Armenian Philology in the Modern Era ,2014-06-05 Philology is one of the most investigated fields of Armenian studies At the end of the twentieth century it was important to provide an overview of the main achievements and on the methodological approaches implemented in this field till now This is the aim of the present publication Part I focuses on the manuscripts the inscriptions and the printings Its second section is devoted to the textual criticisms and the third section explores the interface between linguistics and philology Case studies form the core of Part II One chapter offers an overview on the 17th 19th centuries and two articles are devoted to the conditions of the circulation of the literary production in the 20th century both in Western and Eastern Armenian *(Re)constructing Armenia in Lebanon and Syria* Nicola Migliorino,2008 For almost nine decades since their mass resettlement to the Levant in the wake of the Genocide and First World War the Armenian communities of Lebanon and Syria appear to have successfully maintained a distinct identity as an ethno culturally diverse group in spite of representing a small non Arab and Christian minority within a very different mostly Arab and Muslim environment The author shows that while in Lebanon the state has facilitated the development of an extensive and effective system of Armenian ethno cultural preservation in Syria the emergence of centralizing authoritarian regimes in the 1950s and 1960s has severely damaged the autonomy and cultural diversity of the Armenian community Since 1970 the coming to power of the Asad family has contributed to a partial recovery of Armenian ethno cultural diversity as the community seems to have developed some form of tacit arrangement with the regime In Lebanon on the other hand the Armenian community suffered the consequences of the recurrent breakdown of the consociational arrangement that regulates public life In both cases the survival of Armenian cultural distinctiveness seems to be connected rather incidentally with the continuing search for legitimacy of the state *The History of Armenia* S. Armenian Organization and Ideology Under Ottoman Rule Dikran Kaligian, 2017-09-08 This book provides a comprehensive picture of Armeno Turkish relations for the brief period of Ottoman Constitutional rule between 1908 and 1914 Kaligian integrates internal documents of the Armenian Revolutionary Federation and existing research on the last years of the empire as well as the archives of the British American and German diplomatic corps By reducing the overemphasis on central government policies and by describing unofficial contacts political relations and provincial administration and conditions Kaligian provides a unified account of this key period in Ottoman history Kaligian sets out to resolve many of the conflicting conclusions in the current historiography including the most central issue the Armenian Revolutionary Federation relations with the Turkish Committee of Union and Progress It is impossible to obtain a true picture of Armeno Turkish relations without an accurate analysis of their two leading parties This study finds that the ARF was torn between maintaining relations with a CUP that had failed to implement promised reforms and was doing little to prevent increasing attacks on the Armenian population or break off relations thus ending any realistic chance for the constitutional system to succeed The party continued to stake its reputation and resources on the success of constitutional government even after the trauma of the 1909 Adana massacres The decisive issue was the failure of land reform This book sets the record straight in terms of understanding Armeno Turkish relations during this short but pivotal period Kaligian's study the first of its kind shows that the party's internal deliberations support the conclusion that it did remain loyal and contradicts the view that the party's only aim was to incite a rebellion against Ottoman rule The author has done an excellent job of leading the reader through this rich history using primary source information to bridge the gaps from theory to analysis to evidence

[Journey to the Republic of Armenia](#) Kalman Dubov, 2021-11-26 Armenia sits on the cusp between Europe and Asia landlocked between Turkey and Iran two opposing powers For much of its history Armenia was forced to contend between two greater powers positioned on either side of it There was Persia and its powerful influence on one side and Turkey on the other both interested in advancing and assuming control over the Armenian Plains Today these enmities continue to persist with Turkey refusing to open its borders with Armenia while there is a strong tourist trade with Iran Besides these competing countries Azerbaijan claims the Nagorno Karabakh enclave as does Armenia There are periodic flare ups with the most recent ceasefire brokered by Russia taking place on 10 November 2020 resulting in Azerbaijan gaining a distinct military advantage large territories in the disputed region In August 2017 I traveled to and spent a nearly month in Armenia visiting sites both in Yerevan the capital and in locations distant from the capital The ancient Zorats Karer site of the Armenian Stonehenge has massive stones configured in a curving S shape placed by ancient and unknown people The site is also known as the singing stones because

