Athanasius, the man and his theology

- The fiery young deacon was only in his twenties, he was already a power in Alexandrian church and a theologian of note. Formerly Alexander's secretary, now a deacon and the top member of his staff, he was reported to have written a number of the bishop's sermons and letters. He was quite prepared to use the violent methods of the streets, when necessary, to accomplish worthwhile goals.
- He felt that compromise with Arius and his allies was out of the question.
 The differences between the Arians and true Christians were no mere matters of emphasis or alterable "opinion": they went to the heart of what it meant to be a Christian.
- Jesus had to be <u>both</u> fully human and fully divine. Could the death of a mere human being redeem our sins, grant us immortality, and, eventually, resurrect our physical bodies? Of course not!
- Constantine favored the doctrine of Alexander and Athanasius. The Church
 he needed was one that would help him keep order among the ordinary folk:
 people who would never become immortal unless God decided for reasons
 of his own to save them.
