Women's War Stories Michelle Hartman, Malek Abisaab, 2022-09-09 Women have consistently been left out of the official writing of Lebanese history and nowhere is this more obvious than in writing on the Lebanese Civil War As more and more histories of the war begin to circulate few include any in depth discussion of the multiple roles women played in wartime Lebanon Fewer still address the essential issues of women s work and their creative production such as literature performance art and filmmaking Developed out of a larger oral history project collecting and archiving the ways in which women narrated their experiences of the Lebanese Civil War this book focuses on a wide range of subjects all framed as women telling their war stories Each of the six chapters centers on women who worked or created art during the war revealing in their own words the challenges struggles and resistance they faced during this tumultuous period of Lebanese history

North Country Mary Lethert Wingerd, 2010 In 1862 four years after Minnesota was ratified as the thirty second state in the Union simmering tensions between indigenous Dakota and white settlers culminated in the violent six week long U S Dakota War Hundreds of lives were lost on both sides and the war ended with the execution of thirty eight Dakotas on December 26 1862

in Mankato Minnesota the largest mass execution in American history The following April after suffering a long internment at Fort Snelling the Dakota and Winnebago peoples were forcefully removed to South Dakota precipitating the near destruction of the area s native communities while simultaneously laying the foundation for what we know and recognize today as Minnesota In North Country The Making of Minnesota Mary Lethert Wingerd unlocks the complex origins of the state origins that have often been ignored in favor of legend and a far more benign narrative of immigration settlement and cultural exchange Moving from the earliest years of contact between Europeans and the indigenous peoples of the western Great Lakes region to the era of French and British influence during the fur trade and beyond Wingerd charts how for two centuries prior to official statehood Native people and Europeans in the region maintained a hesitant largely cobeneficial relationship Founded on intermarriage kinship and trade between the two parties this racially hybridized society was a meeting point for cultural and economic exchange until the western expansion of American capitalism and violation of treaties by the U S government during the 1850s wore sharply at this tremulous bond ultimately leading to what Wingerd calls Minnesota s Civil War A cornerstone text in the chronicle of Minnesota s history Wingerd s narrative is augmented by more than 170 illustrations chosen and described by Kirsten Delegard in comprehensive captions that depict the fascinating often haunting representations of the region and its inhabitants over two and a half centuries North Country is the unflinching account of how the land the Dakota named Mini Sota Makoce became the State of Minnesota and of the people who have called it at one time or another home

Young,2017-01-15 You can tell a true war story if you just keep on telling it Tim O'Brien writes in *The Things They Carried* Widely regarded as the most important novelist to come out of the American war in Viet Nam O'Brien has kept on telling true war stories not only in narratives that cycle through multiple fictional and non-fictional versions of the war's defining experiences but also by rewriting those stories again and again Key moments of revision extend from early drafts to the initial appearance of selected chapters in magazines across typescripts and page proofs for first editions and through continuing post-publication variants in reprints *How to Revise a True War Story* is the first book-length study of O'Brien's archival papers at the University of Texas's Harry Ransom Center Drawing on extensive study of drafts and other prepublication materials as well as the multiple published versions of O'Brien's works John K Young tells the untold stories behind the production of such key texts as *Going After Cacciato* *The Things They Carried* and *In the Lake of the Woods* By reading not just the texts that have been published but also the versions they could have been Young demonstrates the important choices O'Brien and his editors have made about how to represent the traumas of the war in Viet Nam The result is a series of texts that refuse to settle into a finished or stable form just as the stories they present insist on being told and retold in new and changing ways In their lack of textual stability these variants across different versions enact for O'Brien's readers the kinds of narrative volatility that is key to the American literature emerging from the war in Viet Nam Perhaps in this case you can tell a true war story if you just keep on revising it

Buss,2006-01-01 Why does it seem as if everyone is writing memoirs and particularly women The current popularity of memoir verifies the common belief that we each have a story to tell And we do especially women Memoirs are not only representations of women s personal lives but also of their desire to repossess important parts of our culture in which women s stories have not mattered Beginning with her own motivations for writing memoirs Helen M Buss examines the many kinds of memoir written by contemporary women memoirs about growing up memoirs about traumatic events about relationships about work In writing

memoirs these women publicly assert that their lives have mattered They reshape the memoir a form as old as the middle ages and as young as today into a social discourse that blends the personal with the political the self with the significant other literature with history and fiction with autobiography and essay Buss urges readers to use their reading experience to help themselves understand and write the significance of their own lives *Repossessing the World* is the first book length critical inquiry into women s use of a form that has often been dismissed as less important than autobiography less professional than the novel and less intellectual than the formal essay Buss demonstrates that the memoir makes its own art not only through selective borrowing from these genres but also through the unique way that the tripartite narrative voice of the memoir constructs the personal and public experience of the memorist as significant to our cultural moment *Dueling Grounds* Mary Jo Lodge, Paul R.
