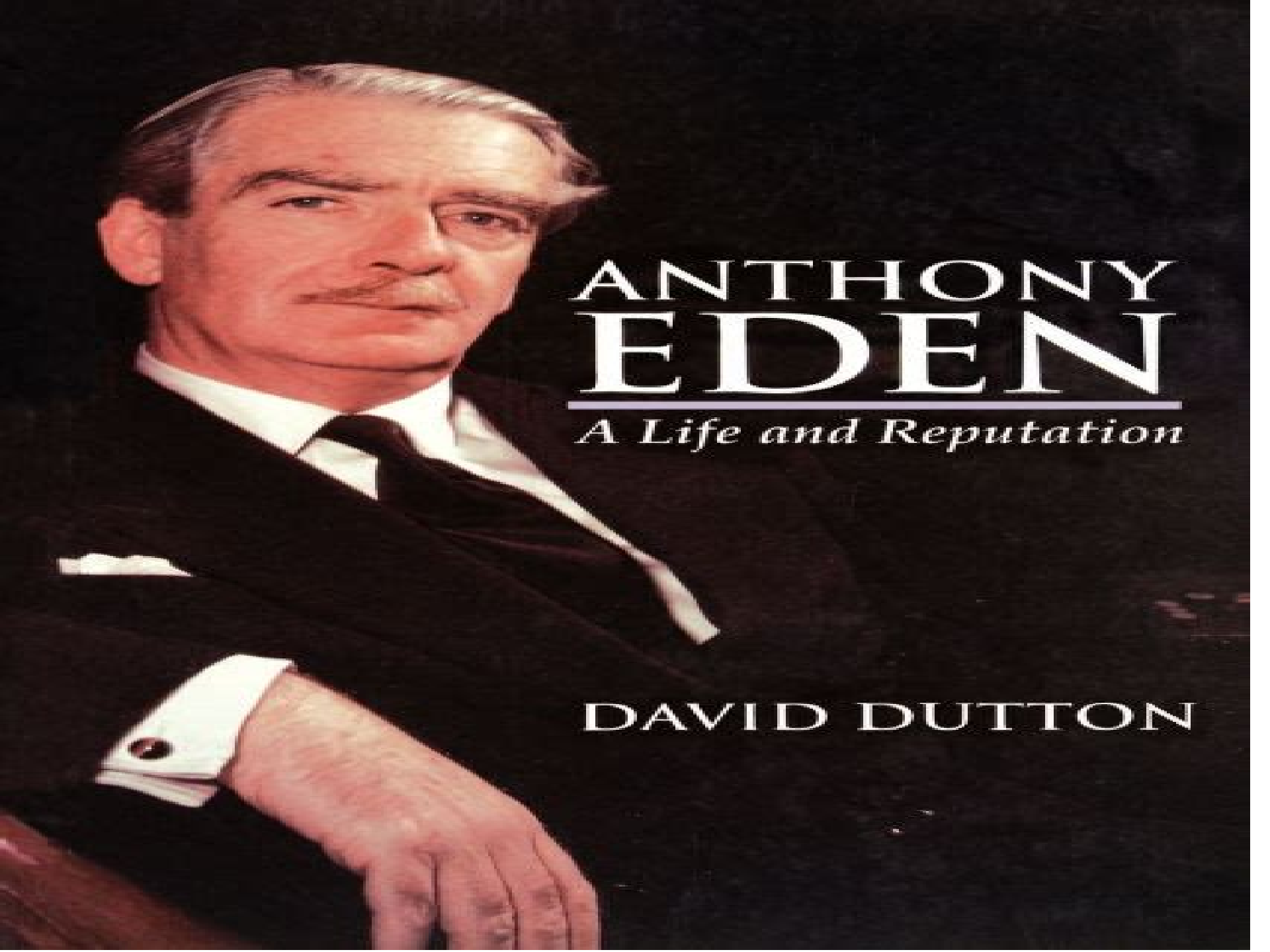

Anthony Eden A Life And Reputation:

