Another America Mark Warhus, 1997 Opening a window for modern readers to see how the original inhabitants viewed the American continent more than three hundred years ago this unique and valuable reference combines rare maps made by Native Americans with essays on their historical and cultural context *Early American Cartographies* Martin Brückner, 2011 Drawing from both current historical interpretations and new interdisciplinary perspectives this collection provides diverse approaches to understanding the multilayered exchanges that went into creating cartographic knowledge in and about the Americas In the introduction editor Martin Brückner provides a critical assessment of the concept of cartography and of the historiography of maps The individual essays then range widely over space and place from the imperial reach of Iberian and British cartography to indigenous conceptualizations including dirty ephemeral maps and star charts to demonstrate that pre nineteenth century American cartography was at once a multiform and multicultural affair The essays also bring to light original archives and innovative methodologies for investigating spatial relations among peoples in the Western Hemisphere from the publisher **New Worlds for All** Colin G. Calloway, 2013-10 Calloway reminds us that neither Indians nor Colonists were a monolithic group resulting in a more nuanced appreciation for the complexity of cultural relationships in Colonial America He provides an essential starting point for studying the interaction of Europeans and Indians in early American life **The Common Pot** Lisa Tanya Brooks, 2008 Literary critics frequently portray early Native American writers either as individuals caught between two worlds or as subjects who even as they defied the colonial world struggled to exist within it In striking counterpoint to these analyses Lisa Brooks demonstrates the ways in which Native leaders including Samson Occom Joseph Brant Hendrick Aupaumut and William Apessa adopted writing as a tool to reclaim rights and land in the Native networks of what is now the northeastern United States **Indians and Emigrants** Michael L. Tate, 2014-08-04 In the first book to focus on relations between Indians and emigrants on the overland trails Michael L Tate shows that such encounters were far more often characterized by cooperation than by conflict Having combed hundreds of unpublished sources and Indian oral traditions Tate finds Indians and Anglo Americans continuously trading goods and news with each other and Indians providing various forms of assistance to overlanders Tate admits that both sides normally followed their own best interests and ethical standards which sometimes created distrust But many acts of kindness by emigrants and by Indians can be attributed to simple human compassion Not until the mid 1850s did Plains tribes begin to see their independence and cultural traditions threatened by the flood of white travelers As buffalo herds dwindled and more Indians died from diseases brought by emigrants violent clashes between wagon trains and Indians became more frequent and the first Anglo Indian wars erupted on the plains Yet even in the 1860s Tate finds friendly encounters were still the rule Despite thousands of mutually beneficial exchanges between whites and Indians between 1840 and 1870 the image of Plains Indians as the overland pioneers worst enemies prevailed in American popular culture In

explaining the persistence of that stereotype Tate seeks to dispel one of the West's oldest cultural misunderstandings

Cartographic Poetry Ted Binnema, François Lanoë, Heinz W. Pyszczyk, 2025-10-06 Poetry is language condensed Blackfoot cartography is landscape distilled Cartographic Poetry is the first book length multidisciplinary study of five maps drawn in 1801 and 1802 by several Blackfoot and Gros Ventre people for the Hudson's Bay Company Representing some of the oldest documents created by Indigenous people on the North American prairies and foothills these maps preserve invaluable evidence about places on the landscape and about historic Blackfoot views of their territories The maps were intended as navigational tools but the landforms and locations on the maps hold significance for the Blackfoot well beyond wayfinding and have for many centuries Exploring their content and utility from historical linguistic and archaeological perspectives Ted Binnema François Lanoë and Heinz W Pyszczyk analyze the maps their place names and features and the tours and trips they may have supported along with providing present day photographs of many of the maps landforms A final section of the book outlines how Indigenous maps contributed significantly to Western geographical knowledge and maps of North America from the 1500s onward Cartographic Poetry will appeal to anthropologists archaeologists geographers historians cartographers and to all readers interested in how Indigenous peoples perceived and navigated their territories in this early period of colonial encounter With a Foreword by Jerry Potts Jr and an Afterword by Dr Eldon Yellowhorn *An Introduction to Native North America* Mark Q. Damming the Reservation Angela K. Parker, 2024-09-10 The single most destructive act ever perpetrated on any tribe by the United States Vine Deloria Jr called it For the Mandan Hidatsa and Arikara communities living on the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation in North Dakota the construction of the Garrison Dam as part of the New Deal era Pick Sloan Missouri Basin Program meant the flooding of a third of their land including their most fertile agricultural acreage the loss of their homes and wrenching relocation In *Damming the Reservation* Angela K Parker an enrolled member of the Three Affiliated Tribes offers a deeply researched unflinching history of the tribes fight to preserve and rebuild their culture shared history common stories sense of place and sovereignty With the richly informed and deeply personal perspective of a historian and descendant of those who survived these events Parker tracks the riverine communities from 1920 to 1960 in the years before during and after the Army Corps of Engineers did its devastating work By studying the inextricable link between on the ground conditions and national policy she builds a cohesive narrative for twentieth century Native American history that hinges on the assertion of Indigenous sovereignties These battles over land water and resources that constitute the territory required to maintain a working sovereign body are at the very heart of the Native American past present and future The author shows how Indigenous resistance to the Garrison Dam created a new generation of activists including Tillie Walker the focus of the book s epilogue *Damming the Reservation* documents what can happen when a settler colonial nation tramples tribal rights while exerting control over rural hinterlands in this case the reservation community developed a praxis of self determination and tribal sovereignty that trickled up to the national level so that tribal meanings came to saturate federal Indian policy This is a history whose lessons echo through today s most pressing environmental justice crises

Exploring the Castle Robert Kershaw, 2008 In 1901 naturalist George Bird Grinnell took note of an extensive network of mountains ridges valleys lakes and rivers on both sides of the Continental Divide from northern Montana into southern British Columbia and Alberta Disregarding political boundaries he named it The Crown of the Continent Grinnell was obviously inspired by the region s majestic landscape and the wildlife it sustained He also recognized the need to conserve it But while *Crown of the Continent* speaks eloquently of the region s beauty with more than a passing nod to European monarchy and history the Blackfeet name carries a more vital and universal meaning Mo kakiikin the backbone of the world At the heart of this complex landscape lies the Castle Wilderness The book is divided into two main sections *The Meaning of Place* Why the Castle Matters gives an overview of the area s culture natural history climate flora and fauna as well as explanations of present day uses and developments
