This work requires further specification through a developed anthropology which allows for expansion within the tradition of Catholic theological ethics. The inclusion of Levinas and a focus on the virtue of solidarity allows for an advancement of virtue theory and theological ethics to the extent that the virtue of solidarity becomes a key aspect of any ethical reasoning.

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
