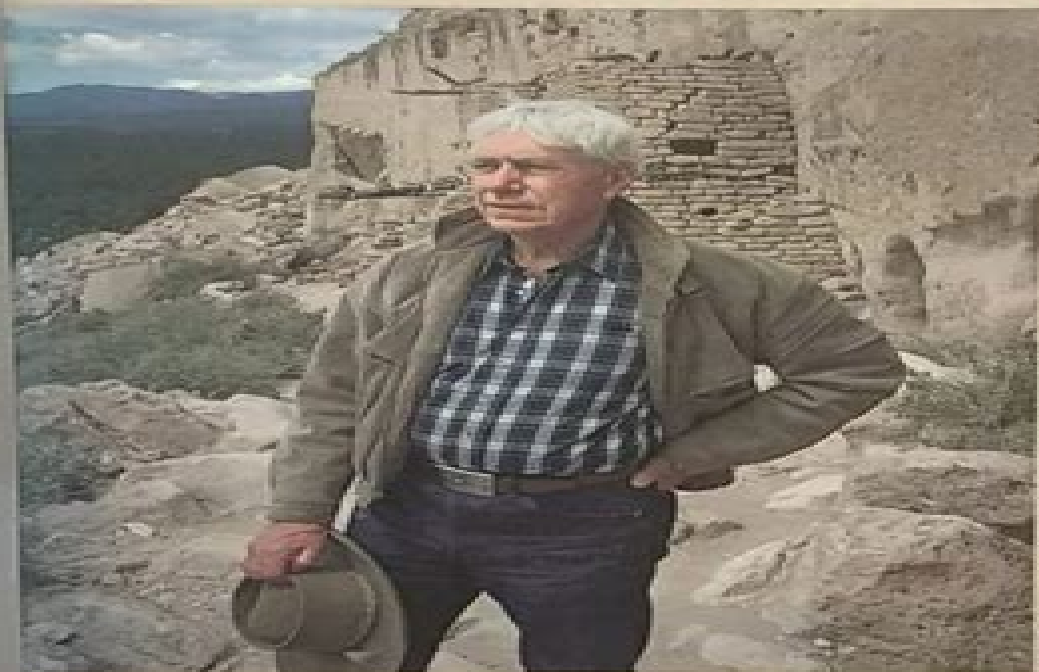

Everyday Life Agnes Heller, 2015-07-03 This book first published in 1984 examines the politics and philosophy of ordinary men and women and their ordinary transactions It analyses the interaction between the individual and the social both for the roots of everyday behaviour and for the means to change the social fabric Using an approach that combines Marx Husserl Heidegger and Aristotle Agnes Heller defines categories such as group crowd community and deals with characteristics of everyday life such as repetition rules norms economics habits probability imitation She also analyses everyday knowledge and concludes by looking at the place of personality in everyday life **Material Culture and Technology in Everyday**

Life Phillip Vannini, 2009 Focusing on the technoculture of everyday life this book attempts to zero in on the simplicity and the habitual character of the interaction between humans and material objects which is often assumed or taken for granted Because objects are always meaningful in the pragmatic use to which they are directed the material world of everyday life can be seen as a technoculture of its own one made of behaviors as simple and yet as significant as using a lawnmower or decorating one's body In discussing the unique methodological components of the ethnography of the technoculture of everyday life this book begins a dialogue on how we can examine from the participants perspective the interconnections between social agents their technological material practices their material objects or technics and their social and material environment The Ethics of Everyday Life Michael C. Banner, 2014 Why do we have children and what do we raise them for Does the proliferation of depictions of suffering in the media enhance or endanger compassion How do we live and die well in the extended periods of debility which old age now threatens Why and how should we grieve for the dead And how should we properly remember other grief and grievances In addressing such questions the Christian imagination of human life has been powerfully shaped by the imagination of Christ's life Christ's conception birth suffering death and burial have been subjects of profound attention in Christian thought just as they are moments of special interest and concern in each and every human life However they are also sites of contention and controversy where what it is to be human is discovered constructed and contested Conception birth suffering burial and death are occasions in other words for profound and continuing questioning regarding the meaning of human life as controversies to do with IVF abortion euthanasia and the use of bodies and body parts post mortem indicate In The Ethics of Everyday Life Michael Banner argues that moral theology must reconceive its nature and tasks if it is not only to articulate its own account of human being but also to enter into constructive contention with other accounts In particular it must be willing to learn from and engage with social anthropology if it is to offer powerful and plausible portrayals of the moral life and answers to the questions which trouble modernity Drawing in wide ranging fashion from social anthropology and from Christian thought and practice from many

periods and influenced especially by his engagement in public policy matters including as a member of the UK's Human Tissue Authority Banner develops the outlines of an everyday ethics stretching from before the cradle to after the grave

Kearns, 2009-11-10 An exploration of law's place in everyday life and the influence of everyday life on the law *Everyday Life Matters* Cynthia Robin, 2013-10-29 While the study of ancient civilizations has often focused on holy temples and royal tombs a substantial part of the archaeological record remains hidden in the understudied day to day lives of artisans farmers hunters and other ordinary people of the ancient world The various chores of a person's daily life can be quite extraordinary and even though they may seem trivial such activities can have a powerful effect on society as a whole *Everyday Life Matters* develops general methods and theories for studying everyday life applicable in archaeology anthropology and a wide range of disciplines In this groundbreaking work Cynthia Robin examines the 2 000 year history 800 B C A D 1200 of the ancient farming community of Chan in Belize explaining why the average person should matter to archaeologists studying larger societal patterns Robin argues that the impact of what is commonly perceived as habitual or quotidian can be substantial and a study of a polity without regard to the citizenry is woefully incomplete She also develops general methods and theories for studying everyday life applicable across a wide range of disciplines Refocusing attention from the Maya elite and offering critical analysis of daily life interwoven with larger anthropological theories Robin engages us to consider the larger implications of the seemingly mundane and to rethink the constitution of human societies everyday life and ordinary people