of the holes bored into the stones One must conjecture that the ancient construction of Gobekli Tepe in Turkey attracted ancient hunter gatherers to this large region where they constructed these sites for reasons with which we are not familiar Other than these stones nothing is known of them why they were built and its overall purpose Even their age is contested Further south is Tatev site of an ancient monastery containing a unique scientific obelisk The tall stone column standing free at its base was designed to predict the severity of earthquakes by its movement This is a remarkable construction made by an early seismologist interested in calibrating the periodic earthquakes this area experiences To travel to the monastery grounds I crossed the deep gorge by way of the world s longest cable tramway the Wings of Tatev As I review in my reviews of journeys to different countries I visited with the small Jewish community in Armenia Its chief rabbi the only formal Jewish leader in the country welcomed me and I spent one Sabbath as we discussed the history of Jews in the country and the minuscule community he leads today During the Second World War he his mother and aunt sheltered here finding the country and city a welcome respite from Nazi and Soviet anti Semitism Thousand of fellow Jews did the same and were grateful for this place of refuge But in the years following that world conflict all but approximately one hundred Jews left the country Today they reside in Israel as in other counties There is an enduring question why the Armenian setting was not conducive to Jewish settlement and business development I found Armenia to be a fascinating country with a long and complex history Known for the Armenia Genocide it is a place with attractions that remain unique I share my journey and the places of interest about this country with its complex history and its special people

Syrian Armenians and the Turkish Factor Marcello Mollica, Arsen Hakobyan, 2021-10-27 This volume examines significant social transformations engendered by the ongoing Syrian conflict in the lives of Syrian Armenians The authors draw on documentary material and fieldwork carried out in 2013 2019 among Syrian Armenians in Armenian and Lebanese urban settings The stories of Syrian Armenians reveal how contemporary events are seen to have direct links to the past and to reproduce memories associated with the Armenian genocide the contemporary involvement of Turkey in the Syrian war for example is seen on the ground as an attempt to control the Armenian presence in Syria Today the Syrian Armenian identity encapsulates the complex intersection of memory transnational links to the past collective identity and lived experience of wartime everydayness Specifically the analysis addresses the role of memory in key events such as the bombing of Armenian historical sites during the commemorations of 24 April in the Eastern Syrian city of Deir ez Zor the perceived shift from destroying Syrian Armenians material culture to attempting to destroy the Armenian community in urban Aleppo and the informal transactions that take place in the border area of Kessab This carefully researched ethnography will appeal to scholars of anthropology sociology and political science who specialize in studies of conflict memory and diaspora

The Armenians in the Medieval Islamic World Seta B. Dadoyan, 2013-02-14 In the second of a three volume work Seta B Dadoyan explores the Armenian condition from the 970s to the end of the fourteenth century This period marked the gradual loss of semi autonomy on the traditional mainland and the

rise of Armenian power of diverging patterns in southeastern Asia Minor north Syria Cilicia and Egypt Dadoyan's premise is that if Armenians and Armenia have always been located in the Middle East and the Islamic world then their history is also a natural part of that region and its peoples. She observes that the Armenian experience has been too complicated to be defined by simplistic constructs centered on the idea of a heroic yet victimized nation. She notes that a certain politics of historical writing supported by a culture of authority has focused sharply on episodes and in particular on the genocide. For her sources Dadoyan has used all available and relevant primary and secondary Armenian sources as well as primary Arab texts and sources. This book will stimulate re-evaluation of the period and re-conceptualizing Armenian and Middle Eastern histories.

The Armenians in the Medieval Islamic World, Volume Three Seta B. Dadoyan, 2013-09-23. In this first of a massive three-volume work Seta B. Dadoyan studies the Armenian experience in the medieval Islamic world and takes the reader through hitherto undiscovered paradigmatic cases of interaction with other populations in the region.
