The result does not denigrate him but shows him in the full heroism of his brief, prodigiously creative life. Rayfield has spent more than three years combing the Chekhov archives all over Russia. Chekhov was a restless traveler for the whole of his life, going from Siberia to the Côte d'Azur and has uncovered thousands of documents and letters from Chekhov's lovers, friends, and family, most of them never published before, which cumulatively tell of a life far more entangled and turbulent than we ever previously suspected. January 1860 15 July 1904 was a Russian playwright and short story writer who is considered to be among the greatest writers of short fiction in history His career as a playwright produced four classics and his short stories are held in high esteem by writers and critics Along with Henrik Ibsen and August Strindberg Chekhov is often referred to as one of the three seminal figures in the birth of early modernism in the theatre Chekhov practiced as a medical doctor throughout most of his literary career Medicine is my lawful wife he once said and literature is my mistress Chekhov renounced the theatre after the reception of *The Seagull* in 1896 but the play was revived to acclaim in 1898 by Konstantin Stanislavski's Moscow Art Theatre which subsequently also produced Chekhov's *Uncle Vanya* and premiered his last two plays *Three Sisters* and *The Cherry Orchard* These four works present a challenge to the acting ensemble as well as to audiences because in place of conventional action Chekhov offers a theatre of mood and a submerged life in the text Chekhov had at first written stories only for financial gain but as his artistic ambition grew he made formal innovations which have influenced the evolution of the modern short story He made no apologies for the difficulties this posed to readers insisting that the role of an artist was to ask questions not to answer them
