Temkin,2021-03-15 For me people come first Alice Neel 1900 1984 declared in 1950 I have tried to assert the dignity and eternal importance of the human being This ambitious publication surveys Neel s nearly 70 year career through the lens of her radical humanism Remarkable portraits of victims of the Great Depression fellow residents of Spanish Harlem leaders of political organizations queer artists visibly pregnant women and members of New York s global diaspora reveal that Neel viewed humanism as both

a political and philosophical ideal In addition to these paintings of famous and unknown sitters the more than 100 works highlighted include Neel's emotionally charged cityscapes and still lifes as well as the artist's erotic pastels and watercolors Essays tackle Neel's portrayal of LGBTQ subjects her unique aesthetic language which merged abstraction and figuration and her commitment to progressive politics civil rights feminism and racial diversity The authors also explore Neel's highly personal preoccupations with death illness and motherhood while reasserting her place in the broader cultural history of the 20th century

Seeing Through the Seventies Laura Cottingham, 2013-11-05 In recent years Laura Cottingham has emerged as one of the most visible feminist critics of the so-called post-feminist generation Following a social-political approach to art history and criticism that accepts visual culture as part of a larger social reality Cottingham's writings investigate central tensions currently operative in the production distribution and evaluation of art especially those related to cultural production by and about women *Seeing Through the Seventies: Essays on Feminism and Art* gathers together Cottingham's key essays from the 1990s These include an appraisal of Lucy R Lippard the most influential feminist art critic of the 1970s a critique of the masculinist bias implicit to modernism and explicitly recuperated by commercially successful artists during the 1980s an exhaustive analysis of the curatorial failures operative in the Bad Girls museum exhibitions of the early 1990s surveys of feminist-influenced art practices during the women's liberationist period speculations on the current possibilities and obstacles that attend efforts to recover lesbian cultural history and an examination of the life work and obscuration of the early twentieth-century French photographer Claude Cahun

The Sculptural Imagination Alex Potts, 2000-01-01 Potts also offers a detailed view of selected iconic works by sculptors ranging from Antonio Canova and Auguste Rodin to Constantin Brancusi David Smith Carl Andre Eva Hesse and Louise Bourgeois key players in modern thinking about the sculptural The impact of minimalism features prominently in this discussion for it disrupted accepted understanding of how a viewer interacts with a work of art thereby placing the phenomenology of viewing three-dimensional objects for the first time at the center of debate about modern visual art Jacket

The Art of the Sister Chapel Andrew Hottle,2017-07-05 The Sister Chapel 1974 78 was an important collaborative installation that materialized at the height of the women s art movement Conceived as a nonhierarchical secular commemoration of female role models The Sister Chapel consisted of an eighteen foot abstract ceiling that hung above a circular arrangement of eleven monumental canvases each depicting the standing figure of a heroic woman The choice of subject was left entirely to the creator of each work As a result the paintings formed a visually cohesive group without compromising the individuality of the artists Contemporary and historical women deities and conceptual figures were portrayed by distinguished New York painters Alice Neel May Stevens and Sylvia Sleigh as well as their accomplished but less prominent colleagues Among the role models depicted were Artemisia Gentileschi Frida Kahlo Betty Friedan Joan of Arc and a female incarnation of God Although last exhibited in 1980 The Sister Chapel has lingered in the minds of art historians who continue to note its significance as an exemplar of feminist collaboration Based on previously unpublished archival materials and featuring dozens of rarely seen works of art this comprehensive study details the fascinating history of The Sister Chapel its constituent paintings and its ambitious creators
