Selling Mrs. Consumer Janice Williams Rutherford, 2010-07-01 This first book length treatment of the life and work of Christine Frederick 1883 1970 reveals an important dilemma that faced educated women of the early twentieth century Contrary to her professional role as home efficiency expert advertising consultant and consumer advocate Christine Frederick espoused the nineteenth century ideal of preserving the virtuous home and a woman's place in it In an effort to reconcile her desire to succeed in the public sphere of modernization and consumerism with the knowledge that most middle class Americans still held traditional beliefs about gender roles Frederick fashioned a career for herself that encouraged other women to remain at home With the rise of home economics and scientific management Frederick college educated but confined to the drudgery of housework devised a plan for bringing the public sphere into the domestic Her home would become her factory She learned how to standardize tasks by observing labor saving devices in industry and then applied this knowledge to housework She standardized dishwashing for example by breaking the job into three separate operations scraping and stacking washing and drying and putting away Determined to train women to become proficient homemakers and efficient managers Frederick secured a job writing articles for the Ladies Home Journal A professional career as home efficiency expert later expanded to include advertising consultant and consumer advocate Frederick assured male advertisers that she knew women well and promised to help them sell to Mrs Consumer While Frederick sought the power and influence available only to men she promoted a division of labor by gender and therefore served the fall of the early twentieth century wave of feminism Rutherford's engaging account of Christine Frederick's life reflects a dilemma that continues to affect women today whether to seek professional gratification or adhere to traditional family values **Making Home Work** Jane E. Reading for Realism Nancy Glazener, 1997 *Reading for Realism* presents a new approach to U S literary history that is based on the analysis of dominant reading practices rather than on the production of texts Nancy Glazener's focus is the realist novel the most influential literary form of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries a form she contends was only made possible by changes in the expectations of readers about pleasure and literary value By tracing readers collaboration in the production of literary forms *Reading for Realism* turns nineteenth century controversies about the realist romance and sentimental novels into episodes in the history of readership It also shows how works of fiction by Rebecca Harding Davis Henry James Nathaniel Hawthorne and others participated in the debates about literary classification and reading that in turn created and shaped their audiences Combining reception theory with a materialist analysis of the social formations in which realist reading practices circulated Glazener's study reveals the elitist underpinnings of literary realism At the book's center is the Atlantic group of magazines whose influence was part of the cultural machinery of the Northeastern urban bourgeoisie and crucial to the development of literary realism in America Glazener shows how the promotion of realism by this group of publications also meant a consolidation of privilege primarily in terms of class gender race and region for the audience it served Thus American realism so often portrayed as a quintessentially populist form actually served to enforce existing structures of class and power

Charlotte Perkins Gilman Cynthia Davis,2010-03-02 Charlotte Perkins Gilman offers the definitive account of this controversial writer and activist s long and eventful life Charlotte Anna Perkins Stetson Gilman 1860 1935 launched her career as a lecturer author and reformer with the story for which she is best known today *The Yellow Wallpaper* She was hailed as the brains of the US women s movement whose focus she sought to broaden from suffrage to economics Her most influential sociological work criticized the competitive individualism of capitalists and Social Darwinists and touted altruistic service as the prerequisite to both social progress and human evolution By 1900 Gilman had become an international celebrity but had already faced a scandal over her divorce and abandonment of her child As the years passed her audience shrunk and grew more hostile and she increasingly positioned herself in opposition to the society that in an earlier more idealistic period she had seen as the better part of the self In her final years she unflinchingly faced breast cancer her second husband s sudden death and finally her own carefully planned suicide she preferred chloroform to cancer and cared little for a single life when its usefulness was over Charlotte Perkins Gilman presents new insights into the life of a remarkable woman whose public solutions often belied her private anxieties It aims to recapture the drama and complexity of Gilman s life while presenting a comprehensive scholarly portrait *Design Book Review* ,1991
