Budgetary Politics in American Governments James J. Gosling, 2006 Budgetary Politics in American Governments unlike most public budgeting texts takes a comparative approach to the subject of public budgeting examining budgetary politics at the federal state and local government levels Students are introduced to the budgetary decision making process taxation spending budget execution and financial management as well as the budget process at each level of government Thoroughly updated but preserving much of the third edition's structure and approach this fourth edition contains a new chapter that will introduce students to the interrelationship of economics and politics in budgeting

Conflict and Change in EU Budgetary Politics Johannes Lindner, 2006-02-27 Why did the European Union experience a stark variation in the levels of conflict between the late 1970s when budgetary disputes dominated European politics and the 1990s when political actors were able to settle upon budgetary agreements without major conflicts This book responds to this key question with a two step argument Its first part shows that decision making rules can be regarded as a key determinant of the level of conflict in EU budgetary politics It details far reaching reform in 1988 reduced conflict because it introduced an institutional setting for multiannual budget planning that corrected the deficiencies of the original budget treaty Having identified institutional change as the trigger for the reduction of conflict the second part of this study focuses on the 1988 reform It shows how a number of reproduction mechanisms prevented major institutional change in the 1970s and early 1980s When these reproduction mechanisms lost force a reform became possible and a new institutional setting emerged in 1988 These findings deliver a sharp insight into the interplay between rules and conflict in the still evolving political system of the EU Moreover by identifying precise conditions for the occurrence of institutional change and by linking political performance of institutions to their stability this is a significant contribution to institutionalist research in social science This book is an excellent resource for students and scholars of the European Union Political Science International Relations Public Policy and Public Finance

Budgetary Politics and Elections Rudolf Wildenmann, 1986 The 1986 pre election year in the Federal Republic of Germany was an interesting one Starting with the communal elections in Schleswig Holstein in March the parties began to prepare themselves for the big upcoming event the general election in January 1987 The governing Christian Democrats CDU suffered a severe vote loss in this March election as part of their most loyal supporters the farmers decided to abstain due to a general dissatisfaction with EEC regulations and agricultural government policies In order to avoid further farmers boycotts for the next Lander elections in Lower Saxony in June Bavaria in October and Hamburg in November the federal government sprang into action A 500 million DM programme was passed in the beginning of June which reduced the farmers contributions to the agrarian social security system with retrospective effect to January 1986 As a result of the reactor accident in Tschernobyl another 500 million DM were promised to cover the losses of agricultural products because of radio activity In order to appease the farmers even more a special election gift of 100 million DM to

subsidize fallow land was given to Lower Saxony's farmers one week before the election took place. At the same time the parliament increased veterans' benefits by 2.15% from July onwards, further increases being promised by January 1987. The predominant social policy issue however concerned old age pensions, more precisely the question of adopting a so-called baby year in pension law. The coalition government in Bonn decided to give all women born before 1921 a monthly payment of 25 DM for each child. The programme will start in October 1987 and will gradually include all female pensioners with children by 1990. Described by Chancellor Kohl as a new dimension in social policy, the programme will cost 3.3 billion DM per year by 1990.

What sustains split partisan control of the institutions of American national government year after year? Why can it shift so easily from Democratic or Republican presidencies coupled with Republican or Democratic Congresses? How can the vast array of issues and personalities that have surfaced in American politics over the last forty years fit so neatly within, indeed reinforce the sustaining political pattern of our time? These big questions constitute the puzzle of modern American politics. The old

answer a majority and a minority party plus dominant and recessive public issues will not work in the Era of Divided Government Byron Shafer a political scientist who is regarded as one of the most comprehensive and original thinkers on American politics provides a convincing new answer that has three major elements These elements in combination not divided government as a catch phrase are the real story of politics in our time The first element is comprised of two great sets of public preferences that manifest themselves at the ballot box as two majorities The old cluster of economic and welfare issues has not so much been displaced as simply joined by a second cluster of cultural and national concerns The second element can be seen in the behavior of political parties and party activists whose own preferences don't match those of the general public That public remains reliably left of the active Republican Party on economic and welfare issues and reliably right of the active Democratic Party on cultural and national concerns The third crucial element is found in an institutional arrangement the distinctively American matrix of governmental institutions which converts those first two elements into a framework for policymaking year in and year out In the first half of the book Shafer examines how dominant features of the Reagan first Bush Clinton and second Bush administrations reflect the interplay of these three elements Recent policy conflicts and institutional combatants in Shafer's analysis illuminate this new pattern of American politics In the second half he ranges across time and nations to put these modern elements and their composite pattern into a much larger historical and institutional framework In this light modern American politics appears not so much as new and different but as a distinctive recombination of familiar elements of a political style a political process and a political conflict that has been running for a much much longer time

Urban Politics and Decentralization Richard L. Cole, David A. Caputo, 1974 Everett Dirksen and His Presidents Byron C. Hulse, 2000 He was as recognizable by his mellifluous voice as by his rumpled appearance Everett McKinley Dirksen was one of the most colorful American politicians of the twentieth century and was considered by some the most powerful man in Congress Now Byron Hulse takes a new look at the senator from Illinois to show how his interactions with the White House made him a pivotal figure in American politics during the Cold War era Hulse traces Dirksen's relationships with four presidents to show how the senator shifted from being a major Republican critic of Truman to an ardent Republican supporter of LBJ Dirksen learned suprapartisan politics from Eisenhower and became Ike's most trusted confidant on Capitol Hill then as Senate Minority Leader he played a key role in furthering the ambitious goals of the Johnson administration Hulse analyzes the reasons for Dirksen's dramatic policy reversals telling how the senator who in 1950 warned of the dangers of a leviathan executive came to embrace the power of the presidential office to provide for the social welfare contain the spread of communism and guarantee civil rights Drawing on primary sources at the Johnson presidential library and the Dirksen Congressional Center Hulse shows how the senator combined legislative craftsmanship with the ability to get bills passed He links Dirksen to the issues and events that shaped the 1950s and 1960s and tells how the Johnson Dirksen coalition moved domestic policy forward through civil rights legislation but ran aground on the insurmountable problem of Vietnam Hulse also uses Dirksen's career to explore change continuity and conflict in the Republican Party over two decades He explains how the GOP evolved through internal political and ideological tensions from the Taft Eisenhower contest through the McCarthy era to the beginning of Nixon administration revealing Dirksen's role in that process By the time of Dirksen's death in 1969 the Vietnam War the explosion of urban riots and President Nixon's preference for the politics of resentment put an end to the suprapartisan spirit Hulse's book recreates a Washington milieu the likes of which may never be seen again offering a lens for viewing postwar American politics while painting the definitive political portrait of one of our most remarkable leaders
