The reader should ponder different cases such as those of the spiral design of early Europe entering Egypt of the Syrian and Cretan art in the XVIIIth dynasty of the effect of Persia upon Greece and of Greece upon Italy both through Magna Graecia and the conquest of Greece of the effect of the Goth Lombard and Northman on Europe and of Japan on modern Europe Some reflection on these great artistic movements will give a little insight as to the history of art Regarding the illustrations I have thought it more useful to give details large enough to be clearly seen rather than to contract too much surface into a space where it cannot well be studied