Anthony Eden David Dutton, 1997 Historical reputation is closely examined but is not allowed to compromise a proper assessment of a man who was at the heart of British political life for more than two decades Eden's role in some of the key episodes in modern history is searchingly probed his participation in the appeasement of Nazi Germany and Fascist Italy until 1938 when he resigned from Chamberlain's government his direction in conjunction with Churchill of Britain's wartime diplomacy his Anthony Eden, 1941 Typed signed note to J C Wedgwood England Robert Anthony Eden 1st Earl of Avon born June 12 1897 died January 14 1977 was a British Conservative politician and Prime Minister from 1955 to 1957 He was also Foreign Secretary for three periods between 1935 and 1955 including during the Second World War He is best known for his outspoken opposition to appeasement in the 1930s his diplomatic leadership in the 1940s and 1950s and the failure of his Middle East policy in 1956 that ended his premiership Eden's worldwide reputation as an opponent of appeasement a Man of Peace and a skilled diplomat was overshadowed in the second year of his premiership when the United States refused to support the Anglo French military response to the Suez Crisis which critics across party lines regarded as an historic setback for British foreign policy signalling the end of British predominance in the Middle East Most historians argue that he made a series of blunders especially not realizing the depth of opposition to military action by the US Most historians say that Eden completely dominated the British decision making process in the Suez crisis However Jonathan Pearson argues in *Sir Anthony Eden and the Suez Crisis Reluctant Gamble* 2002 that Eden was more reluctant and less bellicose than most historians say He is generally ranked among the least successful British Prime Ministers of the 20th century although two broadly sympathetic biographies in 1986 and 2003 have gone some way to redressing the balance of opinion Thorpe says the Suez Crisis was a truly tragic end to his premiership and one that came to assume a disproportionate importance in any assessment of his career

June 1940, Great Britain and the First Attempt to Build a European Union Andrea Bosco, 2016-06-22 June 2016 represents a significant moment in British history The decision to leave the European Union at the most critical period since its existence could bring unpredictable and far reaching consequences both for the United Kingdom and the Union itself June 1940 was also a turning point in British history On the afternoon of 16 June a few hours before the French Government opted for the capitulation Churchill made on behalf of the British Government an offer of indissoluble union When a sceptical Churchill put forward to the British Cabinet the text of the declaration drafted by Jean Monnet Sir Arthur Salter and Robert Vansittart he was surprised at the amount of support it received The Cabinet adopted the document with some minor amendments and de Gaulle who saw it as a means of keeping France in the war telephoned

Reynaud with the proposal for an indissoluble union with joint organs of defence foreign financial and economic policies a common citizenship and a single War Cabinet The proposal however never reached the table of the French Government The spirit of capitulation embodied in Weygand and P tain prevailed and France submitted herself to the German will for the second time in seventy years After the Munich crisis Great Britain had to face the danger of another European war with the inevitable loss of the Empire and it was at this point that the country first began to favour the application of the federalist principle to Anglo French relations In this conversion to federalism a fundamental role was played by the Federal Union the first federalist movement organised on a popular basis The contribution of Federal Union to the development of the federal idea in Great Britain and Europe was to express and organise the beginning of a new political militancy and it represented the first step of a historical process the overcoming of the nation State the modern political formula which institutionalises the political division of mankind This study principally examines the first eighteen months of the Federal Union during which time it was able to raise itself to the attention of the general public and the political class as the heir of the League of Nations Union The research is based on extensive unpublished archival material found across the globe from London Oxford Brighton and Edinburgh to Washington Paris and Geneva

The League of Nations, International Terrorism, and British Foreign Policy, 1934-1938 Michael D. Callahan, 2018-05-02 This book examines the League of Nations state supported terrorism and British foreign policy after the rise of Hitler in the 1930s. It argues that with strong leadership from Britain and France the League made it possible for states to preserve the peace of Europe after terrorists aided by Italy and Hungary killed the King of Yugoslavia in 1934. This achievement represents the League at its most effective and demonstrates that the organization could carry out its peacekeeping functions. The League also made it possible to draft two international conventions to suppress and punish acts of terrorism. While both conventions were examples of productive collaboration in the end, few governments supported the League's anti-terrorism project in itself. Still, for Britain Geneva served the cause of peace by helping states to settle their differences by mediation and concession while promoting international cooperation and a central conviction of British appeasement policy in the 1930s.
