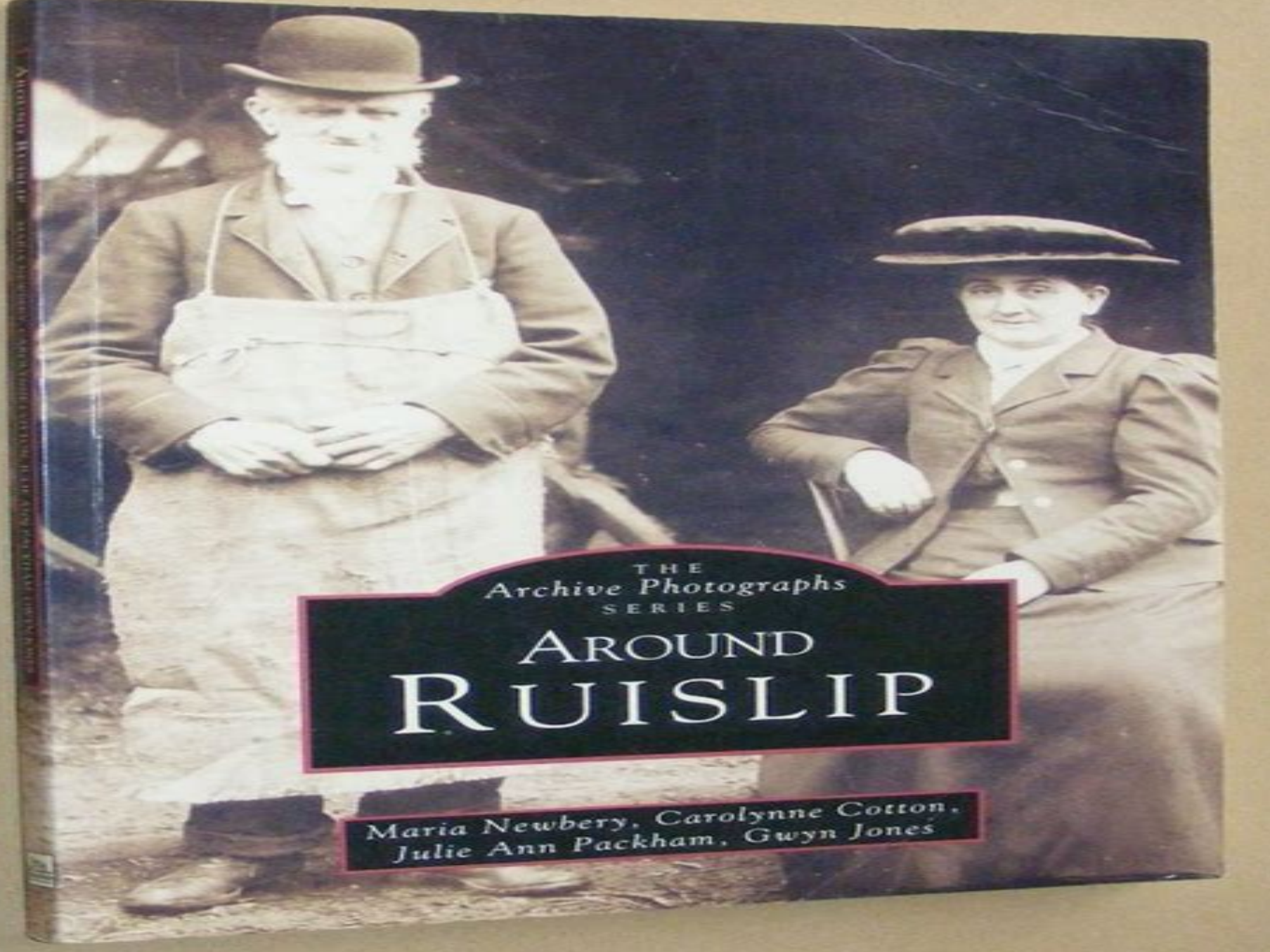

Mawgan Porth Rupert Bruce Mitford,2014-04-15 **Mawgan Porth** lies c 55m from the sea on the northern slope of the Vale of Lanherne near the North Cornish coast and faces south on to the floodplain of the River Menalhyl Excavations in 1950 52 1954 and 1974 uncovered three distinct but similar groups of buildings known as courtyard houses and a cemetery

