Anthology Of Irish Literature:

Irish Writing Stephen Regan, 2004 Can we not build up a national tradition a national literature which shall be none the less Irish in spirit from being English in language W B Yeats This anthology traces the history of modern Irish literature from the revolutionary era of the late eighteenth century to the early years of political independence From Charlotte Brooke and Edmund Burke to Elizabeth Bowen and Louis MacNeice the anthology shows how in forging a tradition of their own Irish writers have continually challenged and renewed the ways in which Ireland is imagined and defined The anthology includes a wide ranging and generous selection of fiction poetry and drama Three plays by W B Yeats Augusta Gregory and J M Synge are printed in their entirety along with the opening episode of James Joyce's Ulysses The volume also includes letters speeches songs memoirs essays and travel writings many of which are difficult to obtain elsewhere Stephen Regan's anthology vividly and valiantly presents a nation and a national literature coming into being Paul Muldoon *An anthology of Irish literature* David H. Greene, 1985-10-01 Most anthologies of Irish literature deal only with Irish literature in English that which is generally referred to as Anglo Irish literature Most of them also deal only with Irish writers of the twentieth century An Anthology of Irish Literature is an exception to both these tendencies The selections represent Irish literature from the seventh century through the twentieth century Volume I contains translations of medieval Irish poetry and narratives many of which though transcribed in Middle Irish are from an older oral tradition The volume also offers examples of Irish lyric poetry of the 17th and 18th centuries and translations from 19th century Irish poets All the selections in Volume II were originally written in English Beginning with some anonymous poems it includes Swift's famous essay on Irish children and works by Oliver Goldsmith Virtually all of modern Irish literature written in English was a part of the literary movement known as the Irish Renaissance This grew from the desire of Irish writers to maintain a literary tradition by creating a modern literature which drew sustenance and inspiration from the Gaelic past It was a nationalistic movement and was bound up with the political movement which culminated in the Easter 1916 Rising and the Anglo Irish war of 1918-1921 The most famous writers of the Irish Renaissance were George Bernard Shaw W B Yeats Sean O'Casey James Joyce and Frank O'Connor [An Anthology of Irish Literature](#) David H. Greene, 2003-01 **An Anthology of Irish Literature: Irish literature in English** David Herbert Greene, *Irish Literature* Alexander Norman Jeffares, Peter Van de Kamp, 2006 The second of the three volumes roughly spans the middle decades of the nineteenth century a period dominated by the enormity of the Great Famine Its terror is recorded in first hand accounts and in the powerless yet forceful reactions which this cataclysmic event engendered

in such writers as John Mitchel who in his Jail Journal pits the self against the state This volume documents the rise of cultural nationalism in the work of the contributors to The Nation Davis Mangan Lady Wilde and the response of Unionist intelligentsia in the Dublin University Magazine It juxtaposes the authentic Gaelic voice in translation Ferguson and Walsh against the haunting intensity of Mangan and the non conformism of his fellow inauthenticator Father Prout It witnesses the stage Irishman in Lever s fiction being placed on Boucicault s popular podium in his reworking of Gerald Griffin s account of The Colleen Bawn It records the rise of Fenianism in such writers as Charles Kickham and it sees Ireland taking stock in the work of W E H Lecky It notes the emergence of a new literary confidence in the works of Sigerson and Todhunter It extends well beyond examinations of Irish identity not only in encapsulating popular writing but also by incorporating writers of Irish descent who investigated different cultures
