Beisner, 1987-02-04 This outstanding collection of essays is the product of a symposium on peacemaking and peacekeeping sponsored by the National Committee for the Bicentennial of the Treaty of Paris The original papers included in this volume were written by leading scholars from the United States Great Britain and Canada to assess themes related to the prerequisites and consequences of peace The emphasis is on peaceful outcomes and the preservation of peace rather than the causes of war and the writings reflect a penetrating awareness of the many facets of peacemaking and peacekeeping Included are thought provoking discussions on the impact of war and promise of peace on women the American perception of peace as an opportunity for profit and as a private political issue the avoidance of war and the possible obsolescence of war in our own era

The American Union and the Problem of Neighborhood James E. Lewis Jr., 2000-11-09 In this book James Lewis demonstrates the centrality of American ideas about and concern for the union of the states in the policymaking of the early republic For four decades after the nation s founding in the 1780s he says this focus on securing a union operated to blur the line between foreign policies and domestic concerns Such leading policymakers as Thomas Jefferson James Madison James Monroe John Quincy Adams and Henry Clay worried about the challenges to the goals of the Revolution that would arise from a hostile neighborhood whether composed of new nations outside the union or the existing states following a division of the union At the center of Lewis s story is the American response to the dissolution of Spain s empire in the New World from the transfer of Louisiana to France in 1800 to the independence of Spain s mainland colonies in the 1820s The breakup of the Spanish empire he argues presented a series of crises for the unionist logic of American policymakers leading them finally to abandon a crucial element of the distinctly American approach to international relations embodied in their own federal union

[Sex and Citizenship in Antebellum America](#) Nancy Isenberg, 2000-11-09 With this book Nancy Isenberg illuminates the origins of the women s rights movement Rather than herald the singular achievements of the 1848 Seneca Falls convention she examines the confluence of events and ideas before and after 1848 that in her view marked the real birth of feminism Drawing on a wide range of sources she

demonstrates that women's rights activists of the antebellum era crafted a coherent feminist critique of church state and family. In addition Isenberg shows they developed a rich theoretical tradition that influenced not only subsequent strains of feminist thought but also ideas about the nature of citizenship and rights more generally. By focusing on rights discourse and political theory Isenberg moves beyond a narrow focus on suffrage. Democracy was in the process of being redefined in antebellum America by controversies over such volatile topics as fugitive slave laws temperance Sabbath laws capital punishment prostitution the Mexican War married women's property rights and labor reform all of which raised significant legal and constitutional questions. These pressing concerns debated in women's rights conventions and the popular press were inseparable from the gendered meaning of nineteenth century citizenship.

Military Power, Conflict and Trade Michael P. Gerace, 2004-06-01

Wherever international commerce flows in

world politics military power often flows with it sometimes as a protector of commerce sometimes as its promoters and sometimes as a tool of aggression against it How are military power and international trade related Do military power and commerce expand together or does military power decline as commerce and perhaps interdependence increases Does this relationship vary across countries and if so how Power Conflict and Trade is a study of the relationship between military power and international commerce among the Great Powers prior to World War I After building an argument for a direct relationship between military power and commerce one grounded in a mercantilist view of state power and exploring their numerous connections the book estimates models of the relationship among the Great Powers and explores a great deal of their commercial and military data all of which is situated in the context of their mutual rivalries Another question investigated is whether the peacetime conflicts and rivalries of the Great Powers affected their trade relations adversely There is strong support for the argument that military power and commerce move together in world politics though there is evidence for an inverse relationship as well

Howlett, 2013-05-01 This new edition of Nicholas Murray Butler's *The International Mind* marks the 100th anniversary of its publication Widely read at the time it has reached the status of classic work Butler is one of the 20th Century's most famous college presidents He transformed Columbia University into a famous research institution of higher learning More importantly this work still has an important message for today's readers how can we establish an international mind that builds a lasting peace for the world This work is based on Butler's famous speeches as president of the Lake Mohonk Conferences on International Arbitration which took place just prior to the start of World War 1 Butler was a strong proponent of judicial internationalism and education as the mechanism through which the settlement of disputes between nations could be resolved As head of the just established Carnegie Endowment for International Peace's Division of Intercourse and Education Butler put forth his own views on international understanding Later Butler would become president of Carnegie's Peace Endowment and was most responsible for helping to bring forth the 1928 Kellogg Briand Pact renouncing war as an instrument of national policy In 1931 based on his efforts for world peace which began at Lake Mohonk NY Butler shared the Nobel Peace Prize with Jane Addams This new edition has a scholarly introduction as well as an extensive bibliographic essay on American Peace Writings by Charles F Howlett An added feature to this new edition is a listing of Butler's most notable works the platforms of the 1907 1912 Lake Mohonk Conferences and an lengthy 1914 interview with Butler by New York Times reporter Edward Marshall Readers will find the appendices an added bonus to a now classic work This new edition of Butler's important book will bring to light one of the early 20th century peace classics devoted to the study of international arbitration It offers a clear and compelling argument as to the importance of internationalism as proposed by some of the more prominent educational leaders statesmen and jurists of the pre World War 1 period Most importantly reissuing this work in its one hundredth anniversary year bears testimony to its lasting importance since Butler's efforts and those at the Lake Mohonk Conferences on International Arbitration led to the creation of a Permanent Court of International Justice only a few years after the conclusion of the First World War

brought suit the following year to integrate women into VMI In a book that poses serious questions about equal rights in America Philippa Strum traces the origins of this landmark case back to VMI s founding its evolution over fifteen decades and through competing notions about women s proper place Unlike most works on women in military institutions this one also provides a complete legal history from the initial complaint to final resolution in *United States v Virginia* and shows how the Supreme Court s ruling against VMI reflected changing societal ideas about gender roles At the heart of the VMI case was the rat line a ritualized form of hazing geared toward instilling male solidarity VMI claimed that its system of toughening individuals for leadership was even more stringent than military service and that the system would be destroyed if the Institute were forced to accommodate women Strum interviewed lawyers from Justice and VMI heads of concerned women s groups and VMI administrators faculty and cadets to reconstruct the arguments in this important case She was granted interviews with both Justice Ginsburg author of the majority opinion and Justice Scalia the lone dissenter on the bench and meticulously analyzes both viewpoints She shows how Ginsburg s opinion not only articulated a new constitutional standard for institutions accused of gender discrimination but also represented the culmination of gender equality litigation in the twentieth century *Women in the Barracks* is a case study that combines both legal and cultural history reviewing the long history of male elitism in the military as it explores how new ideas about gender equality have developed in the United States It is an engrossing story of change versus tradition clear and accessible for general readers yet highly instructive and valuable for students and scholars Now as questions continue to loom concerning the role of state funding for single sex education Strum s book squarely addresses competing notions of women s place and capabilities in American society
