This book reflects the most recent research devoted to a systematized perspective and a critical reconstruction of previous theoretical attempts of explaining justifying and continuing Kuhn's ingenious hypothesis in arts. Hofstadter, Clignet and Habermas revealed to be the most engaged scholars in solving this aesthetic puzzled problem. In this context the structural similarities between science and arts are attentively evaluated thus satisfying an older concern attributed to the historical Kuhn. Kubler dispute extensively commented along the pages of this book. How can we track the matter of rationality and truth in art and aesthetics inspired by scientific perspectives? Are artistic styles similar to scientific paradigms? Are we entitled to pursue paradigms and masterpieces as rational models in science respectively in arts? Art's Way Out John Baldacchino, 2012-03-26 In taking the critique of inclusion and entry as a first step, Art's Way Out's discussion of art politics and learning aims to delineate what an exit pedagogy would look like where culture is neither seen as a benign form of inclusion nor as a hegemonic veil by which we are all subscribed to the system via popularized forms of artistic and cultural immediacy. An exit pedagogy as prefigured in what could be called art's way out through the implements of negative recognition qua impasse would not only avoid the all too facile symmetrical dualism between conservative and progressive liberal and critical pedagogies but also seek the continuous referral of such symmetries by setting them aside and look for a way out of the confined edifices of education and culture per se. An exit pedagogy seeks its way out by reasserting representation in the comedic, the jocular and more effectively in the arts' power of pausing as that most effective way by which aesthetics comes to effect in its autonomist and radical essence. In this fluent, limpid and scholarly work, Baldacchino examines inter alia the problem of empathy in relation to art as an event or series of events drawing upon a wide and rich

The Oxford History of Western Art Martin Kemp, 2000 The Oxford History of Western Art is the new authority on the development of visual culture in the West over the last 2700 years from the classical period to the end of the twentieth century OHWA is an innovative and challenging reappraisal of how the history of art can be presented and understood None of the currently available general histories of art offers the wealth of perspectives and cross media references of this book Through a carefully devised modular structure readers are given insights not only into how and why works of art were created but also how works in different media relate to each other across time Here uniquely is not the simple linear story of art but a rich series of stories told from varying viewpoints The founding principle of the book has been to use carefully selected groupings of pictures to give readers a sense of the visual texture of the various periods and episodes covered The 167 illustration groups supported by explanatory text and picture captions create a sequence of visual tours not merely a procession of individually great works viewed in isolation but

Whilst bringing their own expertise and vision to their sections, each author was also asked to relate their text to a number of unifying themes and issues including written evidence, physical contexts, patronage, viewing and reception techniques, gender and racial issues, centres and peripheries, media and condition.
