the basis of what kinds of evidence did they judge their own successes and failures? Young Criminal Lives ends with a critical review of the historical rise of evidence based policy making within criminal justice. It will appeal to scholars and students of crime and penal policy, criminologists, sociologists and social policy researchers and practitioners in youth justice and child protection.

Ellis, 2014-08-13 This volume brings together a wide range of case studies from across the globe written by some of the leading scholars in the field to explore the complex ways in which historical understandings of childhood and juvenile delinquency have been constructed in a global context.

Offending Youth Kerry Carrington, Margaret Pereira, 2009 Rates of female delinquency especially for violent crimes are increasing in most common law countries. At the same time the growth in cyber bullying especially among girls appears to be a related global phenomenon. While the gender gap in delinquency is narrowing in Australia, United States, Canada and the United Kingdom, boys continue to dominate the youth who commit crime and have a virtual monopoly over sexually violent crimes. Indigenous youth continue to be vastly over represented in the juvenile justice system in every Australian jurisdiction. The Indigenisation of delinquency is a persistent problem in other countries such as Canada and New Zealand. Young people who gather in public places are susceptible to being perceived as somehow threatening or riotous, attracting more than their share of public order policing. Professional football has been marred by repeated scandals involving sexual assault, violence and drunkenness. Given the cultural significance of footballers as role models to thousands if not millions of young men around the world, it is vitally important to address this problem. Offending Youth explores these key contemporary patterns of delinquency, the response to these by the juvenile justice agencies and moreover what can be done to address these problems. The book also analyses the major policy and legislative changes from the nineteenth to twenty first centuries, chiefly the shift from penal welfarism to diversion and restorative justice. Using original cases studied by Carrington twenty years ago, Offending Youth illustrates how penal welfarism criminalised young people from socially marginal backgrounds, especially Aboriginal children, children from single parent families, family less children, state wards and young people living in poverty or in housing commission estates. A number of inquiries in Australia and the United Kingdom have since established that children

committed to these institutions supposedly for their own good experienced systemic physical sexual and psychological abuse during their institutionalisation The book is dedicated to the survivors of these institutions who only now are receiving official recognition of the injustices they suffered The underlying philosophy of juvenile justice has fundamentally shifted away from penal welfarism to embrace positive policy responses to juvenile crime such as youth conferencing cautions warnings restorative justice circle sentencing and diversion examined in the concluding chapter Offending Youth is aimed at a broad readership including policy makers juvenile justice professionals youth workers families teachers politicians as well as students and academics in criminology policing gender studies masculinity studies Indigenous studies justice studies youth studies and the sociology of youth and deviance more generally

City David Churchill,2017 The history of modern crime control is usually presented as a narrative of how the state wrested control over the governance of crime from the civilian public Most accounts trace the decline of a participatory discretionary culture of crime control in the early modern era and its replacement by a centralized bureaucratic system of responding to offending The formation of the new professional police forces in the nineteenth century is central to this narrative henceforth it is claimed the priorities of criminal justice were to be set by the state as ordinary people lost what authority they had once exercised over dealing with offenders This book challenges this established view and presents a fundamental reinterpretation of changes to crime control in the age of the new police It breaks new ground by providing a highly detailed empirical analysis of everyday crime control in Victorian provincial cities revealing the tremendous activity which ordinary people displayed in responding to crime alongside a rich survey of police organization and policing in practice With unique conceptual clarity it seeks to reorient modern criminal justice history away from its established preoccupation with state systems of policing and punishment and move towards a more nuanced analysis of the governance of crime More widely the book provides a unique and valuable vantage point from which to rethink the role of civil society and the state in modern governance the nature of agency and authority in Victorian England and the historical antecedents of pluralized modes of crime control which characterize contemporary society
