Armed Struggle and the Search for State Yezid Sayigh, 1997-12-11 This masterly new work spans an entire epoch in the history of the contemporary Palestinian national movement from the establishment of Israel in mandate Palestine in 1948 to the PLO Israel accord of 1993 Contrary to the conventional view that national liberation movements proceed with state building only after attaining independence the case of the PLO shows that state building may shape political institutionalization throughout the previous struggle even in the absence of an autonomous territorial economic and social base That is the central argument of this insightful study which traces the political ideological and organizational evolution of the PLO and its constituent guerrilla groups Taking the much vaunted armed struggle as its connecting theme it shows how conflict was used to mobilize the mass constituency assert particular discourses of revolution and nationalism construct statist institutions and establish the legitimacy of a new political class and bureaucratic elite The book draws extensively on PLO archives official publications and internal documents of the various guerilla groups and over 400 interviews conducted by the author with the PLO rank and file Its span primary sources and conceptual framework make this the definitive work on the subject

Armed Struggle and the Search for State Yaz~id Şâyigh, 1997 *The Palestinian Left and Its Decline* Francesco Saverio Leopardi, 2020-07-06 This book examines the history of the Palestinian Left by focusing on the trajectory of the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine PFLP during its declining phase Relying on a substantial corpus of primary sources this study illustrates how the PFLP s political agency contributed to its own marginalisation within the Palestinian national movement Following the 1982 eviction of the Palestine Liberation Organisation PLO from Lebanon the bases of the PFLP s opposition to Fatah s primacy in the national movement were jeopardised This book argues that the PFLP s loyalty to the PLO institutional and political framework prevented the formulation of a real counterhegemonic political project This drove the PFLP s action to suffer a fundamental contradiction undermining its stance within the national movement In the attempt to continue its opposition to Fatah while maintaining integration in the Palestinian mainstream the PFLP s agency fluctuated compromising its effectiveness and credibility Apparently irreversible the PFLP s marginalisation is a factor fostering the current Palestinian impasse as no alternative is emerging to break the thirteen year long Hamas Fatah polarisation

Making Endless War Brian Cuddy, Victor Kattan, 2023-08-17 Making Endless War is built on the premise that any attempt to understand how the content and function of the laws of war changed in the second half of the twentieth century should consider two major armed conflicts fought on opposite edges of Asia and the legal pathways that link them

together across time and space The Vietnam and Arab Israeli conflicts have been particularly significant in the shaping and attempted remaking of international law from 1945 right through to the present day This carefully curated collection of essays by lawyers historians philosophers sociologists and political geographers of war explores the significance of these two conflicts including their impact on the politics and culture of the world s most powerful nation the United States of America The volume foregrounds attempts to develop legal rationales for the continued waging of war after 1945 by moving beyond explaining the end of war as a legal institution and toward understanding the attempted institutionalization of endless war

How Israelis and Palestinians Negotiate Tamara Cofman Wittes, 2005 Refreshing and revealing in equal measure this innovative volume conducts a critical self critical exploration of the impact of culture on the ill fated Oslo peace process The authors negotiators and scholars alike demolish stereotypes as they construct an unusually subtle and sophisticated understanding of how culture influences negotiating styles Culture they argue did not cause the Oslo breakdown but it did play an influential intervening role at several levels coloring the thinking of political leaders shaping domestic politics on both sides and affecting each side s evaluation of the other s beliefs and intentions After an overview by William Quandt of the history of the Oslo process and the impact of international factors such as U S mediation the volume presents a detailed analysis of first Palestinian and then Israeli negotiating styles between 1993 and 2001 Omar Dajani a former legal advisor to the Palestinian team explains how elements of Palestinian identity and national development have hobbled the Palestinians ability to negotiate effectively Aharon Klieman a distinguished Israeli analyst traces a long standing clash between diplomatic and security subcultures within the Israeli political elite and reveals how Israeli identity has helped create a negotiating style that opts for short term gains while undermining the prospects for a lasting agreement Drawing on these insights Tamara Wittes concludes the volume by offering not only a fresh appreciation of culture s influence on interethnic negotiations but also lessons for future negotiators in the Israeli Palestinian conflict Read the review from Foreign Affairs

The Italian State and International Terrorism, 1969-1986 Valentine Lomellini, 2024-01-08 This book sheds light on the so called Moro Doctrine an Italian state security policy which has been portrayed in literature as an under the counter agreement made between Italy and Palestinian movement during the Cold War The Moro Doctrine or Lodo Moro as it is known in Italy aimed to protect the peninsula from Palestinian attacks by allowing terrorists to use Italian territory as a base for weapons and guerrilla fighters Responsibility for the Lodo was instrumentally placed on Aldo Moro the five time Prime Minister of Italy after his death and since then his name has become indelibly linked with the shame of having negotiated with Palestinian terrorists Thanks to records collected from over twenty archives in Italy the USA France Germany Britain and Russia concrete evidence shows that the significance of this agreement needs to be rethought The author argues that the decision to adopt the Lodo was not solely made by Moro but also involved key figures of the Christian Democrat and Socialist parties various magistrates and even the President of the Republic It illustrates how terrorism was used as an effective tool in international diplomacy to influence foreign and domestic policies Offering a re examination of Italian counter terrorist policy this book analyses how Italy responded to international terrorism during the Cold War providing a useful read for those researching Italian and European history Cold War studies the history of international relations and diplomacy and Middle East history
