Disturbing issues surround Heidegger's commitment to National Socialism, his disdain for liberal democracy and his rejection of the Enlightenment. Fried confronts these issues focusing not on the historical debate over Heidegger's personal involvement with Nazism but on whether and how the formulation of Heidegger's ontology relates to his political thinking as expressed in his philosophical works. The inquiry begins with Heidegger's interpretation of Heraclitus, particularly the term *polemos* (war) or in Heidegger's usage, confrontation. Fried contends that Heidegger invests *polemos* with broad ontological significance and that his appropriation of the word provides important insights into major strands of his thinking: his conception of the human being, understanding of truth and interpretation of history as well as the meaning of the so-called turn in his thought. Although Fried finds that Heidegger's politics are continuous with his thought, he also argues that Heidegger's work raises important questions about contemporary identity politics. Fried also shows that many postmodernists, despite attempts to distance themselves from Heidegger, fail to avoid some of the same political pitfalls his thinking entailed.

Signature Derrida Jacques Derrida, 2024-05-31 Throughout his long career, Jacques Derrida had a close collaborative relationship with *Critical Inquiry* and its editors. He saved some of his most important essays for the journal, and he relished the ensuing arguments and polemics that stemmed from the responses to his writing. That *Critical Inquiry* encouraged collecting the best of Derrida's work that was published in the journal between 1980 and 2002, *Signature Derrida* provides a remarkable introduction to the philosopher and the evolution of his thought. These essays define three significant periods in Derrida's writing: his early, seemingly revolutionary phase; a middle stage, often autobiographical, that included spirited defense of his work; and his late period, when his persona as a public intellectual was prominent and he wrote on topics such as animals and religion. The first period is represented by essays like *The Law of Genre*, in which Derrida produces a kind of phenomenological narratology.
