communities both at national regional and municipal levels They are also reflected in recent developments in legislation and jurisprudence concerning the most essential Islamic core values such as dietary laws the precepts on modest dress Islamic burial practices and the possibilities to found Islamic cemeteries as well as the observance of Friday prayers and annual holidays Looking at the legal position of Islam in the countries of the European Union the authors of this volume discuss the challenges posed by the presence of Islam to the Western European system of relationships between law and religion They argue that these challenges necessitate reforms within the relevant European legislation but differ as to their precise nature They also discuss the difficulties of this task as these adjustments will alter a longstanding balance of rights and privileges recognised by different religious denominations Legal reforms however are not sufficient The creation of a truly multicultural Europe also necessitates fighting against the negative image of Islam and Muslims anti Muslimism or Islamophobia prevailing in most of its member states
