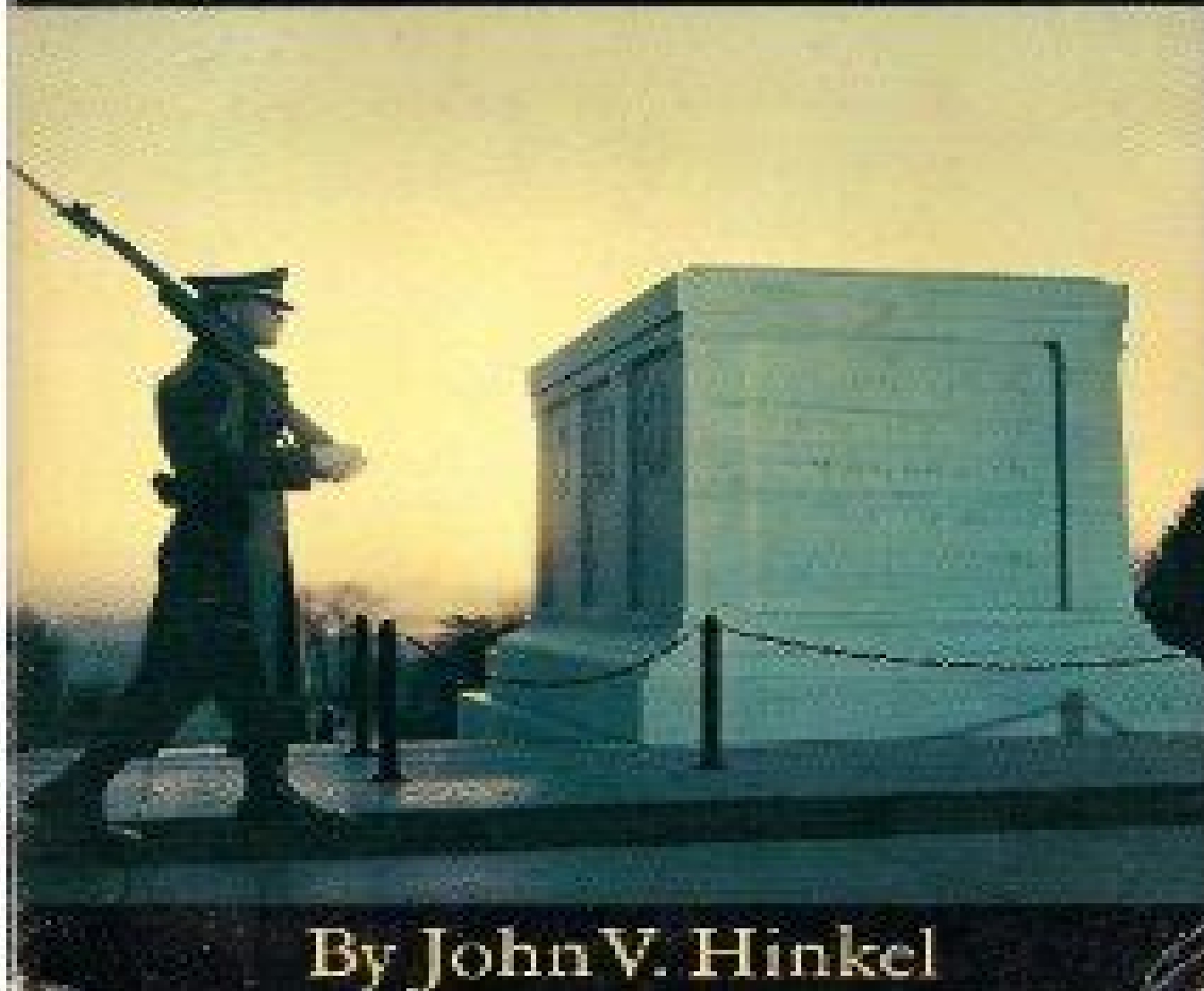

Mills, Pamela Hemenway Simpson, 2003 This richly illustrated collection of fourteen essays examines the ways in which Confederate memorials from Monument Avenue to Stone Mountain and the public rituals surrounding them testify to the tenets of the Lost Cause a romanticized narrative of the war Several essays highlight the creative leading role played by women's groups in memorialization while others explore the alternative ways in which people outside white southern culture wrote their very different histories on the southern landscape The authors who include Richard Guy Wilson Catherine W Bishir W Fitzhugh Brundage and William M S Ramussen trace the origins objectives and changing consequences of Confederate monuments over time and the dynamics of individuals and organizations that sponsored them Thus these essays extend the growing literature on the rhetoric of the Lost Cause by shifting the focus to the realm of the visual They are especially relevant in the present day when Confederate symbols and monuments continue to play a central role in a public and often emotionally charged debate about how the South's past should be remembered The editors Art Historian Cynthia Mills a specialist in nineteenth century public sculpture is executive editor of *American Art* the scholarly journal of the Smithsonian American Art Museum Pamela H Simpson is the Ernest Williams II Professor of Art History at Washington and Lee University She is the coauthor of *The Architecture of Historic Lexington* *Medal of Honor Recipients, 1863-1973* United States. Meyer, 1994 From the late eighteenth through the early twentieth centuries a sweeping movement in architectural and decorative taste dominated Western cultures Known collectively by the descriptive term Revival Styles this phenomenon which left a rich

visual legacy upon the cultural landscapes of many nations exhibited three primary manifestations Classical chiefly Greek and Roman Gothic or Medieval and Egyptian or Near Eastern In America for a variety of reasons a significantly large amount of the creative energy inherent in the Revival movement was directed towards the conception and erection of spectacular monuments and memorials to prominent Americans Frequently designed and executed by the leading architects and sculptors of the day the great majority of these strikingly beautiful artifacts and structures were placed in the large rural cemeteries of American cities developed in the middle decades of the nineteenth century where they remain for future generations to analyze and admire In this richly illustrated volume art historian Peggy McDowell and folklorist Richard E Meyer blend their respective disciplinary perspectives along with their shared long standing fascination with cemeteries and funerary material culture to provide a thoroughgoing descriptive analysis of this dramatic chapter in the history of American memorial art

Quarters One William Gardner Bell, 2001 **The Swing Around the Circle** Garry Boulard, 2008 In 1866 President Andrew Johnson was trying to find solutions to a bewildering array of immediate post Civil War challenges what to do about the recently liberated slaves how to bring the South back into the Union whether or not former members of the Confederacy should be pardoned and forgiven for their war time acts and building a thriving national economy that would provide jobs for millions of new veterans Confronted with an increasingly assertive Congress that had been frustrated by its lack of influence during the presidency of Abraham Lincoln Johnson decided to take his case directly to the American people for the fall mid term elections of 1866 becoming the first president in history to actively engage in a political campaign In a trade ride in which he was joined by the hero Ulysses S Grant the very young George Armstrong Custer and the legendary William Seward the secretary of state who was viciously attacked on the same night that Lincoln was murdered Johnson spoke to hundreds of
