examines the ways that both gamemakers and artists create game based artworks Games and art have intersected at least since the early twentieth century as can be seen in the Surrealists use of Exquisite Corpse and other games Duchamp's obsession with Chess and Fluxus event scores and boxes to name just a few examples Over the past fifteen years the synthesis of art and games has clouded for both artists and gamemakers Contemporary art has drawn on the tool set of videogames but has not considered them a cultural form with its own conceptual formal and experiential affordances For their part game developers and players focus on the innate properties of games and the experiences they provide giving little attention to what it means to create and evaluate fine art In Works of Game John Sharp bridges this gap offering a formal aesthetics of games that encompasses the commonalities and the differences between games and art Sharp describes three communities of practice and offers case studies for each Game Art which includes such artists as Julian Oliver Cory Arcangel and JODI Joan Heemskerk and Dirk Paesmans treats videogames as a form of popular culture from which can be borrowed subject matter tools and processes Artgames created by gamemakers including Jason Rohrer Brenda Romero and Jonathan Blow explore territory usually occupied by poetry painting literature or film Finally Artists Games with artists including Blast Theory Mary Flanagan and the collaboration of Nathalie Pozzi and Eric Zimmerman represents a more synthetic conception of games as an artistic medium The work of these gamemakers Sharp suggests shows that it is possible to create game based artworks that satisfy the aesthetic and critical values of both the contemporary art and game communities

Cinema Expanded Jonathan Walley, 2020 Expanded cinema avant garde moving image works that claim new territory for the cinematic beyond the bounds of familiar filmmaking practices and the traditional theatrical exhibition space First emerging in the 1960s amidst seismic shifts in the arts multi screen films live cinematic performance light art kinetic art video and computer generated imagery all placed under expanded cinema's umbrella re emerged at the dawn of the 2000s opening a vast new horizon of possibility for the moving image and perhaps even heralding the end of cinema as we know it Cinema Expanded Avant Garde Film in the Age of Intermedia offers a bold new account of its subject breaking from previous studies and from larger trends in film and art scholarship Author Jonathan Walley argues that expanded cinema's apparent departure from the traditions and forms of cinema as we know it actually radically asserts cinema's nature and artistic autonomy Walley also resituates expanded cinema within the context of avant garde film history linking it to a mode of filmmaking that has historically investigated and challenged the nature and limits of cinematic form As an outgrowth of this tradition expanded cinema offered a means for filmmakers within the avant garde regardless of their differing styles formal concerns and politics to stake out cinema's unique aesthetic terrain its ontology its independence its identity In addition to reconsidering the better known expanded cinema works of the 1960s and 70s by artists like Andy Warhol Robert Whitman and Nam June Paik Cinema Expanded also provides the first scholarly accounts of scores of lesser known works across more than 50 years Making new arguments about avant garde cinema in general and its complex meditations on the nature of cinema it urgently

addresses current and crucial debates about the fate of the moving image amidst a digital age of near constant technological change

historical national and artistic boundaries to address Graci n s El Critic n Monteverdi s opera Orfeo the poetry of Hafiz John Donne and Baudelaire as well as baroque architecture and Anselm Kiefer s Holocaust paintings In doing so Buci Glucksmann makes the case for the pervasive influence of the baroque throughout history and the continuing importance of the baroque in contemporary arts

archival research and personal collections including films videotapes and sound recordings At once aesthetic cultural and political this renewed perspective asks new questions and rewrites past assumptions about the artists work The legendary members of the East Coast Pictures Generation emerged at Hallwalls Contemporary Art Center in Buffalo in the mid 1970s These young people had started Hallwalls an artist run organization that invited artists from a variety of mediums to show their work It also featured productions by the founding members themselves Robert Longo Charles Clough Cindy Sherman Nancy Dwyer and Michael Zwack The works discussed in the volume include performance video films painting music and literature and have been chosen because of the way they foreground states of the body in relationship to conditions of their medium As a distinguishing feature of Hallwalls artists work the practice uses these traces to make metaphors on the process of mechanical reproduction itself The Hallwalls artists work also gives testament to Buffalo and to New York City the cities that formed their historical contexts This book will be of interest to scholars working in art history performance studies film studies and gender studies