all containing evidence of a date of occupation between c AD 850 and 1050 Each courtyard group comprised a long main room along one side with a partitioned end for livestock several smaller rooms or walls around the remaining sides and a narrow entrance The living area of the main room included a hearth and various vertical slab features and wall cupboards Traces of earlier buildings and occupational materials were found beneath the courtyard houses The cemetery contained adult and child burials enclosed in slab graves Pottery from the excavations forms a homogenous group with distinctive forms and fabric partly inspired by the bar lug tradition of Scilly and Cornwall with possible derivations from similar devices on contemporary Continental pottery Other finds included simple stone tools made from local and regional materials an abundance of perforated local slates a few bone artefacts iron traces and a silver penny of Aethelred the Unready struck between AD 990 and 995 from a small room in Courtyard House 1 Associated animal bones indicate a domestic economy supplemented by shell fishing Abandonment and possibly resettlement inland at St Mawgan appears to have been caused by difficult sandy and windy seashore conditions

Edward I's Regent Michael Ray,2022-05-05 Born at Christmas 1249 to Richard Edmund of Cornwall was nephew to Henry III and cousin to Edward I His eventful childhood took him to Germany when his father was elected king there He was captured at the battle of Lewes and imprisoned for more than

a year Returning from crusade he witnessed the brutal murder of his half brother which left him as heir to his father the richest man in the kingdom Throughout his life Edmund played a crucial role in medieval England As Regent of England Earl of Cornwall and the richest man in the land he was a leading force of the late thirteenth century This book considers Edmund's life his use of his wealth to lend to the king and others and to be a major benefactor of religious houses His piety saw him found two new religious houses rebuild another and bring the Holy Blood relic from Germany to Hailes abbey His record as Regent of England for three years is assessed The wide spread of his lands which included 13 castles and more than 800 places in 27 counties and his tenants are set out as is his place in the local community The basis of his wealth and its sources including money from his lands but also from tin mining and marine dues in Cornwall is explored and his knightly affinity and his close associates and officials are considered On a personal level the book examines his unsuccessful childless marriage with the sister of the Earl of Gloucester Edmund was a key figure throughout Edward I's reign and the late thirteenth century In this insightful account the man behind England's greatest king is at long last brought to the fore

The Heart of Drawing Michael J. Strauss, Mags Phelan Stones, Abrah Griggs, 2023-02-20 In this unique new book The Heart of Drawing 59 artists from 22 countries exhibit their art and talk about their process of creation to inspire readers and help them find inspiration for their own creative efforts The book is about what happens during the creation of a drawing NOT just about the final result Drawing is described as an act of cognition that can help you develop eye brain hand coordination conceptualize and analyze ideas think creatively and express yourself and communicate with others It's about Drawing to Learn which is the main focus of the book The words and images you see express a journey and the artists are exploring their internal and external realities with shape line and value The book promotes gestural or expressive drawing not necessarily a perfect finished work Because of this many of the drawings show restated lines drawn over erasures and other tentative marks and draw overs showing the process of creation They are not all flawless finished pieces Though from many countries and with various backgrounds most of the artists say they began drawing at an early age And most had someone in their lives encouraging them to create What most have in common is their gestural and exploratory approach to drawing Some describe entering a meditative state while drawing when nothing matters except putting marks on a surface Such drawing is sometimes a felt bodily experience more than an intellectual one For example one artist notes I keep a journal of my thoughts a kind of reservoir for fleeting feelings and impressions where like a primordial soup ideas congeal and give birth to strange creatures that crawl onto the shore discover wings and take flight What's best about The Heart of Drawing is the drawings themselves How these artists create is as diverse as humanity itself and the whole collection will give aspiring artists ideas for their own creative efforts
