use artefacts to understand particular aspects of Roman behavior and experience including discrepant experiences according to factors such as age social position and left or right handedness which are fostered through artifact design The relationship between production and users of artifacts is also explored investigating what particular production methods make possible in terms of user experience and also examining production constraints that have unintended consequences for users The book examines topics such as the perceived agency of objects differences in social practice across the provinces cultural change and development in daily practice and the persistence of tradition and social convention It shows that design intentions everyday habits of use and the constraints of production processes each contribute to the reproduction and transformation of material culture
